

New Brunswick Parking Authority Enforcing Handicapped Parking

1. Parking Meters

• Handicap parkers are not granted free parking at the meters. Once the maximum time allowable on the parking meter is paid up to 24 hours, continuous use of the parking space is allowed. In other words, parking beyond the time limit is allowed once the maximum time previously paid.

2. NBPA Parking Facilities

• There are ample handicap parking spaces available throughout our facilities. Spaces are accessible nearby the entrances, the elevators, stairs, and exits of all our facilities. The monthly and daily rates are listed on our website at <u>www.njnbpa.org</u> and at each of our facilities.

3. Alternate Side

• Handicap parkers are not exempt from street sweeping, alternate side street parking, The only exemptions are the ones who have their own designated handicap parking space or zone in front of their resident.

4. Permit Parking

• Handicap parkers are not exempt when parked in a residential area that requires a permit. In order to park in a residential parking area, vehicle must display a valid residential parking permit. The permit parking rule applies for all, no exception.

5. Handicapped Parking Zones/ Space

Applicant must meet certain criteria as established by the City Ordinances sub sections 10.20.10 and 10.20.020 and are subject to annual renewal. Requirement: A valid Disabled ID Card, Vehicle Registration, and Drivers' License.
