ABSTRACT OF PROVISIONS ISSUED TO DETACHMENTS OF CHEROKEE EMIGRANTS,

BY LEWIS ROSS CONTRACTOR FOR SUBSISTING THE CHEROKEE EMIGRATION IN THEIR REMOVAL WEST UNDER THE ARRANGEMENT MADE BY THE AUTHORITIES OF THE CHEROKEE NATION, WITH MAJOR GENERAL WINFIELD SCOTT, U.S. ARMY, IN BEHALF OF THE UNITED STATES GOVT. COMMENCING ON THE FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER 1838 AND ENDING ON THE TWENTY FIFTH DAY OF MARCH 1839.
