Organization Terms of Service

Updated: June 16, 2026

These Organization Terms of Service (the "Organization Terms") govern access to and use of the Win For Wildlife platform, websites, dashboards, software, tools, content, documentation, and related services (collectively, the "Platform") by nonprofit organizations, charities, conservation organizations, schools, chapters, clubs, associations, and other approved fundraising entities (each, an "Organization," "you," or "your"). These Organization Terms are between you and Win For Wildlife, Inc. ("Win For Wildlife," "Company," "we," "us," or "our").

By creating an Organization account, clicking to accept, signing an order form, launching a campaign, or otherwise using the Platform on behalf of an Organization, you represent that you have authority to bind that Organization and you agree to these Organization Terms. If you do not agree, do not use the Platform.

1. Document structure; priority

These Organization Terms incorporate by reference: (a) our Buyer/User Terms of Use for individual purchasers, donors, entrants, visitors, and other end users; (b) our Acceptable Use Policy; (c) our Global Privacy Policy; (d) any posted product-specific terms; (e) any written order form, subscription plan, statement of work, or campaign approval issued by us; (f) each campaign's official rules, terms, permit disclosures, prize descriptions, and eligibility requirements; and (g) the terms and policies of Stripe, including the Stripe Connected Account Agreement and Stripe Services Agreement, to the extent payment processing is used.

If there is a conflict, the following order controls unless applicable law requires otherwise: (1) a signed written agreement with us; (2) campaign-specific official rules approved for publication; (3) these Organization Terms; (4) the Acceptable Use Policy; (5) the Buyer/User Terms; and (6) general website terms or help-center materials.

2. The Platform and our role

Win For Wildlife provides technology that helps approved Organizations create, promote, administer, and report on fundraising campaigns, including charitable raffles, 50/50 raffles, sweepstakes, giveaways, donations, event-related sales, auctions, and other fundraising formats that we may support from time to time (each, a "Campaign").

Win For Wildlife is a technology provider. Unless a written agreement says otherwise, we are not the sponsor, promoter, operator, beneficiary, professional fundraiser, commercial co-venturer, gaming operator, broker, escrow agent, fiduciary, trustee, legal advisor, tax advisor, accounting advisor, or insurer for any Campaign. The Organization is the sponsor

and operator of its Campaign and is responsible for its legality, content, rules, prizes, winner selection requirements, tax treatment, participant communications, recordkeeping, reporting, refunds, and fulfillment.

We may provide compliance tools, geolocation tools, payment workflows, RNG or draw tools, audit logs, campaign templates, reminders, guidance, and dashboards. These tools are designed to reduce risk, but they do not constitute legal authorization, legal advice, tax advice, accounting advice, or a representation that your Campaign is lawful in any jurisdiction. The availability of a feature does not mean you are permitted to use that feature.

3. Eligibility

To use the Platform as an Organization, you must: (a) be an eligible nonprofit, charity, tax-exempt organization, conservation organization, school, chapter, club, association, or other entity approved by us; (b) maintain all registrations, tax-exempt status, corporate good standing, charitable solicitation registrations, gaming/raffle/sweepstakes licenses, and other authorizations required for your activities; (c) use a bank account and Stripe Connected Account held in the Organization's legal name unless we approve another structure in writing; (d) appoint an authorized representative with legal authority to bind the Organization and complete onboarding, identity, tax, bank-account, and payment-verification requirements; and (e) use the Platform only for lawful public-benefit fundraising purposes approved by us.

You may not use the Platform for personal crowdfunding, fundraising primarily for the direct benefit of a named individual or family, debt repayment, bail, fines, litigation, political candidate campaigns, unlawful lobbying, or any other use prohibited by our Acceptable Use Policy, Stripe's restricted-business rules, or applicable law. We may reject, suspend, or terminate any Organization, Campaign, prize, beneficiary, transaction, payout, or account if we determine or reasonably suspect that it is ineligible, unlawful, misleading, too risky, or inconsistent with our mission or policies.

4. Accounts and authorized users

You must provide accurate, current, and complete information and keep it updated. You are responsible for all actions taken through your account, including actions by administrators, employees, contractors, volunteers, chapters, agents, and other users you invite or permit to use your account ("Authorized Users"). You must maintain appropriate internal controls over user roles, passwords, MFA, bank-account changes, prize approvals, Campaign launches, refunds, exports, and payout settings.

You must notify us promptly at support@winforwildlife.com of any suspected unauthorized access, compromised credentials, payment-account issue, data incident, suspicious transaction, or misuse of the Platform. We may require MFA, additional verification, documentation, legal opinions, board approvals, government filings, prize documentation, or other information before enabling or continuing access to any feature.

5. Campaign rules, permits, and legal compliance

You are solely responsible for determining whether each Campaign is lawful in every jurisdiction where you offer, advertise, sell entries, accept donations, ship prizes, or otherwise solicit support. This includes, without limitation, compliance with nonprofit governance rules, charitable solicitation laws, raffle and lottery laws, sweepstakes and contest laws, AMOE requirements, state and local gaming approvals, federal and state tax rules, consumer protection laws, advertising laws, accessibility laws, privacy laws, sanctions laws, anti-money-laundering requirements, and all recordkeeping and reporting obligations.

For each Campaign, you must publish accurate, clear, and complete official rules and disclosures, including as applicable: sponsor name; eligibility; age and location restrictions; campaign start and end dates; entry methods; purchase price; donation treatment; odds or odds methodology; prize description and approximate retail value; drawing date and method; winner notification and verification procedures; tax obligations; refund policy; shipping or pickup restrictions; permit/license numbers; AMOE/no-purchase-necessary instructions; prohibited participants; and any other disclosures required by law or by us.

You may not launch or operate a Campaign unless you have obtained all required permits, licenses, registrations, approvals, consents, prize documentation, insurance, and official rules. You must promptly provide copies of these materials to us on request and must promptly update the Platform if anything changes.

6. Raffles, 50/50s, sweepstakes, giveaways, and AMOE

Raffles, lotteries, 50/50s, sweepstakes, giveaways, contests, and other chance-based Campaigns are highly regulated. You may use these features only where permitted by law, approved by us, and supported by Stripe or the applicable payment provider. You acknowledge that a Campaign may be lawful in one jurisdiction and unlawful or restricted in another.

For sweepstakes and giveaways, you are responsible for ensuring that no purchase is necessary where required, that any alternate method of entry has equal dignity and timing, that any bonding or registration requirements are satisfied, that free entries are processed fairly, and that official rules accurately describe all material terms.

For raffles and 50/50s, you are responsible for ticket pricing, permit eligibility, prize limits, drawing procedures, winner verification, reporting, and compliance with any requirement that funds be used for approved charitable purposes. You may not alter, cancel, substitute prizes, change odds, change eligibility, extend deadlines, or change drawing procedures except as allowed by the official rules, applicable law, and our policies.

We may use geolocation, address verification, IP screening, card or payment-method restrictions, age gates, state gating, compliance holds, audit logs, seed numbers, cryptographic draw records, video or timestamp tools, and other controls. These controls are risk-reduction tools only and do not transfer legal responsibility from you to us.

7. Prizes, winner selection, fulfillment, and taxes

You are solely responsible for sourcing, owning or having the right to award, describing, valuing, insuring, shipping, delivering, substituting, and fulfilling all prizes. You must not list a prize unless it is lawful to offer, advertise, transfer, and deliver in every applicable jurisdiction and under Stripe's rules and our Acceptable Use Policy. Prizes involving firearms, ammunition, regulated weapons, hunting trips, travel, animals, alcohol, controlled goods, high-value items, or other regulated items require advance written approval from us and may be prohibited or restricted.

You are responsible for winner eligibility, identity verification, background checks where applicable, tax reporting, Forms W-9/1099, withholding, winner affidavits, liability releases, publicity releases, and any government filings. We may assist with workflows, but we are not responsible for prize fulfillment or tax compliance.

8. Payments, fees, refunds, chargebacks, and payouts

Payment processing is provided by Stripe or another payment provider we approve. You must maintain an active, compliant payment account and agree to all applicable payment-provider terms. We do not control Stripe's underwriting, reserves, holds, payouts, account suspension, chargeback decisions, ACH timing, card-network rules, or payment-method limitations.

You authorize us and our payment providers to process transactions, deduct or collect platform fees, processing fees, optional tips, subscription fees, refunds, chargebacks, reversals, negative balances, taxes, and other amounts owed. Unless a written agreement states otherwise, fees paid to us are non-refundable. We may invoice you or debit amounts from payouts or payment accounts where permitted.

You are responsible for publishing and honoring your Campaign refund policy. Entries, tickets, donations, bids, purchases, and tips are generally final unless the official rules, applicable law, or our policies require otherwise. We may pause, reject, refund, reverse, or hold transactions or payouts if required by law, payment-provider rules, risk controls, suspected fraud, Campaign cancellation, eligibility issues, or misuse of the Platform.

9. Organization content and user-generated content license

You retain ownership of content you submit, upload, post, import, or otherwise provide through the Platform, including Campaign descriptions, logos, photos, videos, messages, official rules, prize descriptions, donor lists, supporter communications, forum posts, and other materials ("Organization Content").

You grant Win For Wildlife and our service providers a perpetual, non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid, transferable and sublicensable license to host, store, copy, display, perform, reproduce, distribute, transmit, modify, adapt, create derivative works from, use, and otherwise exploit Organization Content and other user-generated content for the purpose of operating, improving, securing, promoting, and providing the Platform, administering Campaigns, providing support, complying with law, creating audit

records, and marketing the Platform and your Campaigns, subject to our Global Privacy Policy and any written confidentiality obligations. This license includes content posted in any forum, community, message board, chat, review, comment, activity feed, or similar public or semi-public feature.

You represent and warrant that you have all rights, permissions, consents, licenses, releases, and authority necessary to provide Organization Content and grant this license; that the Organization Content is accurate and not misleading; and that it does not violate law, third-party rights, privacy rights, publicity rights, intellectual property rights, or our Acceptable Use Policy. We may remove, moderate, disable, or refuse Organization Content at any time.

10. Data, privacy, and communications

Our Global Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect personal information. You are responsible for providing any notices and obtaining any consents required for personal information you upload, import, collect, or process through the Platform, including donor lists, participant lists, email addresses, phone numbers, custom form responses, and marketing preferences.

"Campaign Participant Data" means personal information and related Campaign activity data associated with individuals who purchase, donate, enter, bid, register for, win, claim, or otherwise participate in a Campaign through the Platform, including name, email address, phone number, mailing address, residency or location information, eligibility information, transaction status, donation or purchase history, ticket numbers, entry records, bid history, receipts, refund requests, winner verification information, communications, marketing preferences, and related Campaign participation records.

When a User participates in your Campaign through the Platform, you acknowledge that Win For Wildlife and you may each collect, receive, use, retain, analyze, and disclose Campaign Participant Data as described in the Global Privacy Policy, these Organization Terms, the applicable Campaign disclosures, and applicable law. Win For Wildlife may use Campaign Participant Data to provide, operate, secure, improve, personalize, analyze, and market the Platform and Campaigns; provide fundraising, analytics, audience-development, retargeting, reporting, benchmarking, and marketing services to Organizations; help Organizations understand and communicate with supporters; recommend Campaigns or Organizations to Users; and otherwise as described in the Global Privacy Policy.

You may use Campaign Participant Data made available to you through the Platform to administer Campaigns, communicate with participants, issue receipts, fulfill prizes, comply with legal and recordkeeping obligations, and, subject to applicable law, your own privacy notices, and Users' marketing preferences, conduct supporter outreach, fundraising, stewardship, and marketing. Neither party acquires ownership of a User's personal information in a manner that limits the User's rights under applicable privacy, consumer protection, marketing, or communications laws.

As between you and us, you are responsible for your direct relationships with purchasers, donors, entrants, members, volunteers, winners, and other supporters. You must use Platform exports, reports, and personal information only for lawful purposes and in accordance with your posted privacy notices, our Global Privacy Policy, and applicable law. You must not use the Platform to send unlawful marketing, spam, misleading messages, or messages inconsistent with a user's opt-out choices.

We may use aggregated, anonymized, de-identified, or usage data to operate, analyze, improve, benchmark, secure, and market the Platform, provided that such data does not identify an individual or your confidential Organization Content.

11. Confidentiality

Each party may receive non-public information from the other party that is marked confidential or should reasonably be understood as confidential. The receiving party will use confidential information only to perform or receive services, will protect it using reasonable care, and will disclose it only to personnel, advisors, service providers, and authorities who have a need to know and are subject to confidentiality or legal obligations. Confidential information does not include information that is public without breach, independently developed, lawfully received from a third party, or required to be disclosed by law.

12. Intellectual property, feedback, and publicity

We and our licensors own the Platform, software, documentation, designs, workflows, templates, data models, audit tools, analytics, APIs, trademarks, service marks, logos, and other intellectual property. No rights are granted except the limited right to access and use the Platform during the term and in accordance with these Organization Terms.

If you provide ideas, suggestions, requests, or feedback, you grant us a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free right to use them without restriction or compensation.

Unless you opt out in writing, you authorize us to identify you as a customer and to use your name and logo in customer lists, proposals, investor materials, and sales presentations. We will not issue a press release announcing our relationship without your consent.

13. Availability, support, changes, and beta features

We may modify, suspend, discontinue, or limit all or part of the Platform at any time. We do not guarantee uninterrupted or error-free availability. Support, service levels, beta features, implementation services, and custom development are provided only if expressly agreed in writing.

Beta, pilot, experimental, or pre-release features are provided for evaluation only, may be modified or discontinued at any time, may contain errors, and should not be relied upon for legal compliance without your independent review.

14. Suspension and termination

We may suspend or terminate your account, any Authorized User, any Campaign, any payout, any transaction, or any feature immediately if we determine or reasonably suspect: (a) a violation of these Organization Terms, the Acceptable Use Policy, Stripe rules, or law; (b) fraudulent, misleading, risky, or abusive activity; (c) a security risk or data incident; (d) missing or inaccurate onboarding information; (e) payment-provider suspension; (f) regulatory inquiry; or (g) that suspension is necessary to protect us, users, Organizations, payment providers, regulators, or the public.

You may stop using the Platform at any time, subject to your payment obligations, Campaign obligations, recordkeeping duties, and any signed agreement. Upon termination, your right to access the Platform ends, but provisions that by their nature should survive will survive, including payment obligations, licenses, confidentiality, disclaimers, limitations of liability, indemnities, dispute resolution, and recordkeeping provisions.

15. Disclaimers

THE PLATFORM IS PROVIDED "AS IS" AND "AS AVAILABLE." TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, WE DISCLAIM ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESS, IMPLIED, STATUTORY, OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TITLE, QUIET ENJOYMENT, NON-INFRINGEMENT, ACCURACY, AVAILABILITY, SECURITY, AND ERROR-FREE OPERATION.

WE DO NOT WARRANT THAT ANY CAMPAIGN IS LAWFUL, THAT ANY FEATURE WILL SATISFY LEGAL REQUIREMENTS, THAT ANY GEOLOCATION OR PAYMENT CONTROL WILL BLOCK ALL INELIGIBLE USERS, THAT ANY OFFICIAL RULES ARE COMPLETE, THAT ANY DRAW OR RNG PROCESS WILL SATISFY A PARTICULAR REGULATOR, OR THAT ANY CAMPAIGN WILL ACHIEVE A PARTICULAR FUNDRAISING RESULT.

16. Indemnification

You will indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Win For Wildlife and its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, contractors, agents, service providers, licensors, and payment partners from and against all claims, demands, investigations, penalties, fines, losses, liabilities, damages, costs, and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, arising out of or related to: (a) your Campaigns; (b) your Organization Content; (c) your prizes, rules, permits, refunds, taxes, winner selection, fulfillment, or communications; (d) your use or misuse of the Platform; (e) your violation of these Organization Terms, the Acceptable Use Policy, Stripe rules, or law; (f) your relationship with any purchaser, donor, entrant, winner, regulator, sponsor, chapter, or beneficiary; or (g) your negligence, fraud, willful misconduct, or infringement of third-party rights.

17. Limitation of liability

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, WIN FOR WILDLIFE WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, EXEMPLARY, PUNITIVE, OR ENHANCED DAMAGES, LOST PROFITS, LOST REVENUE, LOST GOODWILL, LOST DATA,

LOSS OF USE, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, CAMPAIGN FAILURE, PAYMENT DELAY, REGULATORY ACTION, OR COST OF SUBSTITUTE SERVICES, EVEN IF ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, OUR TOTAL LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THESE ORGANIZATION TERMS OR THE PLATFORM WILL NOT EXCEED THE GREATER OF (A) THE PLATFORM FEES ACTUALLY PAID TO US BY YOU FOR THE SPECIFIC CAMPAIGN GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM DURING THE THREE MONTHS BEFORE THE EVENT GIVING RISE TO LIABILITY, OR (B) \$100. THIS LIMITATION APPLIES REGARDLESS OF THEORY OF LIABILITY AND EVEN IF A REMEDY FAILS OF ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE.

18. Dispute resolution, arbitration, and class waiver

Before filing a claim, the parties will attempt in good faith to resolve the dispute informally. A party initiating a dispute must send written notice to legal@winforwildlife.com or to Win For Wildlife, Inc., Attn: Legal, 6341 Johnson Road, Bozeman, Montana 59718, describing the dispute and requested relief. The parties will confer by phone or video within 45 days unless mutually extended.

Except for claims that qualify for small claims court, claims for injunctive or equitable relief relating to intellectual property, confidentiality, data security, or unauthorized Platform use, and claims that cannot be arbitrated as a matter of law, any dispute arising out of or relating to these Organization Terms or the Platform will be resolved by binding arbitration administered by JAMS under its applicable rules. The Federal Arbitration Act governs the arbitration agreement. Arbitration will be conducted on an individual basis only. Class actions, representative actions, collective actions, class-wide arbitration, and jury trials are waived to the maximum extent permitted by law.

19. Governing law and venue

These Organization Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Delaware, without regard to conflict-of-law rules, except that the Federal Arbitration Act governs arbitration. For disputes not subject to arbitration, the parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts located in Delaware, unless applicable law requires a different forum.

20. General

You may not assign these Organization Terms without our prior written consent. We may assign them in connection with a merger, acquisition, financing, corporate reorganization, sale of assets, or by operation of law. These Organization Terms do not create a partnership, joint venture, agency, fiduciary, employment, or franchise relationship. If any provision is unenforceable, it will be modified to the minimum extent necessary, and the remaining provisions will remain in effect. Our failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver. These Organization Terms, together with incorporated terms, are the entire agreement regarding your use of the Platform as an Organization.

Buyer/User Terms of Use

Updated: June 16, 2026

These Buyer/User Terms of Use (the "User Terms") govern your access to and use of the Win For Wildlife website, platform, purchaser portal, buyer dashboard, donation pages, campaign pages, communications, content, and related services (collectively, the "Platform"). These User Terms are between you and Win For Wildlife, Inc. ("Win For Wildlife," "Company," "we," "us," or "our").

By visiting the Platform, creating an account, purchasing an entry or ticket, making a donation, submitting an alternate method of entry, bidding, posting content, or otherwise using the Platform, you agree to these User Terms. If you do not agree, do not use the Platform.

1. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old and legally able to enter into a binding contract. You may participate in a Campaign only if you satisfy the eligibility requirements in the applicable official rules, including any age, residency, location, employee/insider, licensing, payment-method, and other restrictions. We may use geolocation, address verification, identity checks, payment controls, and other tools to assess eligibility, but eligibility remains subject to the official rules and applicable law.

If you are located where use of the Platform, a Campaign, a payment method, or a prize is prohibited, you may not participate. We may deny, void, cancel, refund, reverse, suspend, or block any entry, ticket, donation, bid, purchase, prize, account, or transaction if we determine or reasonably suspect that you are ineligible, the Campaign is not available in your location, the transaction is suspicious, or the transaction may violate law, payment-provider rules, or our policies.

2. Campaigns are operated by Organizations

Campaigns are created and operated by the nonprofit, charity, conservation organization, school, chapter, association, or other approved fundraising entity identified on the Campaign page (the "Organization"). Unless we expressly say otherwise in writing, Win For Wildlife is not the sponsor, promoter, operator, beneficiary, professional fundraiser, gaming operator, seller, merchant of record, broker, escrow agent, trustee, legal advisor, tax advisor, or insurer for any Campaign.

The Organization is responsible for Campaign official rules, eligibility, prize descriptions, odds, drawings, winner verification, refunds, tax documentation, fulfillment, and compliance with applicable laws. You should review the Campaign page and official rules carefully before participating.

3. Accounts and security

You may need an account to use certain Platform features. You must provide accurate and current information, keep your login credentials confidential, and promptly notify us at support@winforwildlife.com of suspected unauthorized access. You are responsible for all activity under your account unless caused by our failure to use reasonable security measures.

4. Payments, entries, donations, bids, tips, and fees

Payment processing is provided by Stripe or another payment provider. By making a payment, you authorize the payment provider to charge your selected payment method for the amount shown at checkout, including entries, tickets, donations, bids, purchases, platform fees, processing fees, optional tips, shipping, taxes, and other charges disclosed to you.

We do not store full payment-card numbers. Payment providers may collect and process payment information under their own terms and privacy notices. Payment-provider rules may delay, hold, reject, refund, reverse, or otherwise affect transactions.

Unless the official rules or applicable law state otherwise, entries, tickets, donations, bids, purchases, tips, and fees are final and non-refundable. Refunds are generally available only if required by law, required by the official rules, approved by the Organization, or initiated by us due to cancellation, ineligibility, suspected fraud, payment-provider action, or legal/compliance concerns. Refund timing may depend on payment-method rules.

5. Raffles, 50/50s, sweepstakes, giveaways, and odds

Raffles, 50/50s, sweepstakes, giveaways, and other prize-based Campaigns are subject to official rules. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received unless the official rules state otherwise. No statement on the Platform guarantees that you will win or receive a prize.

For sweepstakes or giveaways where a no-purchase-necessary method is required, the official rules will describe the alternate method of entry. A purchase or donation will not improve your chance of winning where prohibited by law.

6. Prizes, winner verification, and taxes

Prizes are provided by the Organization or its prize suppliers, not by Win For Wildlife unless we expressly state otherwise. You may be required to verify identity, eligibility, residency, age, tax information, background-check eligibility, license status, shipping information, or compliance with law before receiving a prize. If you do not complete required verification, are ineligible, violate the rules, or cannot lawfully receive a prize, the Organization may disqualify you and select an alternate winner.

You are responsible for all taxes, reporting, licenses, permits, travel documents, background checks, transfer fees, shipping issues, and other obligations associated with any prize unless

the official rules state otherwise. We do not provide tax, legal, accounting, or financial advice.

7. Donations and tax receipts

Donations are made to the Organization identified on the Campaign page. We do not guarantee that any payment is tax-deductible or that you will receive a tax receipt. The Organization is responsible for tax receipts, charitable acknowledgments, and use of funds. Contact the Organization with questions about tax deductibility, receipts, or how funds will be used.

8. Campaign participant data and marketing rights

"Campaign Participant Data" means personal information and related Campaign activity information associated with your purchase, donation, entry, bid, registration, prize claim, or other participation in a Campaign through the Platform, including your name, email address, phone number, mailing address, residency or location information, eligibility information, transaction status, donation or purchase history, ticket numbers, entry records, bid history, receipts, refund requests, winner verification information, communications, marketing preferences, and related Campaign participation records.

When you participate in a Campaign, you acknowledge that Win For Wildlife and the Organization sponsoring or operating that Campaign may each collect, receive, use, retain, analyze, and disclose Campaign Participant Data as described in our Global Privacy Policy, applicable Campaign disclosures, the Organization's privacy notices, and applicable law.

The Organization sponsoring or operating a Campaign may use Campaign Participant Data it receives through the Platform to administer the Campaign, communicate with participants, issue receipts, fulfill prizes, comply with legal and recordkeeping obligations, and, subject to applicable law, its own privacy notices, and your marketing preferences, conduct supporter outreach, fundraising, stewardship, and marketing.

Win For Wildlife and Organizations do not acquire ownership of your personal information in a manner that limits your rights under applicable privacy, consumer protection, marketing, or communications laws. Each party's use of Campaign Participant Data remains subject to the Global Privacy Policy, applicable Campaign disclosures, applicable law, and any legally required consent, opt-out, deletion, correction, access, or other privacy rights.

9. User content and forum/community license

You may be able to submit, upload, post, message, comment, review, or otherwise provide content through the Platform, including profile information, messages, photos, videos, forum posts, comments, reviews, support requests, and other materials ("User Content"). You are solely responsible for your User Content and must ensure that it is accurate, lawful, non-infringing, and consistent with these User Terms and our Acceptable Use Policy.

You retain ownership of your User Content. You grant Win For Wildlife and our service providers a perpetual, non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid, transferable and sublicensable license to host, store, copy, display, perform, reproduce, distribute, transmit, modify, adapt, create derivative works from, use, and otherwise exploit your User Content for the purpose of operating, improving, securing, promoting, and providing the Platform, administering Campaigns, providing support, complying with law, creating audit records, and marketing the Platform and Campaigns, subject to our Global Privacy Policy. 10. Acceptable use

13. Availability, changes, suspension, and termination

We may modify, suspend, discontinue, or limit all or part of the Platform at any time. We may suspend or terminate your account, entries, transactions, access, or participation if we determine or reasonably suspect that you violated these User Terms, official rules, the Acceptable Use Policy, payment-provider rules, or law, or that suspension is necessary to protect us, Organizations, other users, payment providers, regulators, or the public.

WE DO NOT WARRANT THAT ANY CAMPAIGN IS LAWFUL, THAT ANY ORGANIZATION CONTENT IS ACCURATE, THAT ANY PRIZE DESCRIPTION IS COMPLETE, THAT ANY DRAW OR WINNER SELECTION WILL BE ERROR-FREE, THAT ANY GEOLOCATION TOOL WILL IDENTIFY EVERY INELIGIBLE USER, OR THAT YOU WILL WIN OR RECEIVE ANY PRIZE.

15. Limitation of liability

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, WIN FOR WILDLIFE WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, EXEMPLARY, PUNITIVE, OR ENHANCED DAMAGES, LOST PROFITS, LOST DATA, LOSS OF GOODWILL, CAMPAIGN CANCELLATION, PAYMENT DELAY, LOST OPPORTUNITY, OR PRIZE-RELATED DAMAGES, EVEN IF ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, OUR TOTAL LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THESE USER TERMS OR THE PLATFORM WILL NOT EXCEED THE GREATER OF (A) AMOUNTS YOU PAID THROUGH THE PLATFORM IN THE TRANSACTION GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM, EXCLUDING AMOUNTS PAID TO AN ORGANIZATION OR PAYMENT PROVIDER, OR (B) \$50.

16. Release and indemnification

17. Dispute resolution, arbitration, and class waiver

Before filing a claim, you and we will attempt in good faith to resolve the dispute informally. The notice must include your name, contact information, account email if applicable, a description of the dispute, and the relief requested.

Except for claims that qualify for small claims court, claims for injunctive or equitable relief relating to intellectual property, data security, or unauthorized Platform use, and claims that cannot be arbitrated as a matter of law, any dispute arising out of or relating to these User Terms or the Platform will be resolved by binding arbitration administered by JAMS under its applicable rules. The Federal Arbitration Act governs this arbitration agreement. Arbitration will be conducted on an individual basis only. Class actions, representative actions, collective actions, class-wide arbitration, and jury trials are waived to the maximum extent permitted by law.

You may opt out of arbitration by sending written notice to legal@winforwildlife.com within 30 days after first accepting these User Terms. Your opt-out notice must include your name, address, account email if any, and a clear statement that you want to opt out of arbitration.

18. Governing law and general terms

These User Terms are governed by Delaware law, without regard to conflict-of-law rules, except that the Federal Arbitration Act governs arbitration. If any provision is unenforceable, it will be modified to the minimum extent necessary, and the remaining provisions will remain in effect. We may assign these User Terms. You may not assign them without our consent. These User Terms, together with incorporated terms and official rules, are the entire agreement regarding your use of the Platform as a user.

Acceptable Use Policy

This Acceptable Use Policy ("AUP") applies to all use of the Win For Wildlife platform, websites, organization dashboards, buyer/user portals, campaign pages, fundraising, crowdfunding, raffle, sweepstakes, donation, auction, communication, and related services (the "Platform"). This AUP is incorporated into our Organization Terms of Service and Buyer/User Terms of Use.

You may use the Platform only for lawful, truthful, transparent, and approved nonprofit fundraising purposes. You are responsible for ensuring that your use of the Platform, your Campaigns, your prizes, your content, your transactions, and your beneficiaries comply with all applicable laws, Stripe's prohibited and restricted business rules, payment-network rules, and this AUP.

1. Stripe and payment-provider rules

The Platform uses Stripe or other payment providers for payment processing. You may not use the Platform for any activity, business, product, service, Campaign, prize, beneficiary, payout, or transaction that is prohibited or restricted by Stripe unless Stripe and Win For Wildlife have expressly approved the use in writing and all legal requirements are satisfied. Stripe's Prohibited and Restricted Businesses list is available at <https://stripe.com/legal/restricted-businesses> and may change over time.

If a payment provider rejects, restricts, suspends, holds, or terminates a payment account, transaction, payout, or Campaign, we may take corresponding action on the Platform.

2. Illegal activity and evasion

You may not use the Platform to fund, facilitate, promote, advertise, conceal, or support illegal activity, including illegal goods or services, fraud, scams, theft, bribery, corruption, money laundering, sanctions evasion, tax evasion, false identity information, fake documents, unauthorized access, cybercrime, card testing, chargeback evasion, or any transaction designed to circumvent law, payment-provider rules, or Platform controls.

You may not misrepresent your identity, entity status, tax-exempt status, beneficiary, Campaign purpose, prize source, prize value, legal approvals, permits, licenses, bank-account ownership, payment account, use of proceeds, or any material Campaign information.

Games of chance, raffles, 50/50s, sweepstakes, lotteries, contests, fantasy sports, prize competitions, and similar activities are prohibited unless they are expressly supported by the Platform, approved by Win For Wildlife, permitted by applicable law, permitted by Stripe or the payment provider, and operated in accordance with approved official rules and required permits.

You may not use the Platform for casino gambling, sports betting, fantasy sports for prizes, internet gambling, unauthorized lotteries, bidding-fee auctions, paid games of skill, or any payment of an entry or player fee that promises a prize of value outside an approved charitable Campaign structure. Sweepstakes must include a compliant no-purchase-necessary alternate method of entry where required by law.

5. Restricted or prohibited goods, prizes, and services

You may not use the Platform for Campaigns, transactions, prizes, or fundraising related to prohibited, illegal, or high-risk goods or services. Restricted categories include, without limitation:

- illegal drugs, controlled substances, drug paraphernalia, cannabis products, marijuana businesses, and certain CBD products;
- adult content, adult services, sexual services, or sexually explicit materials;

- wildlife contraband, illegally taken game, ivory, protected species, endangered species products, or other wildlife products prohibited by law;

- financial products, securities, investments, lending, debt relief, money transmission, cryptocurrency, NFTs, stored value, gift cards, prepaid cards, virtual currency, or other regulated financial products unless expressly approved;
- high-value goods, precious metals, jewelry, travel packages, timeshares, airline or charter travel, or other elevated-risk prizes unless approved by us and the payment provider; and
- any other product, service, prize, or Campaign prohibited or restricted by Stripe, payment networks, law, or our policies.

6. Personal crowdfunding and misuse of charitable fundraising

You may not use the Platform for personal crowdfunding, direct financial support of a named individual or family, personal medical bills, funeral costs, housing emergencies, personal education expenses, legal fees, bail, fines, debt repayment, personal projects, or similar purposes unless expressly approved by us and conducted by an eligible Organization through an established charitable program that complies with law.

You may not use the Platform for deceptive fundraising, fake testimonials, inflated prize values, misleading odds, hidden fees, unauthorized endorsements, bait-and-switch prizes, pressure tactics, false scarcity, undisclosed conflicts of interest, misleading tax-deductibility claims, misleading "winner" claims, unrealistic incentives, pyramid schemes, multilevel marketing, get-rich-quick schemes, no-value-added resale, or any unfair, deceptive, or abusive act or practice.

8. Content, communications, and user conduct

You may not post, upload, transmit, or distribute content that is unlawful, infringing, defamatory, harassing, abusive, threatening, hateful, discriminatory, obscene, sexually exploitative, invasive of privacy, harmful to minors, misleading, fraudulent, malicious, or otherwise objectionable.

You may not spam, scrape, harvest personal information, send unauthorized marketing, impersonate others, interfere with the Platform, attempt to access unauthorized areas, introduce malware, reverse engineer the Platform, overload systems, manipulate identifiers, bypass geolocation or eligibility controls, or use bots or automated tools except as authorized by us.

9. Compliance documentation and cooperation

We may take action without prior notice where we believe delay could create legal, payment, security, fraud, safety, reputational, or user-protection risk.
