KENTUCKY BLUEGRASS

Poa pratensis

DESCRIPTION

It takes a Fullback to carry these qualifications: Best statistical performance in schedules A, B, C, Northeast, Transition, North Central, and Upper Midwest/Mountain Zone. #1 Traffic Tolerance at Wisconsin, and A-LIST quality. Fullback has excellent seedling vigor and establishment, spring green up, summer density and drought performance (wilting and dormancy), and low seed head expression. This Kentucky Bluegrass variety also has great winter color and is an outstanding competitor to *Poa annua*. Fullback Kentucky Bluegrass exhibits Super Elite performance across trials: #1 Rated Summer Patch at Tennessee and tied for #1 Mean Turfgrass Quality Rating out of 110 entries.
