Woodall Chewings Fescue, *Festuca rubra var. falax*, is excellent for use in shade, low input mixtures, and blends requiring reduced fertilizer, irrigation and mowing which saves time and money. It excels in sun and shade mixtures for lawn and golf course rough use. Woodall Chewings Fescue was developed and tested in the transition zone.
