Drexel All-Time Series w/ Old Dominion

Last meeting: The Dragons won the teams' only meeting last season, 53-45 at Old Dominion. The win was the 145th in Denise Dillon's career, moving her past Lil Haas for first place on Drexel's all-time Division I wins list.

All-Time Series: Drexel is just 5-14 all-time in this series, but has won two in a row. Drexel ended ODU's 17-year CAA Tournament winning streak in the 2009 semifinals.

ABOUT OLD DOMINION

The Lady Monarchs started their season 5-0, and would move to 8-1 before suffering their second loss. Lately, however, Old Dominion has been an inconsistent team, alternating wins and losses since winning the first two games of CAA play against Georgia State and Towson. In their last outing, the Lady Monarchs fell at William & Mary, 73-69.

Old Dominion, playing its final season as a member of the CAA, has already swept Georgia State, also defeating Towson and UNCW to earn its 4-3 league mark. It fell to Delaware and Hofstra before Sunday's loss at William & Mary. Sitting at 13-6 overall, the Lady Monarchs boast earlier wins over Virginia Tech, VCU and UNLV.

Jackie Cook leads the way for Old Dominion, scoring 13.8 points per game. Shae Kelley is also in double figures, contributing 12.3. She is also averaging 8.8 rebounds a contest to lead the team. Old Dominion ranks third in the CAA in both scoring (66.4 ppg) and defense (56.7).

STAT OF THE DAY

11-11

Drexel was a perfect 11-for-11 from the free throw line on Sunday against Delaware. It was the first time the Dragons were perfect from the line since going 11-for-11 in their First Round WNIT win at Fairfield last March 15. Drexel was perfect from the line when shooting at least 10 free throws three times last year, winning all three games. They lost on Sunday, 65-56 to Delaware.

HEAD COACH · DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 · Tenth Season · Career Record: 164-130

Entering her tenth season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has elevated the program to uncharted heights. Now the winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to a school-record four consecutive postseason appearances. Dillon brought the Dragons their first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season and earned her second conference Coach of the Year honor. She has followed that up with three-straight WNIT appearances.

Since coming to University City and taking over as head coach in 2003, Dillon has inspired greatness in her players and forged a new standard for success for the program. Already the first coach in the team's history to lead the Dragons to four consecutive winning seasons, Dillon made it five last year, when the Dragons went 19-14 overall. The Dragons finished third in the CAA, eventually reaching their

second-ever CAA Tournament title game before earning a third-straight bid to the WNIT. The Dragons won their first-ever postseason game, defeating Fairfield on the Stags' home court, 57-41, in the first round of the WNIT.

The break-through season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders, a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, and a crop of quality underclassmen, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the school's first CAA title.

During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of nine All-Conference selections, two Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft.

Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. She helped the Dragons bring in Catherine Scanlon, a local product from Drexel Hill, who was one of the first Dragons to go on to a professional playing career following graduation.

In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach of the program and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament. The Dragons advanced to the semifinals and came within a point of toppling perennial power Old Dominion, a feat that had never been accomplished in the conference tournament.

Dillon's nearly instant success could be attributed, in equal parts, to both a change in coaching philosophy and a change in playing style. The Dragons under Dillon adopted a team-centered approach on the court, while playing in an offense that often illustrated that the team as a whole is greater than the sum of its parts.

The genesis of this approach can be traced back to Dillon's playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense very similar to the one now run by the Dragons, Dillon went on to a Big 5 Hall of Fame playing career on the Main Line. From 1993-96 Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds for the Wildcats. She was an All-Rookie selection, and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. It was a career that would be immortalized by the Philadelphia Big 5 with enshrinement in its Hall of Fame on January 30, 2004, and by her native Delaware County with induction to its Athletes Hall of Fame on April 26, 2012.

Off the court, Dillon's commitment to helping student-athletes grow as players and as people has been one of the program's greatest success stories. Andrea Peterson ('09) and Gabriela Marginean ('10) earned the CAA's prestigious Dean Ehlers Leadership Award in successive years. Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. Hester, whose battle back from Hodgkin's Lymphoma in 2006-07 galvanized the team and the Drexel Athletics family, was recognized nationally as the recipient of the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award. Through community outreach and serving others, including visits to the Ronald McDonald House and several local day care centers and organizing fundraisers, the Dragons have helped to rally the Philadelphia community while using their experiences to grow as individuals.

TWO-TIME CHAMPS

The Dragons have gone to two tournaments this season and won them both. Drexel first competed in the LIU Turkey Classic over Thanksgiving weekend, defeating UMKC and Colgate for the title. To that point, the Dragons had not won an in-season tournament since the Big Apple Classic on Dec. 28-29, 2000. The next weekend, Drexel traveled north to Vermont, where they handled business against Rhode Island and Vermont to capture the TD Bank Classic championship.

LEADING THE WAY

Drexel has led wire-to-wire in seven of its 13 victories: against Providence, UMKC, Colgate, Rhode Island, Vermont, Penn and Northeastern. In a period from the second half against La Salle on November 17 until December 28 against American, the Dragons never trailed in regulation in any game, going 6-1 during that stretch. The only loss came at No. 24 South Carolina, where Drexel never trailed in regulation before falling in overtime. Drexel also did not trail in the final 36:12 against Towson or the final 37:05 at UNCW.

100 CLUB

With the Dragons' 85-73 win at Northeastern, Drexel head coach Denise Dillon became the fifth coach in CAA history to reach 100 career regular season league victories. Dillon is 100-69 overall in CAA regular season play, with one regular season league title and two CAA Coach of the Year awards. She also is third among active coaches in victories behind Delaware's Tina Martin and JMU's Kenny Brooks.

FRESH PRODUCE

Drexel boasts a strong freshman class this season, including two who have already won CAA Rookie of the Week honors. Rachel Pearson earned the award on Nov. 26 after scoring 19 points in the LIU Turkey Classic semifinal against UMKC. The total marked the most for a Drexel freshman since Gabriela Marginean had 28 on March 8, 2007. Meghan Creighton got the nod on Dec. 3 after earning All-TD Bank Classic honors. She had a career-high 14 points in the title game on 4-for-4 shooting, all from three-point range. She also had four rebounds, six assists and no turnovers.

ROAD TRIP

Drexel played six straight games on the road early in their season, going 5-1 in that stretch. The Dragons' only loss came in overtime at No. 24 South Carolina. They are now 7-2 in true road contests, one year after setting a program record with 10 road wins.

HAPPY HOLLIE-DAYS

In the Dragons' final game before Christmas, Hollie Mershon became the 20th

player in program history to reach 1,000 career points when she scored 23 against Penn. Mershon currently has 1,190 points, leaving her 14th all-time in Drexel women's basketball history, 30 points behind Maureen Michaels (1,220 from 1997-00) for 13th.

JOHNSON-ALLEN BREAKS OUT

Renee Johnson-Allen has been a tough defender and rebounder, but lately she has shown an ability to put points on the board. Johnson-Allen matched her 2011-12 total of 21 points in just three games against Colgate, South Carolina and Rhode Island. Since that Colgate game, Johnson-Allen has averaged 4.7 points per game (five points was her career high to that point). She has scored in all but two games, and set career highs in points (11, URI), rebounds (11 at JMU), assists (6 at UNCW) and steals (4, URI and at Northeastern) since then.

CARROLL CONNECTION

Senior guard Hollie Mershon graduated from Archbishop Carroll in 2009, completing an All-County career and helping Carroll to three Philadelphia Catholic League Championships and the 2009 PIAA State Championship. Also on that state champion team were two freshman who now are in the midst of their debut season with Mershon's Dragons, Meghan Creighton and Rachel Pearson. That duo wound up winning three PCL titles of their own, and another state championship last season. The trio is the only one in the CAA that all played together at the same high school.

PRO BROS

Senior forward Taylor Wootton is a proven strong defender for Denise Dillon's squad. Her defensive abilities should be no surprise. Taylor's brother, Corey, is a third-year defensive end for the Chicago Bears. Corey, who was an All-Big Ten player at Northwestern, had a sack as a rookie which forced Minnesota Vikings' quarterback Brett Favre out of their Monday night matchup and effectively ended Favre's career. Meanwhile, junior Abby Redick can turn to her brother, JJ, who was an All-American shooting guard at Duke and left as the ACC's all-time leading scorer. Redick now plays for the Orlando Magic, reaching the NBA Finals in 2009. He averages 8.5 points per game for his career, and is a 40% three-point shooter.

HARRISONBURG DRAMATICS

For the second straight year, the Dragons overcame a double-digit deficit to win at James Madison. They trailed by 15 in the first half and did not lead until Hollie Mershon's two free throws with four seconds left gave them their 48-46 margin of victory. Last year, the Dukes led by 10 late in the first half before Drexel won, 60-43.

AND THEY'RE OFF!

Drexel started its season with a 7-3 record, matching the program's best-ever ten-game start. The Dragons were also 7-3 in their first-ever Division I season, 1982-83, as well as 2000-01, 2001-02 and 2010-11. Drexel also started 6-0 in CAA play for the first time in program history and is now 6-1. Its best CAA record in program history is 16-2 in 2008-09. The Dragons' best conference start ever was 13-0 in the East Coast Conference in 1989-90, a year it went 13-1 in league play.

DILLON EXTENDS

Shortly after the completion of last year's postseason run, Athletics Director Eric Zillmer announced that the Dragons had signed head coach Denise Dillon to a multi-year extension to remain at the helm. Dillon will be entering her tenth season as the Dragons' head coach in 2012-13. The all-time winningest coach in the Division I history of Drexel women's basketball, Dillon currently has 164 career victories, all at Drexel. Her off-season also included the honor of being inducted into the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame.

COACHING STAFF SHAKEUP

With the departure of assistant coach James Clark to a top-assistant position at Wagner, the Dragons coaching staff will have a little different look to it this season. Stacy McCullough, who has served as the operations assistant for the past four seasons, was promoted to a role as an Assistant Coach. McCullough graduated from Drexel in 2008 after four seasons playing for Coach Dillon, and brings a familiarity with the program that will prove invaluable with recruiting and imparting knowledge of Dillon's system.

Stepping into the role vacated by McCullough is Michelle Baker, a 2012 graduate of Saint Joseph's University. A graduate assistant this year, Baker was an All-Atlantic 10 and All-Big Five performer with the Hawks, leading the team with 13.0 points per game.

POSTSEASON BREAKTHROUGH

Last year was a historic one for the Drexel women, as they reached their second-ever CAA title game and would go on to win their first-ever postseason contest, a 57-41 victory at Fairfield in the first round of the WNIT. Drexel used a 22-2 run that extended across halftime to turn a five-point deficit into a 15-point advantage. Tyler Hale had a career-high 18 points to lead the way for Drexel. The Dragons' appearance

FIRST TEAM HOLLIE

Hollie Mershon was a Second Team All-CAA selection last year as a junior, and expectations have been set for the Malvern, Pa. native to have a standout senior year. She was selected to the First Team Preseason All-CAA after putting up 14.5 points per game and 5.2 rebounds per game last season.

JONESING FOR MORE

Last season, her first in the blue and gold, Nicki Jones led the Dragons with 20 blocks but averaged just 1.9 points and 1.4 rebounds a game. Things have changed dramatically this season. A starter in each of Drexel's first 16 contests, Jones is currently averaging 8.9 points per game and 5.1 rebounds per game. She has nine 10+ point games after having no such games last year. Jones also has two 10-rebound performances, including a 12-point, 10-rebound double-double at La Salle. Meanwhile, Jones continues to lead the team with 28 blocks, and has registered multiple blocks on 11 occasions already this season.
