

# FADE

## ANNUAL RYEGRASS

*Lolium multiflorum*

### DESCRIPTION

Fade is a Turf-Type Annual Ryegrass with a more attractive appearance and improved turf quality compared to Gulf Annual Ryegrass. It is an alternative to more persistent and competitive Perennial or Intermediate Ryegrasses and it is a popular choice as a nurse grass with cool-season species. Fade is quick to germinate and establish, is durable against wear, and is fast to check out in spring. It exhibits consistent color and density quality. Fade Annual Ryegrass is a great option for budget conscious turf managers and is adapted to both cool and warm season regions for temporary turf.

### APPLICATION

- Golf course turf, sports turf
- Use in Ryegrass blends up to 33% or 5-20% by weight in cool-season mixtures as a nurse grass
- Use as temporary cover to improve turf quality and stabilize soil

Cool-season and warm-season zones, winter overseeding of Bermudagrass turf in warm-season zone
