### Quick Hits:

- ODU was picked to finish third in the CAA Preseason Rankings; the Lady Monarchs have already defeated the preseason #1, 2 and 4 teams (Drexel, JMU, UDel)
- ODU defeated JMU in Harrisonburg for the first time since 2005
- According to rpiratings.com, the Lady Monarch schedule through 15 games was ranked the 8th toughest in the nation, #8 out of 345 total programs; ODU's RPI is 76 after the JMU win
- Sophomore Tia Lewis ranks fourth in the CAA in rebounding with 8.1 per game. She is averaging 12.0 points per game and 8.5 rpg after averaging a double-double during her first season at UCF
- Junior Shadasia Green is the team leader in scoring and is second in rebounding with 13.3 points and 5.8 rebounds
- Despite just 92 points her freshman year as a reserve player, senior Jessica Canady now has 861 career points; Tia Lewis has eclipsed the 500-point plateau in her sophomore season with 540 total points
- Old Dominion is just 4 wins shy of 900 in program history; only two programs in NCAA history have reached the milestone (Louisiana Tech and Tennessee)
- Georgia State was one of the hottest teams in the CAA after non-conference play wrapped up, but have only gone 2-3 in league action
- Danyiel MacKeller leads the team with 19.4 points per game

### Recap:

The Panthers used a 21-5 run over the game's final seven minutes to capture its first ever victory over the Lady Monarchs. Georgia State had been one of five teams still looking to record a victory over Old Dominion having dropped their previous seven meetings since joining the CAA in 2005-06. Old Dominion was ahead, 57-54 with 7:12 remaining, before the Panthers made their run. Georgia State also took advantage of a season-high 28 turnovers committed by the Lady Monarchs resulting in 36 Georgia State points.

Old Dominion led for a majority of the first half and enjoyed a nine-point, 25-16 edge, with seven minutes left before the intermission. Although Georgia State continued to chip away, the Lady Monarchs ended the half ahead, 32-29.

A three by sophomore Jasmine Parker (Norfolk, Va.) gave the Lady Monarchs its final lead with 7:12 left in the game as Georgia State started its run. Parker's three from the right side of the floor had Old Dominion had 57-54. On the following play, the Panthers Brittany Hollins hit a three of her own to tie the game at 57 all.

The loss was the first time the Lady Monarchs posted back-to-back CAA losses since the 2002-03 season when ODU fell to VCU, James Madison, and Delaware.

Tiffany Green finished the night with a game-high 22 points along with nine rebounds and three steals. Junior Jessica Canady shot 6-of-8 from the field for 12 points. Parker recorded 11 points and senior Jen Nuzzo went 4-of-4 from the field, including 2-of-2 from downtown to finish with 10 points.

### All-Time Series

#### Against Georgia State:

Georgia State took their first victory in the all-time series last season, defeating ODU in Atlanta, 75-62. Prior to the win, ODU had won seven straight to open the series, dating back to the 2005-2006 season when the Panthers joined the CAA. With this season including, the two teams will have matched up home and home in each of the last five seasons.

#### About the Panthers:

Georgia State had a stellar non-conference season this year, going 9-2 in out of league games. The Panthers pieced together a six-game winning streak and their only losses in the first 12 games came to the ACC's Florida State University and Georgia Tech. However, Georgia State is 2-3 to start the CAA season, with losses at JMU, at Hofstra, and at home to first place VCU. The Panthers have wins at home against UNC Wilmington and Towson.

GSU has been led by returning star Danyiehl McKeller, among the league leaders in scoring. McKeller is averaging 19.4 points per game and is also third on the team in rebounding, hauling in 5.9 rebounds per game. She is fourth in the league in scoring and is shooting 44.9% from the field and is also leading the team in steals with 39.

Speaking of steals, the Panthers are one of the best in the league in takeaways, averaging 11.0 per game, behind only VCU. Georgia State leads the conference in assists and assist/turnover ratio, led by point guard Crystal Johnson. Johnson is averaging nearly six assists per game, leading the league and ahead of second place by a full assist.

Georgia State lost second-leading scorer Chan Harris for the season to a foot injury and have seen Shay Rawls step into the starting slot.

### Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks third in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 29.3% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 15.5% from long range (13-for-84).

### Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points.

### Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, senior Jessica Canady is leading the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 57.6% of her shots. In fact, ODU holds the top two spots and three of the top five. Sophomore Tia Lewis is second in the league, with 56.3% of her shots falling and junior Shadasia Green is fifth in the CAA, shooting 51.1% from the field in the first five CAA contests.

As a team, Old Dominion has the second highest shooting percentage in the league, behind only first place VCU. ODU is shooting at a 44.1% clip while VCU has knocked down one more shot in the same number of attempts to lead the league at 44.4% as a team.

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978.

## 1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 895-309 over the past 41 years for a .743 success rate.

## Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has been working her way back from offseason surgery and has now started five straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. She led ODU in rebounding again against Drexel, with 11. The Lady Monarch senior has breached the 800-point plateau and is now also over 550 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 847 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.0 points per game since her sophomore season.

## A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

## Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

## 17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion.

## On the Road Again

The game against St. Joe's on December 22 kicked off a four-game road swing that kept ODU away from the Ted for three weeks. ODU faced the Hawks and then moved on to play Tennessee to wrap up the non-conference slate and then kicked off the CAA schedule at Delaware and Northeastern.

## Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker is among the CAA leaders in steals this season, averaging 2.6 per game with 34 thefts. The ODU junior now has 133 career steals, averaging 1.6 per game in her career.

# Game Day Notes

## Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now third on the team, averaging 11.2 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

With the nine points against Louisville, Parker eclipsed the 600-point plateau. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 600 points, as senior Jessica Canady has over 800.

## Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 96-18 record. Last season, ODU suffered just its second CAA loss ever at the Ted, when JMU defeated the Lady Monarchs 72-67 on January 25, 2009. Of the 18 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

## Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

## Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

## Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

## Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

## Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
