After losing three of the first four all-time meetings against Richmond, Old Dominion has rattled off 21 consecutive wins over the Spiders. The squads last met on March 3, 2001 in the CAA Tournament, when Richmond was a CAA member school, and the Lady Monarchs prevailed, 85-75.

About Richmond

- The Spiders enter today with a 5-4 record, but have dropped three of their last four games. Two of the losses came at the hands of nationally-ranked teams. No. 25 Michigan State topped Richmond, 76-52, on November 27 and No. 12 Georgetown barely held on to beat the Spiders, 65-64, on December 1.
- Senior guard Brittani Shells paces Richmond with 21.0 points per game. Shells, the nation's 16th leading scorer, moved into fourth-place on the Spiders' alltime scoring list (1,656 points) in their last outing. The senior has led Richmond in scoring in all but two games this season.
- team Richmond has faced this season. The Spiders upended VCU on December 5, 68-53. Abby Oliver netted a season-best 22 points in the win.

About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion holds an 81.6 winning percentage against teams from the Atlantic 10 conference. The Lady Monarchs are 40-9 alltime against the league and have the edge in all-time series' against St. Joseph's, Richmond, Charlotte, George Washington and Dayton.
- ODU has been riddled with injuries in the early part of the season. Mairi Buchan, Russia Voronina & Kquanise Byrd, all of which were either projected starters or key reserves, have missed time. Buchan has not played yet this season with a foot injury & Voronina, who started the season playing the best basketball of her career. injured her shoulder at Florida and is week-to-week. Byrd, who • Old Dominion is the second CAA only missed one game, is back and starting. All of the injuries have forced many younger players to step up. Sophomore's Jackie Cook & Jo Guilford have started a combined six games this season after not starting any last year.

George Washington Recap

Defense was the story for the Old Dominion Old Dominion dropped to No. 6 in the latest Colwomen's basketball team Wednesday evening as the Lady Monarchs forced 22 turnovers and held George Washington to 26.0 percent shoot- is also ranked in the Coaches Poll, sits atop the ing from the field in a 60-35 victory over the rankings, while Delaware (No. 9), James Madi-Colonials at the Ted Constant Center Wednesday evening. George Washington's 35 points is the lowest scored against ODU since Delaware State was only able to muster 28 in a game verse the Lady Monarchs on Dec. 20, 2007. The Colonials netted only 13 points in the first half, which was the lowest since that same game, when the Hornets tallied just 12 points in the opening stanza en route to losing 70-28. Senior Tia Lewis led Old Dominion (4-3) with a game-high 15 points and 11 rebounds. Both marks are season-high's for the forward who recorded her second doubledouble of the season. Sophomore Jo Guilford hit for a career-high 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting, while senior Shadasia Green posted seven points and eight rebounds in the win. The Lady Monarchs won the battle of the boards (43-39) for just the second time this season and ODU had a 15-0 edge in fast break points.

Defending The Three

Old Dominion has shut down its opponents on the perimeter early this season, ranking second nationally in three-point field goal defense (19.0%). George Washington shot 3-of-16 from beyond the arc on Wednesday and teams are 19of-100 on the year against the Lady Monarchs.

Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just eight wins shy of her 600th career victory. She has compiled a 592-226 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 543 career wins at ODU.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. Old Dominion boasts a dominant 105-22 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No. 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs will play one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against four teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel).

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlatic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madision was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 913-317 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
