As always, none of this would be possible without you — our supporters, advisors, and fellow believers in what's possible when we center generosity, proximity, and trust.

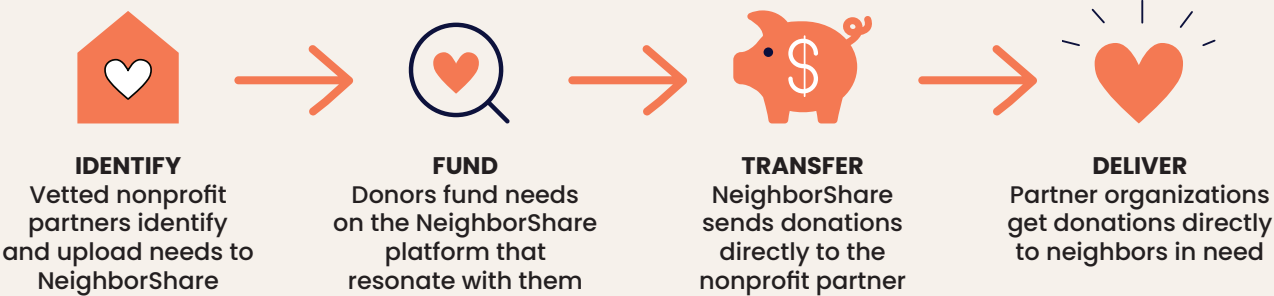

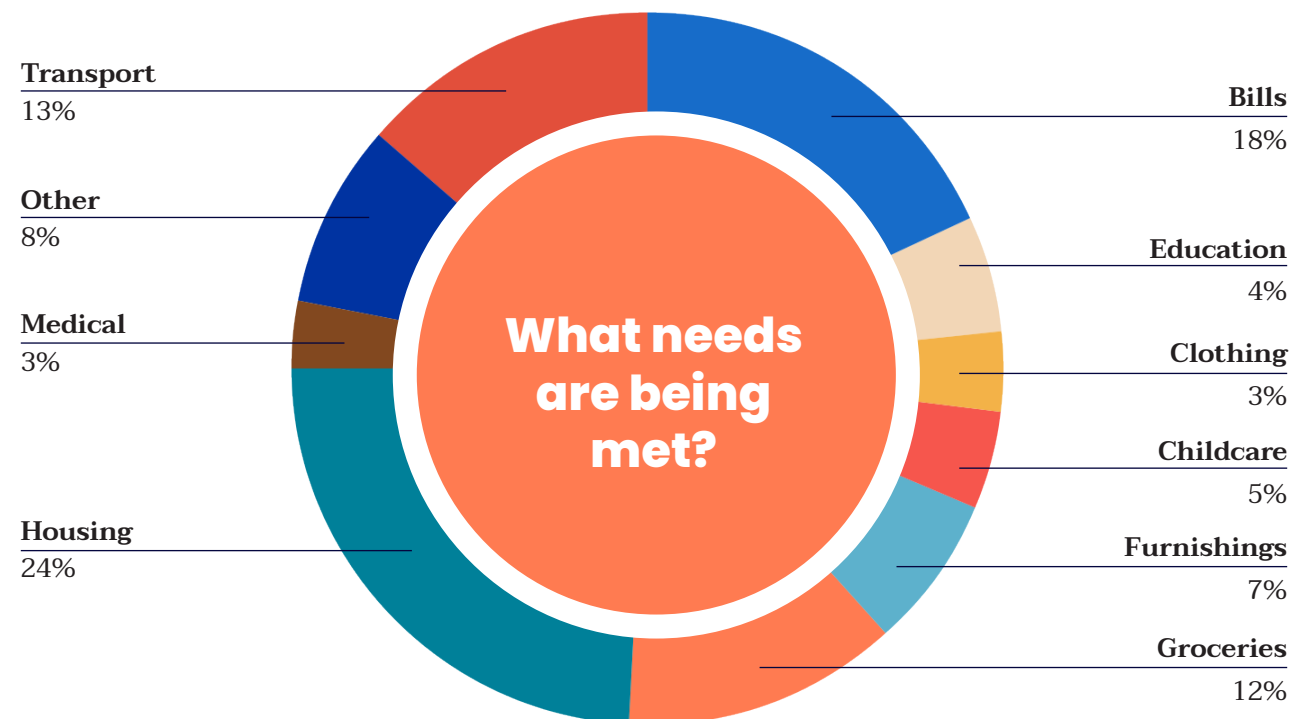

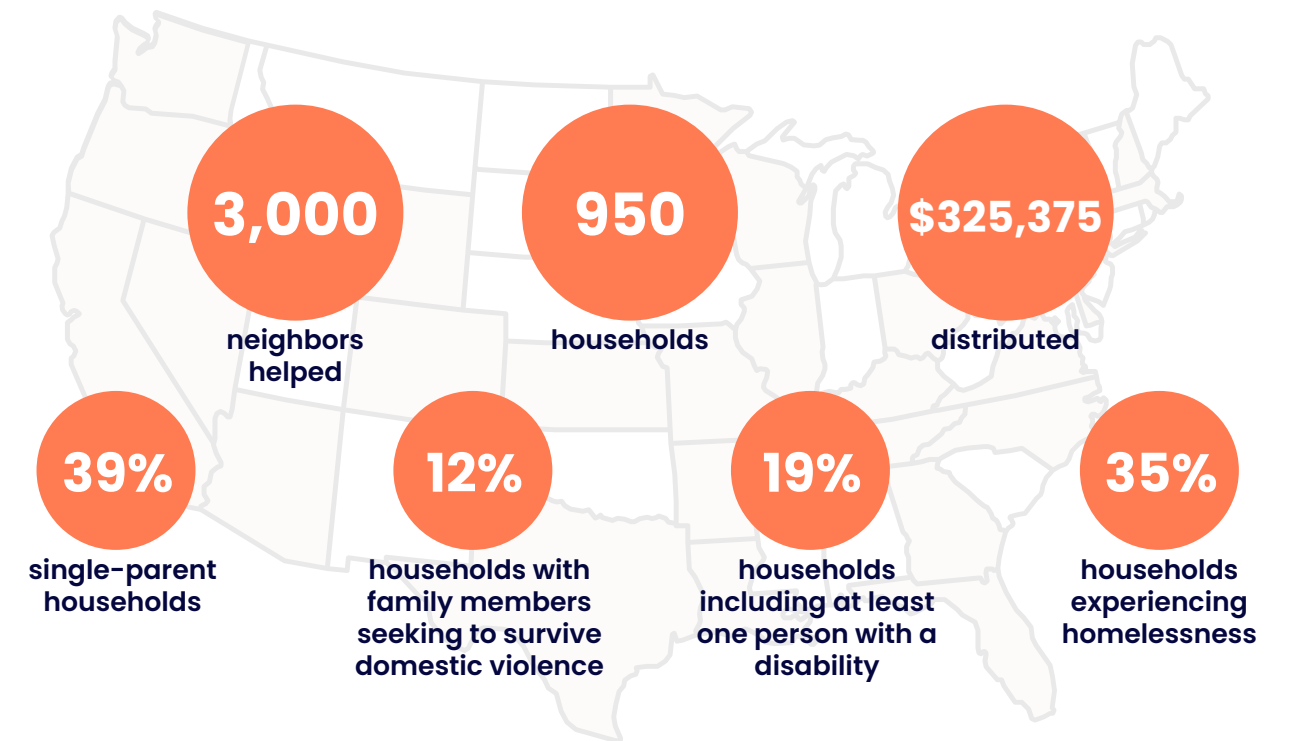

New Data Alert!

In 2024, we began collecting two new data points. We asked our referring nonprofit partners to report:

- Will this support help your client obtain or maintain stable housing?
- Will this support help your client obtain or maintain stable employment?

The results dramatically increased our understanding of NeighborShare's impact.

- Regardless of the need category request (housing or otherwise), **48%** of all neighbors indicated meeting their submitted need would help them obtain or maintain stable housing
- That number rose to **84%** for specific housing-related requests like rent assistance or a security deposit
- **30%** of neighbors indicated that meeting their submitted need would help them obtain or maintain stable employment

Impact Spotlight

In 2024, NeighborShare grew its impact to new communities and new partners across the country, helping households obtain new jobs, move into stable housing, access medical care, and more. Here are three highlights:

Creating job and income stability

Many of our partner organizations operate job training programs, provide people with professional coaching and application assistance, and connect people with job opportunities. But too often, people are one small step away from securing or keeping a good job when things fall through – their car breaks down, they have to purchase a uniform, or they can’t afford an extra few hours of childcare.

In 2024, NeighborShare helped someone in 300 households get or keep a stable job.

How we helped



James
Project Ropa, San Pedro CA

After a brief period of homelessness following a divorce, James was staying with his sister and commuting 10 miles to work each way by bicycle. When his bike was stolen, he was forced to rely on unreliable public transit which sometimes took over two hours each way. James was late to work twice in one month due to bus delays and was at risk of losing hours or even his job. While saving for a new bike, he just needed a little support to cover rideshare costs and stay on track. NeighborShare stepped in to fill that gap, helping James maintain steady employment and rebuild stability.

“What NeighborShare does, I cannot tell you the relief it brings. When you’re standing on \$0, \$400 is huge. Your gifts are often the difference between quitting or getting to the next level.”

Secure housing creates stability

Losing your home is one of the fastest ways to start a crisis spiral. Finding a way to keep people in their homes and/or secure stable housing is one of the most meaningful and most inexpensive ways to keep families on track. From security deposits to secure new, safe housing to bridging a rent payment that was redirected to a sudden medical expense, NeighborShare is there in times of housing crises.

In 2024, nearly half of the households NeighborShare donors helped reported that assistance would enable them to get or maintain stable housing.

How we helped



Imir
Center for Independence, Marysville, WA

Imir, a dedicated machinist, faced several months of unemployment due to complications from a disability. While working with the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) to secure employment and support, delays stalled his progress. Just as he secured a DVR appointment and referrals for rental aid and job opportunities, Imir was running out of cash and faced eviction. NeighborShare stepped in just in time to cover his rent, helping Imir stay housed and move forward.

Helping neighbors recover from disaster

NeighborShare can be a powerful way to facilitate neighbor to neighbor support in times of natural disaster. In the fall of 2024, we tested this with our longtime partner, Roots of Recovery, who was helping women and children relocate after Hurricane Helene.

Through this small pilot, we helped 72 neighbors across 31 households access goods or services that enabled them to begin or continue their rebuilding journey after the hurricane.

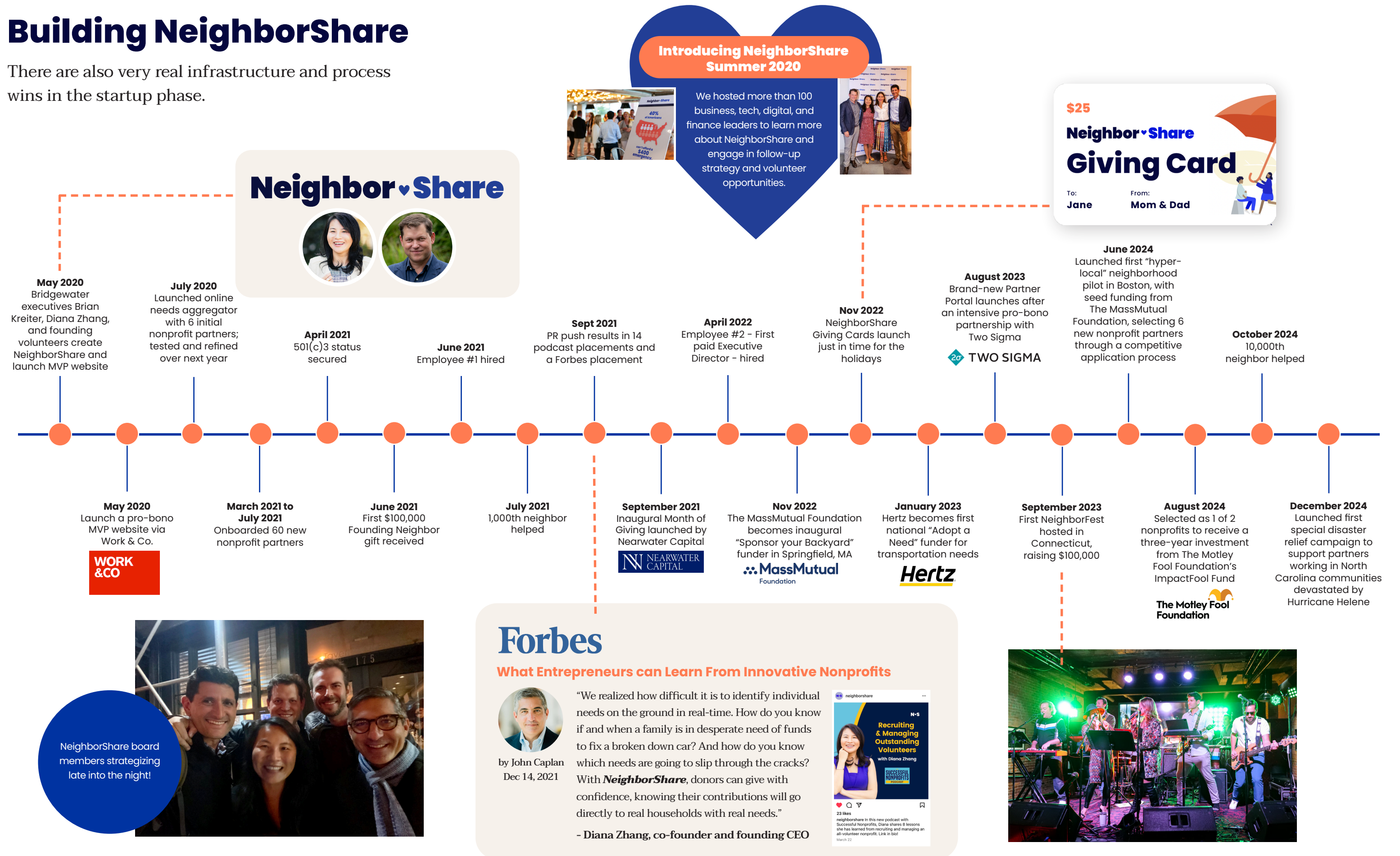
How we helped



Kiana
Roots of Recovery, Asheville, NC

Kiana, a resilient single mother of seven, was still in an emergency shelter months after Hurricane Helene devastated her home in Western North Carolina. When the shelter announced it was closing, she made the brave decision to relocate to Eastern North Carolina in search of stability. While Roots of Recovery worked to secure long-term housing and connect her to local resources, they urgently needed \$400 for a one-week motel stay. NeighborShare stepped in, giving Kiana and her children a safe place to stay as they transitioned to a new start.

There are also very real infrastructure and process wins in the startup phase.
