



(The undersigned) Commissioner and Surveyor (duly authorized) have agreed to the terms of the late Cherokee Treaty concluded at the City of Washington on the twenty-seventh day of February one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, surveyed and laid off to Richard Timberlake six hundred and forty acres of land. Beginning at two white oak saplings and a dogwood, in a little hollow on the north bank of North Chickamauga creek thence North three hundred and twenty poles, (crossing the creek at sixty eight poles, and also at two hundred and fifty eight poles) to a black gum tree; thence East three hundred and twenty poles, (crossing the creek at fifty four poles) to a black oak tree on the top of a high ridge; thence
