Look for red lines of principal trails
4. Cherokee Removal Records, in particular the records of the Commissioner General of subsistence and of the First Board, the Second and Third Boards, and the Fourth Board of Cherokee Commissioners. Field Papers, Cherokees, Boxes 1-4
