(Sir) I have the honor to advise you that transportation has been required of me by the Supt. of the Cherokee removal for 1200 Emigrants from their homes, to the mouths of the Salisaw, Illinois, and Grand Rivers -

These will be embarked upon the Tennessee River about the 1st of Proximo, will take Steam transportation at the foot of the muscle Shoals about the 10th of March, and no accidents opposing, will probably reach their ultimate destinations from the 20th to 25th same month.

I shall calculate to subsist the above, to from 5 to 7 days after their arrival at their respective points of debarkation.

In addition to the above it is estimated that from three to five hundred Cherokees will transport themselves.

These together with the greater part of the others will probably prefer Commutation for the years rations allowed them after their arrival in Arkansas.
