- **From International Airport Zaventem**: Take the train S19 4033 to Brus.-Schuman & Charleroi-Sud and get off in Schuman. *Other options:* Trains direction Gand-Saint-Pierre or Mons, get off at Brussels Central Station and take the metro line to Schuman (see below).
- From Charleroi Airport: Take the bus to Brussels South. From here take the train S8 6561 to Brus.-Schuman & Ottignies or S8 3961 to Brus.-Schuman & Louvain-la-Neuve and get off at Schuman.

<u>From Brussels Central Station</u>: Take the metro Line 1 or 5 (direction Stockel or Herrmann-Debroux) and get off at Schuman.
