Morrow

This diary, or notebook kept by W. L. L. Woodhouse covers the period between 20 February (earliest date estimated) and 24 March, 1839, during which he was a physician in attendance upon the party of Cherokee Emigrants conducted by Richard Taylor. The journal also covers ~~Woodhouse's~~ trip back to Atlanta.

I might remark that this party, of 1029 persons, had 55 deaths en route, and fifty children born. Mr. Morrow's diary goes far to explain this.

I have taken the liberty of making some obvious corrections in the text except, but there remain many obscure readings which should be clarified. Some of the pages, also, are out of chronological order.
