#### **Minutes**

On motion of Mr. Keefe, seconded by Mr. Caputo, the board approved the September 2022 regular board meeting minutes. Vote: 5 - yes, 0 - no, 0 - abstain, 0 - absent.

#### **Executive Director's Report**

Mr. Kennedy reported that financial performance continued to be solid year to date vis-à-vis budget for both revenue and expenses. He noted that staffing progress continues to be solid and that all elevators of the New Brunswick Parking Authority in all facilities were functioning normally.

Mr. Kennedy additionally reported that the routine structural inspections of parking facilities would be underway in the coming weeks.

### Finance

Mr. Rajaratnam reported that year-to-date revenue was \$21 million and year-to-date expenses \$13 million, noting that the NBPA was right on budget so far.

### Legal

No legal to report.

#### **Public Comment**

A member of the public asked for a summary of the proposed 2023 budget and how it compares to the 2022 budget, and he asked what the total debt of the NBPA was. Mr. Rajaratnam stated that the current bonds payable amount was \$219 million. A member of the public asked for a status update on the

unoccupied Wellness Plaza tenant space leased by the county. Mr. McTernan noted that contractual elements were being finalized for a potential interior demolition project for the space. A member of the public asked if the NBPA was including within the 2023 budget the rent from the county for its leased space in Wellness Plaza, and Mr. Rajaratnam replied that about \$65,000 per month was budgeted. Mr. Minchello noted that the budget would be a publicly available document.

## 2023 AUTHORITY BUDGET RESOLUTION

New Brunswick Parking Authority

FISCAL YEAR: January 01, 2023 to December 31, 2023

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for New Brunswick Parking Authority for the fiscal year beginning January 01, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 has been presented before the governing body of the New Brunswick Parking Authority at its open public meeting of October 26, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$41,604,938.00, Total Appropriations including any Accumulated Deficit, if any, of \$31,121,036.00, and Total Unrestriced Net Position planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$0.00; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$2,100,000.00 and Total Unrestricted Net Position planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$2,100,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rents, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the New Brunswick Parking Authority, at an open public meeting held on October 26, 2022 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the New Brunswick Parking Authority for the fiscal year beginning January 01, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023, is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the said Parking Authority's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body of the New Brunswick Parking Authority will consider the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program for Adoption on December 14, 2022.
