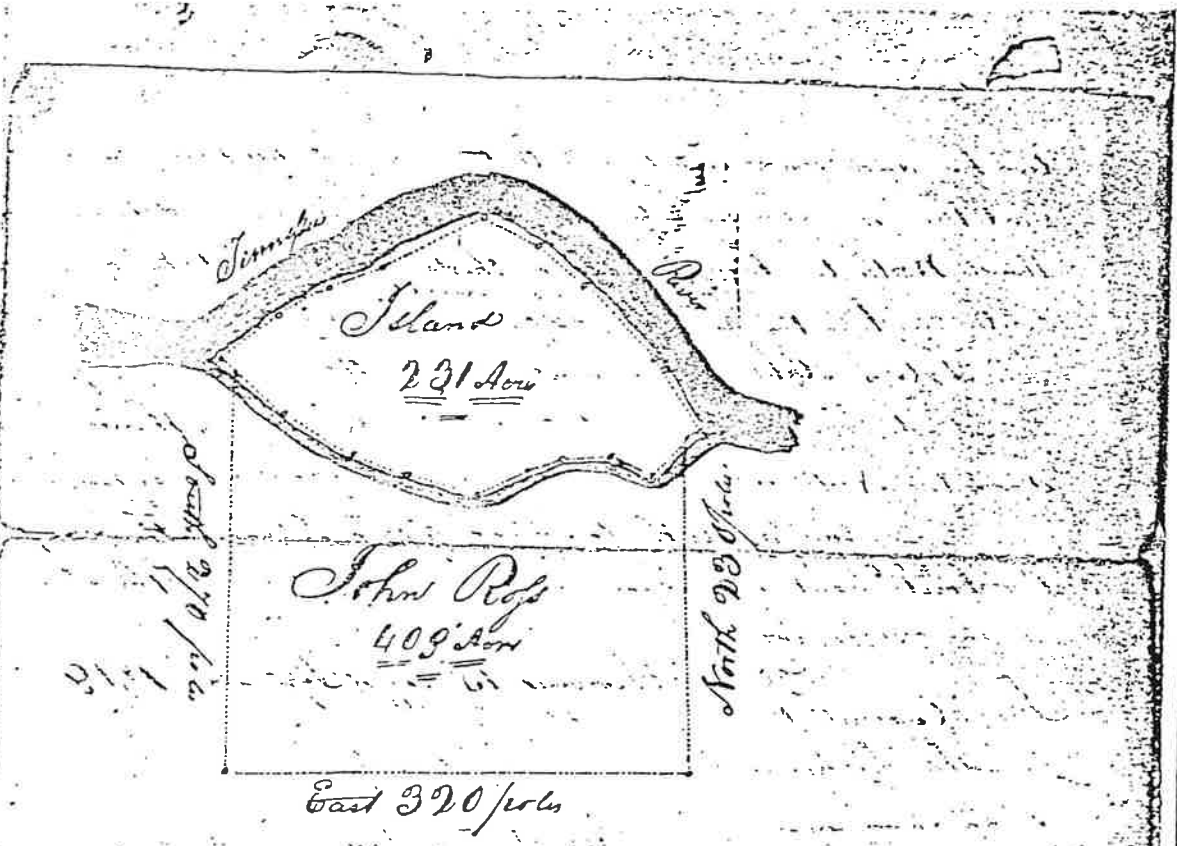

MANUSCRIPT DIVISION AC. NO 1787



State of Tennessee

The undersigned Commissioners and Surveyors (duly authorized) have agreed to the terms of the late Cherokee Treaty concluded at the City of Washington, on the twenty seventh day of February one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, surveyed and laid off to John Ross six hundred and forty acres of lands, including the big Island in Tennessee River, in the center being the first below Tellico. Beginning at a stake, and marked tree on the South bank of the River and pole above the low point of said Island; thence South
