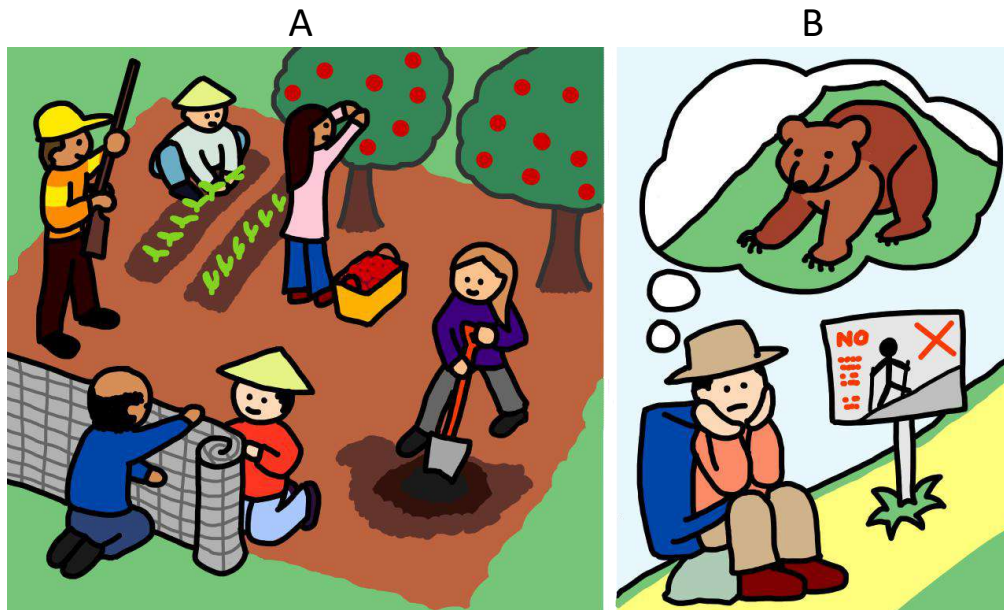


Protecting Farms
