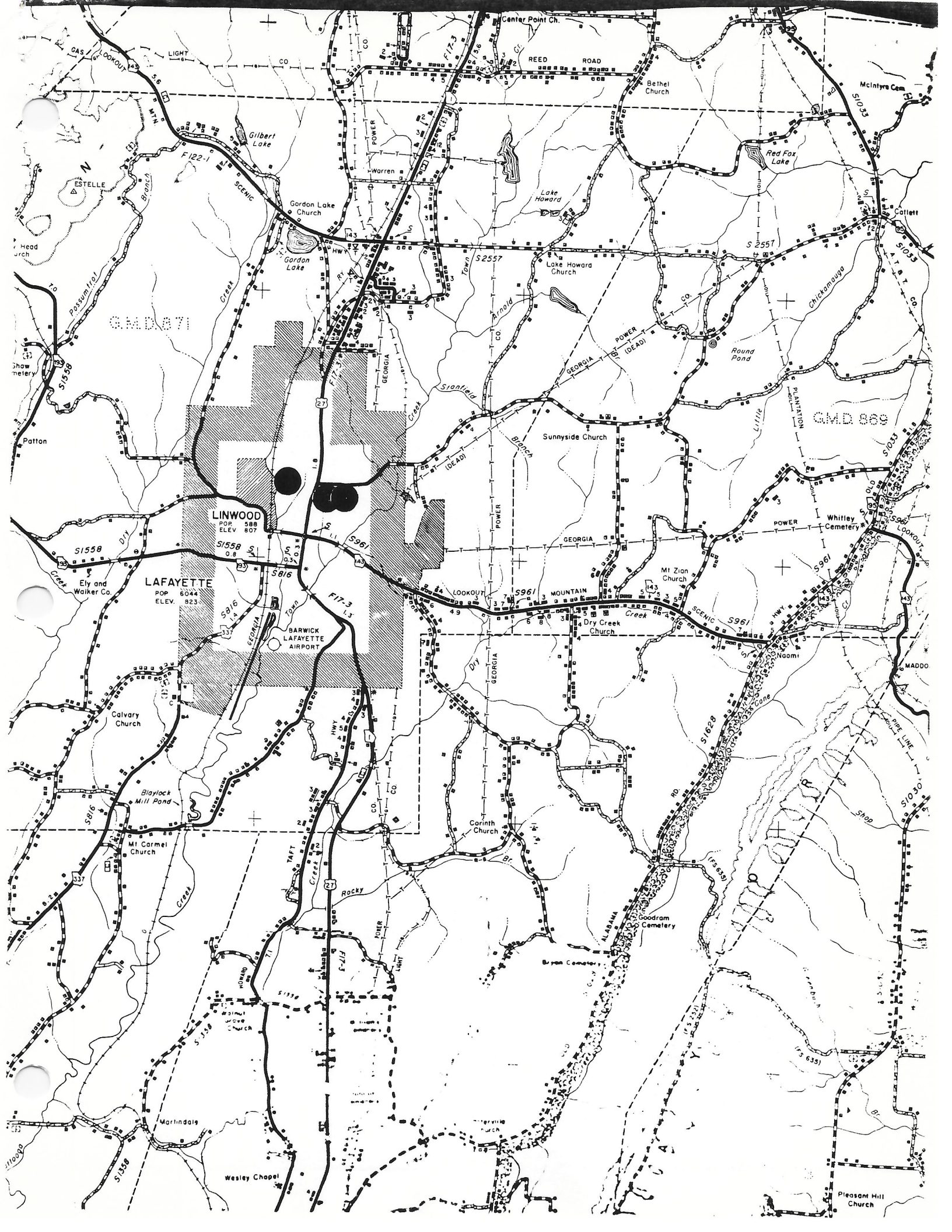
Cherokee Indian Stockade with block house
