Karen Barefoot

ODU head coach Karen Barefoot enters her 14th year as a head coach in 2012-13 and 200 plus wins in her career as she leads the Lady Monarch program in year two. As head coach at the Apprentice School in 2001, she led the Builders to a National Championship in the school's first ever women's sport while taking Lenoir-Rhyne the NCAA Tournament in the 2002-03 season. In 2010-11 while at Elon, she led the Phoenix to the WBI, the schools first ever women's basketball tournament appearance. The last time that ODU made the NCAA Tournament was in 2008 when Barefoot was an assistant coach for the Lady Monarchs and helped them make the Sweet 16.

Cook Ignites Monarchs

Jackie Cook had 18 points by halftime and ODU jumped out to a 16-3 lead and never looked back on Tuesday night in a 77-46 win over USC Upstate in their homeopener.

Cook racked up a career-high 24 points and five steals as ODU scored 34 points over 34 Spartan turnovers. Sophomore Shae Kelley added 10 points and seven rebounds while freshman Galaisha Goodhope scored 12 points and had two steals off the bench.

Lady Monarchs Sign Two

Coach Barefoot announced the addition of Odegua Oigbokie and Destinee Young who signed letters of intent to play for the Lady Monarchs next fall on Nov. 14.

Oigbokie is a highly touted forward from Ridgeway High School in Memphis, Tenn., while Young is a power forward out of Hoffman Estates High School in Hoffmann Estates, Ill.

Oigbokie, who is 6-foot-1, averaged 18 points and eight re-

bounds as a junior and has been named all-district and all-region for Ridgeway the past two seasons. Young, who is also 6-foot-1, averaged 15.4 points and 11 rebounds as a junior at Hoffman Estates High School, where she already is the record holder for career rebounds and single-season blocks.

Out of the five recruits that secondyear head coach Karen Barefoot has landed at ODU, four have been rated as three stars or better by ESPN. The other three were local freshmen guards Galaisha Goodhope out of Norfolk and LaQuanda Younger of Newport News and forward Chelisa Painter from Chesapeake who is sitting out this season after transferring from George Washington.

ODU Smother Hokies Defensively

Senior Jackie Cook (17 pts, 9 asst) and sophomore Shae Kelley (14 pts, 9 asst) each missed a double-double by just a single assist as the Lady Monarchs locked down defensively in their season-opening 55-35 win at Virginia Tech on Friday.

It was the lowest output for the Hokies against ODU since their initial meeting back in 1972 when VT scored 29 points, a span of 30 games. The last time ODU held an opponent to 35 total points and 13 points at the half was on Dec. 8, 2010 vs. George Washington.

Virginia Tech shot just 19.6% in the first half from the field and finished the game 0-for-12 from behind the arc. ODU improved to 29-15 all-time in season openers with the win at Virginia Tech on Friday.

Stepping Up Defensively

In two games this season, ODU has forced 50 turnovers, collected 22 steals and held their opponents to just 1-for-18 from beind the three-point line.

Captains

Senior guard Jackie Cook, senior forward Mairi Buchan and sophomore forward Jackie Cook have been selected as team captains for the 2012-13 season.

Young Monarchs

Old Dominion is ranked 22nd in the country in terms of most inexperienced teams in the country. The Lady Monarchs have just 16 years of combined experience with three freshmen and five newcomers. ODU is the highest ranked team in the CAA and in the state of Virginia on the list.

Lady Monarchs Picked Fifth

Old Dominion was picked to finish fifth this season in the CAA preseason poll. The voting was done by the league's head coaches. Delaware was picked to win the CAA, followed by James Madison, Hofstra and Drexel. Old Dominion and Northeastern followed, while George Mason and UNCW tied for seventh. Towson and William & Mary tied for ninth, followed by Georgia State.
