DESCRIPTION

Gallop is a new and improved Turf-Type Perennial Ryegrass for use on heavy-use sports fields and on the golf course, as well as lawn applications that demand turf quality, disease, and traffic performance. The color and texture of Gallop blend well with other cool-season grasses. Its ability to tolerate a low height of cut make it an excellent companion in seed mixtures used for establishing professional turf as well as overseeding both cool and warm season grasses.
