Sweden

The Swedish Workplace Program (SWP) has a six-step approach that managers and employees utilize:

- 1. Getting everyone onboard
- 2. Workplace committee
- 3. Identify problem and create an action plan
- 4. Implement action plan
- 5. Monitor and evaluate learnings
- 6. Share best practices









Sustainability

>>>> A workplace that practices minimizing their negative impact to the environment and reduce waste of resources.

>>>> It focuses on balancing the planet, people, and profit to produce long-term success.



Sustainable Business Practices









Lighting

LED lights use 75% less energy and last 25 times longer

LED bulb can outlast a CFL 3 to 5 times and 30 times longer than an incandescent bulb

By 2035, the majority of lighting installations are expected to use LED technology




Recycling

Glass and metals are often overlooked, but by including these in your recycled items.

Melting the raw materials to make new glass accounts for 75-85% of CO2 emissions from glass production.

To create new metal, we must use natural resources, specifically iron ore, and coal.









Paper Use

Using paper in the digital age

Producing recycled paper involves between 28% and 70% less energy consumption

10% of deforestation is due to creating paper



Break Rooms

Provide reusable cups, mugs, and silverware instead of using disposables.

Utilize a composting program for food scraps.

Replacing stir-sticks and plastic cutlery with washable or biodegradable options (wooden, bio-plastics, etc.)

Use biodegradable coffee pods.











Water Saving Fixtures

1% of Earth's water is available for humans

Each American uses, on average, about 82 gallons of water per day at home

The initial investment may require a substantial amount of money, but the return will be well worth it.

Renewable Energy

Marketing opportunities, reduction of emissions, and lower energy costs

US Government incentive programs allow for a faster financial return

Motion Sensor Lighting

Simplest solution: make a sign and post it next to a set of lights

Most cost-effective is to utilize sensor lights as much as possible

In a typical commercial building, a business can lower energy consumption by roughly 30% with motion sensor lights.











Buy Remanufactured Cartridges

Ink and toner cartridges contribute a massive amount of waste to landfills.

You can save your business 15-50% per order by purchasing remanufactured cartridges.

There are companies that will pick up your old and used cartridges and deliver remanufactured ones for free.



Apply Window Film

Utilizing window film in the hot summer months reduces the use of air conditioning.

Air conditioners consume a very large amount of electricity from power grids.

It is thin and transparent and also uses metallic atoms to reflect heat from the sun.

Benefits of Promoting Sustainability






Reduce Carbon Footprint

Your company is actively working towards bettering the environment and its employees.

Consumers worldwide have become more aware of the environmental impact that surrounds them.











Company Culture

By making sustainability a core value in your company, it becomes an essential and ingrained part of the culture.

Employers who encourage a more conscious workforce clearly demonstrate that all who work there consider their actions.



Staff Loyalty/ Retention

Employees working at companies with sustainable practices set in place see the respect and loyalty the company has for them.

The employees themselves become more engaged and return their loyalty to the company.







Reduce Company Costs

Businesses can save money on disposal fees, transportation costs, and energy bills when they reduce their waste output.

It is estimated that if a company chooses to implement and enforce sustainable practices, it could save billions.



Higher Productivity
