
Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- This is the seventh all-time meeting between Auburn and Old Dominion; Auburn leads the series 4-2
- The last meeting came March 24, 2014 in the WNIT at Auburn Arena; Auburn won 82-59
- Auburn has won 14 consecutive home non-conference games, dating back to the 2016-17 season
- The Tigers are 52-7 in non-conference games at Auburn Arena, which opened in 2010
- Auburn is 80-31 in non-conference games under Terri Williams-Flournoy and has won 20 of their last 22
- Auburn is 59-15 all-time against current members of Conference USA
- Auburn won its season opener over Wofford 84-82; its 41st straight win in a home opener
- Under Coach Flo, Auburn is 32-1 when scoring at least 80 points in a game
- Unique Thompson (25 pts) and Daisa Alexander (22 pts) gave Auburn its first game with two 20-point scorers since an overtime win over North Carolina last season (Dec. 21, 2018, in Myrtle Beach)
- Thompson's 25-point, 13-rebound effort marked her 21st career double-double; she is tied for 7th in Auburn history and is currently 2nd among active SEC players
- Thompson's 570 career rebounds rank 2nd among active SEC players and 27th in Auburn history
- · Alexander made one 3-pointer vs. Wofford to move to a tie for 9th all-time at Auburn with 103
- Alexander's 165 career steals rank second among active SEC players
- Freshman Annie Hughes became the third Auburn freshman to start her collegiate debut under Coach Flo and the seventh since 2005
- Auburn is 40-9 all-time in season openers and 28-3 when playing its first game of the season at home
- Auburn has won 41 straight home openers, dating back to 1977-78
- · Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy is 8-1 in season-openers at Auburn and 12-4 in her career
- Auburn is in its 49th season of women's basketball and has 937 program wins
- Auburn is 141-40 all-time in the month of November; Coach Flo is 32-13 in November at Auburn

- » Auburn is 1-0 after an 84-82 win over Wofford last Wednesday to open the season.
- Old Dominion enters at 1-0 as well after defeating Campbell 59-44 on Friday.

LAST TIME OUT

- Junior Unique Thompson and senior Daisa Alexander combined for 47 points, and Auburn held off a late rally to earn an 84-82 win over Wofford to open the 2019-20 season.
- The Tigers (1-0) led by as many as 17 points midway through the third quarter but saw the Terriers (0-1) storm back to take the lead just nine minutes later. But strong rebounding and freethrow shooting down the stretch allowed Auburn to withstand a second-half 3-point barrage from Wofford.
- » Thompson picked up where she left off with her 21st career double-double, scoring 25 points and pulling down 11 rebounds. Alexander finished with 22 points and was 9-of-12 at the free-throw line, including a 7-of-8 mark in the fourth quarter.
- Sophomore Brooke Moore scored 15 points in her first career start, and freshman Annie Hughes finished with 10 points, a team-high four assists and two steals. Sophomore Kiyae' White pulled down a career-high nine rebounds as she started for the first time.

- The Tigers are 59-15 all-time against current members of Conference USA. ODU is the first of three CUSA teams Auburn will face this year (UAB, Middle Tennessee).

SCOUTING OLD DOMINION

- Old Dominion is 1-0 after a 59-44 victory over Campbell in their season opener last Friday at home. The Monarchs held Campbell to 29% shooting in the win.
- » All five starters returned for ODU from a team that went 21-11 last season and earned a berth in the WNIT. The Monarchs were picked to finish fifth in Conference USA.
- Sophomore Victoria Morris was ODU's leading scorer last season, averaging 12.8 points/game. Ajah Wayne (11.9 ppg) and Taylor Edwards (11.4 ppg) also return for the Monarchs.
- Head coach Nikki McCray is in her third season on the ODU bench.

- An 18-5 run early in the second half helped Auburn pull away and not look back in an 82-59 win over Old Dominion in the second round of the 2014 WNIT at Auburn Arena.
- >> Tyrese Tanner led the Tigers with 24 points while also dishing out a team-best 5 assists along with four rebounds and two steals. Peyton Davis and Katie Frerking added 12 and 11 points, respectively, off the bench. Davis just missed a double-double with a team-high 9 rebounds.

SCOUTING AUBURN

- Auburn is 1-0 after a season-opening 84-82 win over Wofford last Wednesday.
- » Auburn returns three starters (Daisa Alexander, Erin Howard, Unique Thompson) and five other letterwinners from its 2018-19 team that finished 22-10 overall, 9-7 in SEC play, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four seasons.
- >> The Tigers are among the most inexperienced teams in the country with just three upperclassmen on their 15-player roster. With five freshmen and seven sophomores, Auburn is one of just eight teams nationwide with three or fewer upperclassmen on its roster.
- Senior guard Daisa Alexander is the Tigers' leading returning scorer after averaging 12.6 points/game last season. She also leads Auburn returners in assists (1.8/game) and steals (2.3/game); she ranked 2nd in the SEC in steals last season. Alexander was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.
- Alexander scored 22 points in the opener vs. Wofford while playing point guard, a position she has played sparingly in her college career.
- " Junior forward Unique Thompson averaged a double-double (12.2 points, 10.3 rebounds) as a sophomore. She has 21 career double-doubles which ranks 7th in Auburn history and is currently 2nd among active SEC players. Thompson finished the 2018-19 season ranked 6th in the nation with 4.0 offensive rebounds per game. Thompson was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.
- Thompson picked up where she left off with a 25-point, 13-rebound performance in the opener vs. Wofford; it was her 21st career double-double.
- Sophomore Brooke Moore, redshirt sophomore Kiyae' White and freshman Annie Hughes all earned their first collegiate starts vs. Wofford in the season opener. Moore scored 15 points, Hughes added 10 and led the Tigers with four assists and three steals, and White pulled down a career-high 11 rehounds.

AUBURN-- Junior Unique Thompson and senior Daisa Alexander combined for 47 points, and the Auburn women's basketball team held off a late rally to earn an 84-82 win over Wofford Wednesday night to open the 2019-20 season.

The Tigers (1-0) led by as many as 17 points midway through the third quarter but saw the Terriers (0-1) storm back to take the lead just nine minutes later. But strong rebounding and free-throw shooting down the stretch allowed Auburn to withstand a second-half 3-point barrage from Wofford.

Thompson picked up where she left off with her 21st career double-double, scoring 25 points and pulling down 11 rebounds. Alexander finished with 22 points and was 9-of-12 at the free-throw line, including a 7-of-8 mark in the fourth quarter.

Sophomore Brooke Moore scored 15 points in her first career start, and freshman Annie Hughes finished with 10 points, a team-high four assists and two steals. Sophomore Kiyae' White pulled down a career-high nine rebounds as she started for the first time.

Three freshmen made their Auburn debuts. Hughes started and played just under 30 minutes, and Maliya Perry and Morgan Robinson-Nwagwu saw 11 minutes each off the bench.

Auburn shot 46.9 percent for the game (30-of-64) and was 20-of-28 at the free-throw line. The Tigers out-rebounded the Terriers 43-32, including 17 offensive rebounds that led to 22 second-chance points. Auburn also controlled the paint, outscoring Wofford inside 38-18. The Terriers, shot 48.1 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13-of-27 attempts from long range, including 9-of-16 in the second half.

After the teams finished the first 10 minutes tied 11-11, Auburn outscored Wofford in the second quarter 24-13 to take a 35-24 lead at the break. An 11-4 run over the first 5:13 of the third quarter pushed the Tigers' advantage to as many as 17 at 51-34. Auburn saw its lead shrink a bit by the end of the quarter but still took a 58-48 lead to the final 10 minutes.
