Report of Commissioners

This day comes

Leo Henssely, Robert Manning and Charles Israel the Commissioners heretofore appointed to view and lay out said roads do report for public use the following road - (To wit) Beginning at the end of the land at Hances running down the bank of the Mississippi river to mouth of little creek, thence up said creek about 100 or 150 yards to a point designated by us to cross said creek, thence down the Mississippi River on its bank to the mouth of Brazos creek, thence up Brazos to a Blazed Hickory and Bur oak trees, then a cross the creek to a blazed black Oak in Cotton Wood, thence south to a blazedamore and spruce gum to intersect the Gills Ferry road and Perryville road. - said report being publicly read, and no objection being made thereto, it is ordered by the Court that said road be opened and repaired forty feet width, which shall thence forth be a public highway. —

Whereas by the Ball Book returned and now here exhibited to the Court of an Election held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1837 in the Township of Mazon and Bois Brule Township it appears that Augustus Davis Esquire has been duly elected a Justice of the Peace for Mazon Township - and Jacob M. Burgess duly elected a Justice of the Peace for Bois Brule Township; it is therefore Ordered by the Court that said Elections be approved of by the Court and that the Clerk issue or make out Certificates thereof in due form of Law, signed & delivered as by Law required to each of said Justices Elected.

↓ This is 740<sup>ft</sup> to lay out a road.

Report of Commissioners through Berry County from Jackson to Farmington - to Mill  
Berry County, Missouri

We the persons appointed by the within Order of Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned having first been duly sworn according to Law, do report that in pursuance of the said Order we have viewed laid out and return for public use the following Road viz, Beginning at the end of the road leading from Jackson to Farmington Westward leaving Christian Hahn on the right; thence on leaving Abraham Hahn on the right, thence on leaving Joseph Bullingers on the left, thence on leaving Joshua Keefe on the left, and John Johnson on the right; thence intersecting the road leading from Farmington to Jackson at the County Line; said Report was made this day by Charles French - William Conrad & Samuel C. Whybark Commissioners which Report was read in open Court - and no objections being made thereto, it is Ordered by the Court, that said road be opened and repaired according to Law.
