ON THE RADIO:

Beginning this fall, Old Dominion's men's and women's basketball game broadcasts will move from ESPN Radio 1310 (AM) to WXEZ 94.1 FM, a 40,000 watt station with a signal strength that stretches to the Northern Neck and Eastern Shore, west to Richmond and south to northeastern North Carolina. In addition, selected games will be simulcast on WGAI AM 560 in Elizabeth City, increasing the coverage area to the Outer Banks of North Carolina. Thirteen-time sportscaster of the Year Tony Mercurio will call all the action. Former assistant coach Susan Montgomery will join Mercurio and add color commentary at all home games at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

Jordan became ODU all-time leader in three-pointers made on Nov. 17 with six trey in a victory over Charlotte, surpassing Aubrey Eblin's (1995-99) previous record of 250.

Last season Jordan ranked fourth nationally in three-point field goals per game hitting an average of 3.1 per contest. Her 10 three-pointers against Northeastern not only set a new ODU record for three's in a game, but it was the most three's by a Division I women's player last season.

ABOUT THE LADY MONARCHS:

The Lady Monarchs are coming off its biggest win of the season in last Thursday's 70-28 victory over Delaware State. In the win, three Lady Monarchs notched double-doubles with sophomore Jessica Canady collecting her first career (12 pts., 13 reb.), senior Megan Pym earning her second of the year (12 pts., 12 reb.), and junior Tiffany Green putting away the 12th of her career (11 pts., 12 reb.). Old Dominion moved up to No. 23 in the Associated Press Poll this week having won four of its last five games. The Lady Monarchs used the starting lineup of forward Pym and Shahida Williams, center Green, and guards Jazzmin Walters and Jen Nuzzo for the second straight game. Nuzzo replaced an injured senior guard T.J. Jordan. Jordan, ODU's leading scorer, has been nursing a stress reaction in her left foot and is listed as day-to-day. Friday's game will mark the start of a four-game road trip. Following Friday's game, the Lady Monarchs head to Nashville to take on Vanderbilt in their final non-conference contest of the year. Next weekend, Old Dominion opens up the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) slate at Georgia State and UNC-Wilmington.

ABOUT KENTUCKY:

The Kentucky Wildcats are looking to snap a two-game skid as they take on Old Dominion on Friday night. Kentucky is 4-6 overall in the 2007-08 season and 3-2 at home. The Wildcats' last win came against a familiar Lady Monarch opponent as Kentucky downed William & Mary, 75-44, in its largest margin of victory this season. Samantha Mahoney and Sarah Elliot lead the Wildcats in scoring. Mahoney leads Kentucky as 16.9 points per game, while Elliot is averaging a team second-best 12.1 points per outing along with a team-leading 7.4 boards per game.

SERIES WITH KENTUCKY:

Friday will mark the 11th meeting between the Lady Monarchs and Wildcats and the second straight season these two teams will meet. Old Dominion owns a 7-3 advantage in the all-time series. Last season, the Wildcats handed the Lady Monarchs a 55-69 loss in ODU's home opener of the 2006-07 season. It was the first time the two squads faced off on the hardwood since the 1986-87 season. This season's game will mark ODU's return to Lexington since the 1986-87 season where the Lady Monarchs hold a 2-2 mark against the Wildcats.

LAST TIME VS. KENTUCKY:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team fell, 55-69, to No. 21 (AP)/24 (ESPN/USA Today) Kentucky on Homecoming on November 18, 2006 at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. In the first half, neither team enjoyed more than a five-point

lead. Old Dominion led for much of the first half holding on to a 15-12 edge with 8:19 left in the half. From there Kentucky took a 7-0 run to take over a lead they would never relinquish. Old Dominion did managed to tie the game up late in the half. A T.J. Jordan lay-up with 1:36 remaining tied the game at 23-23 and the Lady Monarchs ended the half down only 27-23. Kentucky had a hot hand in the second half. After the Lady Monarch defense held the Wildcats to just 27.3 percent shooting in half number one, Kentucky ignited for 15-of-23 to hit 65.2 percent from the floor in the second half. Old Dominion cut the Kentucky edge down to one twice in the opening minutes of the second half, but the Wildcats bumped up their margin to eight, 27-39, with 13:16 remaining. The Lady Monarchs would only manage to widdle the Wildcat lead down to five. On the next two plays, a Jordan free-throw and a Sherida Triggs lay-up, Old Dominion got as close to the Kentucky lead, 47-42, as it would get the rest of the game. Guards Carly Ormerod and Samantha Mahoney helped Kentucky take a 6-0 run to give the Wildcats a double digit lead it would hold on for almost the rest of the game. Senior forward Jennifer Humphrey hit two free throws giving the Wildcats its largest lead of the game, a 16-point 65-49 advantage. Jordan was the team's leading scorer and the lone Lady Monarch in double figures. Jordan netted 11 with six points coming from the line. Jazzmin Walters added in nine. Kentucky's Jenny Pfeiffer came off the Wildcat bench to lead all scorers with 22 points. Two other Wildcats joined Pfeiffer with double digit scoring. Ormerod added in 18 points, while Mahoney poured in 12. Old Dominion won the battle of the boards by one, 42-41. Megan Pym hauled in seven rebounds in just six minutes.

HELLO TOP 25:

The Lady Monarchs returned to the Top 25 in the Associated Press Poll for week four following their upset victory over Michigan State on December 2. Old Dominion was ranked at No. 24 and makes its first appearance in the AP Poll since the final poll of the 2002 season when the Lady Monarchs finished 15th and advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament.

STILL IN THE TOP 25 AND MOVING UP:

The Lady Monarchs dropped a spot to No. 25 following its loss to top-ranked Tennessee on December 5th and remained at No. 25 for a second straight week after being idle. Following a 70-28 route of Delaware State, the Lady Monarchs moved up to No. 23 in the AP Poll.

TV TIME:

Old Dominion's contest at Kentucky will be aired by Fox Sports South and was recently added to the lineup at WSKY-4 in the Hampton Roads area.

WAY TO START:

The Lady Monarchs opened the 2007-08 season with a 6-2 overall mark. Among the six victories are wins over two ranked teams in Purdue and Michigan State as well as conference champions from the Sun Belt (Middle Tennessee) and Conference USA (East Carolina). Both losses happened against team ranked in the top four at the time of play - UConn & Stanford. It is the best start for the Lady Monarchs since the 1999-2000 season when Old Dominion opened up the year 7-1.

THREE IN A ROW AGAINST THE BIG 10:

Old Dominion made it back-to-back-to-back victories over the BIG 10. The Lady Monarchs returned from a 66-53 upset win over then No. 22/20 Purdue at the Paradise Jam in St. Thomas, only to return home to see two more BIG 10 squads. Old Dominion then proceeded to down Penn State, 77-49, and upset then No. 19/20 Michigan State, 79-73.

THREE AGAINST THE SEC:

The BIG 10 is not the only conference the Lady Monarchs will see three times during non-conference play. Old Dominion takes on Tennessee, Kentucky, and Vanderbilt of the SEC with defending MEAC champion Delaware State breaking up the mix. The Lady Monarchs are currently 0-1 against the SEC having dropped its contest at then top-ranked Tennessee back on Dec. 5.

CANADY CAN DO:

Sophomore Jessica Canady had a huge hand in Old Dominion's 70-28 victory over Delaware State on Dec. 20, the Lady Monarchs' largest victory of the season. Canady poured in her first career double-double with 12 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. Her 13 rebounds were not her only career number as she reset career marks in blocks (4) and assists (3) as well.

30 BELOW:

For the 21st time in school history, the Old Dominion women's basketball team kept an opponent under 30 points. The Lady Monarchs did on Dec. 20 in a 70-28 victory over Delaware State. It was the fewest points an opponent as scored against the Lady Monarchs since a 66-27 win at Towson on

DOUBLE-DOUBLE-DOUBLE:

A trio of Lady Monarchs registered double-doubles in the 70-28 victory over Delaware State, the most by Old Dominion this season. sophomore Jessica Canady collecting her first career (12 pts., 13 reb.), senior Megan Pym earning her second of the year (12 pts., 12 reb.), and junior Tiffany Green putting away the 12th of her career (11 pts., 12 reb.).

UNDEFEATED - AT HOME:

Old Dominion is currently 5-0 at home and finished non-conference play at 5-0 at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

HEIR JORDAN:

Senior guard T.J. Jordan led Old Dominion to a pair of victories over Penn State and No. 20/19 Michigan averaging 19.0 points and 4.0 assists per game to be named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Player of the Week for the week ending December 2. It was the Lady Monarchs first weekly conference award of the year. After the Lady Lions held Jordan scoreless in the first half, she lit up the court for 14 second half points to end as the game's leading scorer. Jordan's 14 points helped her surpass the 1,200 career point mark. She followed with a game-high 24 points in ODU's upset over #19/20 Michigan State. It was her second 20+ point effort of the season and 14th of her career. Jordan leads Old Dominion averaging 16.9 points per game.

20/20:

Old Dominion had two score 20 or more points in the upset win over Michigan State. Senior guard T.J. Jordan led all scorers with 24 points in her second 20+ point performance of the year and the 14th of her career. Junior forward/center Tiffany Green posted 20 points to tie her career mark. Green also poured in 20 points against CAA rival William & Mary her freshman year in January of 2005.

CAN'T KEEP A GOOD LADY MONARCH DOWN:

Penn State managed to keep Old Dominion leading scorer T.J. Jordan from hitting a bucket in the first half, but Jordan got revenge in half number two. The senior guard lit up the floor for a game-high 14

points all coming in the second half of action.

OPPONENT HIGH, ODU LOW:

Penn State turned the ball over 30 times resulting in 28 points in the Lady Monarchs' 77-49 victory over the Lady Lions. The 30 turnovers were the most for an ODU opponent this season. Conversely, the Lady Monarchs committed only 12 turnovers, a season low for the team.

GREENING UP THE ROSTER:

Freshman Shadasia Green, not to be confused with the other Green in senior Tiffany Green, posted some of her highest numbers of the season in the victory over Penn State. Green tied her high in points with eight, field goals made with four, field goals attempted with five, and minutes played with 13. She also stole the ball three times for another career mark.

BEEN AWHILE...:

Old Dominion met up with some foes they haven't seen for awhile at the Paradise Jam in St. Thomas over Thanksgiving...but sure do have some memories from the last time they played. The first game featured Connecticut and was the first the Lady Monarch took on the Huskies since the 2002 Elite Eight match-up. When Old Dominion took the court for the second game of the tournament, it was the first time the Lady Monarchs and Stanford faced each other since the thrilling overtime national semifinal game in 1997. With Purdue in the third game, it marked the first time 2002 Old Dominion faced the Boilermakers since it's upset over second-seeded and host Purdue in the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2002.

ALL-TOURNAMENT TIME:

It's not the post-season just yet, but already one Lady Monarch has been named to an all-tournament team. Senior guard T.J. Jordan averaged 13.3 points in games against #2/2 Connecticut, #4/4 Stanford, and #22/20 Purdue to earn a spot on the Paradise Jam All-Tournament Team. Jordan led Old Dominion in scoring with 13 against the Huskies and 17 points against the Boilermakers and also poured in 10 points versus the Cardinal.

NO PAIN, NO GAIN:

Coming off a sprained ankle in the meeting with No. 2/2 Connecticut in the first game at the Paradise Jam, senior Megan Pym rebounded by collecting her first career double-double against No. 4/4 Stanford in the tournament. Pym poured in a career-tying 12 points along with 10 rebounds, on board shy of her career mark. It was also Pym's 100th game as a Lady Monarch.

TAKE ME TO YOUR LEADER:

Jen Nuzzo has always been regarded as one of the Lady Monarch leaders and it certainly showed against No. 4/4 Stanford in the second game at the Paradise Jam. Nuzzo, a junior point guard, set a new career mark with 14 points, also marking the first time in her career she led ODU in scoring. In the following game against Purdue, Nuzzo reached double figure scoring again, this time added in 10 points.

STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT:

Old Dominion opened the season with three consecutive wins for the first time since the 1998-1999 season. That season the Lady Monarchs opened the

year with five straight wins en-route to the Sweet 16. The five wins came against Marshall, No. 8/12 Teas Tech, No. 10 N.C. State, and Southern California and Southwest Missouri State in the Torneo Cancun de Basquetboll Tournament. The streak came to end in a setback to No.6/7 Alabama in the Wachovia Women's Classic.

WRITING HER NAME INTO HISTORY:

Senior guard T.J. Jordan managed to find more places to put her name in the Old Dominion record books in the Lady Monarchs' 80-59 victory over Charlotte. With a game-high 28 points, Jordan broke the ODU record for most points scored by a Lady Monarch at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. The previous record of 27 points was held by Max Nhassengo against Hofstra on Feb. 24, 2004. Additionally with her six three-pointers made, she became the ODU recorder holder for three-pointers made in a career, surpassing Aubrey Eblin's (1995-1999) former mark of 250. Jordan currently has 265 made shots from downtown in her career.

DISH IT TO ME:

Junior guard Jazzmin Walters dished out a career-high 12 assists in ODU's 88-66 victory over East Carolina, while committing no turnovers. The 5-2 guard recorded five steals as well in the victory. Last season, Walters finished seventh on the sophomore assist leaders list with 100 dishes.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP:

Jessica Canady shined in the first three Lady Monarch games of 2007-08 season debut. Against Middle Tennessee in the season and home opener, the lone ODU sophomore came off the bench and played a career-high 23 minutes. Netting a then career-high 13 points, she also added three steals and three blocks. Canady did not have to wait much longer to reset her career mark in points as she lead all scorers with 18 in ODU's victory at East Carolina. Returning home to host Charlotte, the second year Lady Monarch posted new career marks in steals (4) and minutes played (28). Against No. 4 Stanford, Canady reset her marks in rebounds hauling in eight against the Cardinal. A few weeks later, Canady poured in her first career double-double with 12 points and a career-high 13 rebounds in a victory against Delaware State. Her 13 rebounds were not her only career number as she reset career marks in blocks (4) and assists (3) as well. To date, she is averaging a team second-best 9.8 points per game.

MOVING ON UP:

With 19 points against the Blue Raiders in the season opener against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 10, senior guard T.J. Jordan moved into 21st on the all-time Old Dominion scoring leaders list. With her 14 points against Penn State in a 77-49 victory Jordan surpassed the 1,200 point mark. She currently has with 1,229 career points.

HOME COURT STREAK:

The Lady Monarchs have won 15 straight home contests dating back to the Dec. 20, 2006, 72-55, victory over national runner-up Rutgers. ODU's last loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center was against national champion Tennessee, 59-75, back on Dec. 22, 2006.

FREE POINTS:

Old Dominion went to the line 35 times against Middle Tennessee in the season opener, sinking 27 shots and shooting 77.1 percent from the charity stripe. Two Lady Monarchs showed that working on free throws over the summer can certainly pay off. Junior Tiffany Green, who hit only 51 percent a year ago from the line, went 8-of-9 and senior Shahida Williams, who connected for just 49 percent last season, netted 5-of-6. Also sinking shots from the free throw line against the Blue Raiders was senior T.J. Jordan, who went 6-of-7.

REJECTED:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team collected 12 blocks against Middle Tennessee on Nov. 10 to set a new team record at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. The previous record of 11 occurred against East Carolina on Nov. 21, 2006 and conference rival UNC-Wilmington on Feb. 24, 2005. Senior Shahida Williams and junior Tiffany Green led the rejections with four apiece. Williams set a new career mark in the block category while sophomore Jessica Canady tied her career mark with three swats.

IN THE POLLS:

The 2007-08 Old Dominion women's basketball team received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Women's Basketball Preseason Poll and moved up to receiving votes in both national polls following the first week of action. Old Dominion's last Top 25 ranking in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll was November 18th, 2003. Old Dominion's last appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 was the final poll of the 2002 season as the Lady Monarchs danced their way to the "Elite Eight".

RANK 'EM UP - ESPN/USA TODAY POLL:

The Lady Monarchs will be taking on six teams ranked among the nation's top 25 in the ESPN/USA Today Women's Basketball Preseason Poll. Among the teams the Lady Monarchs will take on include three teams in the poll's top ten in No. 1 Tennessee, No. 2 Connecticut, and No. 8 Stanford. Other upcoming Lady Monarch opponents include No. 17 Vanderbilt, No. 18 Michigan State, and No. 20 Purdue. Old Dominion opponents receiving votes in the preseason poll include Middle Tennessee, who will serve as the Lady Monarchs season and home opener on November 10th, as well as Kentucky.

RANK 'EM UP - AP POLL:

The Lady Monarchs will be taking on five teams ranked among the nation's top 25 in the Associated Press Women's Basketball Preseason Poll. Among the teams the Lady Monarchs will take on include three teams in the poll's top ten in No. 1 Tennessee, No. 2 Connecticut, and No. 7 Stanford. Other upcoming Lady Monarch opponents include No. 17 Michigan State and No. 23 Vanderbilt. Old Dominion opponents receiving votes in the preseason poll include Middle Tennessee, Kentucky, and Purdue.

SEASON OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 26-13 in season openers including the 2007-08 season opening victory over Middle Tennessee on Nov. 10, 76-68. It was the Lady Monarchs first season opening victory since the 2001-02 season., a 82-26 victory over Towson

welcoming the Tigers to the CAA in their first conference meeting following a move from the America East Conference. In between this year's victory over the Blue Raiders and the 2001-02 win against the Tigers, Old Dominion has fallen to Virginia (2002: 55-63; 2006: 92-72) to open up the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002 and the John Paul Jones Arena in 2006, #20 Colorado (2003: 67-84) at the WBCA Classic, at Georgia Tech (2004: 64-71), and #1 Duke (2005: 56-93).

HOME OPENERS:

In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-11 including a 3-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion defeated Middle Tennessee on Nov. 10 to open up the home slate with a 76-68 victory.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 15-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 291-16 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 152-2 record at home and a 139-14 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (4-0), George Mason (41-0), Northeastern (3-0), UNC-Wilmington (34-0), and Towson (10-0).

NORFOLK, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team kicked off the 2007-08 season with a 76-68 victory over Middle Tennessee State, team receiving votes in both national polls, Saturday night at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. The victory marked the first season opening win for the Lady Monarchs since the 2001-02 season.

The visitors from Mufreesboro, Tennessee opened the game with a 6-2 lead. The Blue Raiders, known for their three-point shooting, hit two shots from downtown to help establish their lead. However, Old Dominion produced a 19-5 run over the course of six minutes to take control of the lead that they would never lose.

The Lady Monarchs led by as many as 14 in the first stanza, but as the half was drawing to a close, Middle Tennessee closed the gap to within seven. Over the final 4:41 of the first half, the Blue Raiders outscored the Lady Monarchs, 11-4, and Old Dominion entered the half up 37-30.

The first part of the second half saw the Lady Monarchs leading by double figures. Coming out of the lockerroom, Old Dominion re-established a double figure advantage with six unanswered points in the first minute and a half. Senior Megan Pym gave the Lady Monarchs their biggest edge of the night with a lay-up with 8:52 left in the game for a 17-point, 64-47, lead.

The Blue Raiders did not go away as five minutes later the Lady Monarchs were clinging to a three-point, 69-66, lead. Over the course of those five minutes, Middle Tennessee only allowed the Lady Monarchs to net five points, all coming from the hands of Shahida Williams on two lay-ups and the second of a two shot award from the charity stripe. Williams' final free throw still had Old Dominion leading by 14, 69-55, with 5:39 to go. The next two minutes however had the Blue Raiders net 11 unanswered points. Middle Tennessee's Latoya Barclay capped the run by hitting a three.

Following Barclay's three with 3:09 left in the game, the Blue Raiders had a chance to capitalize on an ODU turnover. Jackie Pickel from the right side of the arc launched a three, which could have tied the game, but Pym came up with a huge rebound and a put back at the other end of the court to help seal the victory for Old Dominion.

The only points Middle Tennessee would get the rest of the way would be from the line by Amber Holt with 20 seconds remaining. Meanwhile, the Lady Monarchs tacked on five more points along the way for the final score.

Old Dominion went to the line 35 times sinking 27 shots and shot 77.1 percent from the charity stripe. Junior Tiffany Green who hit only 51 percent a year ago from the line went 8-of-9 while Jordan went 6-of-7 and Williams, who connected for just 49 percent last season, netted 5-of-6.

Old Dominion now stands at 26-13 in season opening victories and 28-11 in home openers.

GREENVILLE, N.C. -- Sophomore Jessica Canady set another career mark by coming off the bench for 18 points in the Old Dominion women's basketball team's 88-66 win over defending Conference USA champions, East Carolina, Tuesday night at Minges Coliseum. Canady helped the bench produce 49 points in the Lady Monarchs' first road win of the 2007-08 season.

The Lady Monarchs, winners of 16 straight Colonial Athletic Association titles, put together back-to-back wins to open the season for the first time since 1999-2000. The Pirates, meanwhile, drop their first contest of the season, falling to 1-1 overall.

Canady was not the only Lady Monarch setting a new career-mark. Junior Jazzmin Walters dished out a career-high 12 assists, while committing no turnovers. The 5-2 guard recorded five steals in the victory.

Canady was one of four Lady Monarchs in double figures. Freshman Jasmine Parker (Norfolk, Va.) came off the bench for 14 points, including 12 from downtown. The rookie guard ended the night 4-of-5 from beyond the arc. Senior T.J. Jordan added in 14 points, while senior Shahida Williams netted 11.

East Carolina had two in double digits. Lauren Cochran went 7-of-8 from the field and ended the night with 17 points, while teammate LaCoya Terry recorded 16 points.

The beginning of the game saw five ties followed by the Lady Pirates taking a four-point 29-25 lead at the seven minute mark. During the closing minutes of the half, East Carolina would manage to bump its advantage to four, but that would be the largest lead the Lady Pirates would see all night.

The close of the first half saw freshman Shadasia Green hit a jumper with seven seconds remaining giving the Lady Monarchs its first lead since the 9:05 mark. Old Dominion entered the half up by one, 39-38, and would never lose the lead again.

East Carolina would only hit one field goal for nearly the first five minutes of the second half while Old Dominion rattled off 13 points to take 51-41 lead. Freshman Jasmine Parker (Norfolk, Va.) helped the Lady Monarchs extend their lead to 16 points on back-to-back-to-back three-pointers for a 63-47 advantage with 12:06 to go.

Following Parker's third three, East Carolina proceeded to take a 8-0 run to cut the gap to eight. Terry capped the Lady Pirate run with two free throws for a 63-55 score with 8:42 remaining.

East Carolina would only score 11 more points the rest of the way, while Old Dominion collected 25. Seven of those Lady Pirate points came from the free throw line. Canady gave the Lady Monarchs its largest lead of the night, 86-61, with her final two points of the games at the 2:03 mark.

NORFOLK, Va. -- Senior guard T.J. Jordan managed to find to more places to put her name in the Old Dominion record books Saturday afternoon in the Lady Monarchs' 80-59 victory over Charlotte.

With a game-high 28 points, Jordan broke the ODU record for most points scored by a Lady Monarch at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. The previous record of 27 points was held by Max Nhassegno against Hofstra on Feb. 24, 2004.

Additionally with her six three-pointers made, she becomes the ODU recorder holder for three-pointers made in a career with 251 to date, surpassing Aubrey Eblin's (1995-1999) former mark of 250.

The Lady Monarchs move to 3-0 on the season, the first time since the 1998-99 season Old Dominion has won three straight games to open a season. Meanwhile, the 49ers are stilling looking for their first win, falling to 0-5 on the year.

Jordan was the lone Lady Monarch in double figures. Senior Megan Pym and junior Jazzmin Walters posted nine points with Pym hauling in eight rebounds. Sophomore Jessica Canady added in eight.

Three different 49ers reached double figures in the loss. Shannon McCallum came off the bench for a team-high 14 points to set a new career mark. Danielle Burgin added in 13, while Sabrina Gregory had 11, needing eight more points to become the 15th 49er to score 1,000 career points.

Old Dominion led wire-to-wire. While the Lady Monarchs only led by one, 21-20, with 3:08 remaining in the first half, Old Dominion used the closing minutes to clamp down on defense and not allow Charlotte to score. Meanwhile on offense, the Lady Monarchs used an 8-0 run to take a 31-20 advantage in to the lockerroom.

Charlotte got no closer to the Old Dominion lead than seven points in half number two. Traci Ray hit a three to cut the 49er deficit to, 45-38, with 14:13 left in the game, but Walters and Jordan connected on back-to-back three's themselves to put Old Dominion ahead by double digits the rest of the way.

Old Dominion outrebounded Charlotte, 51-36, as junior Tiffany Green led all with nine boards.

NORFOLK, Va. -- As its been for the last eight consecutive meetings, the home team took the victory in the Old Dominion - Penn State match-up with the Lady Monarchs using a late first half surge and blistering second half en-route to a 77-49 victory over the Lady Lions in women's basketball action at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

Senior T.J. Jordan, who was held scoreless in the first half, exploded for a game-high 14 points in the second half, as one of four Lady Monarchs in double figures. With her performance Jordan surpassed the 1,200 career point mark. Both seniors Shahida Williams and Megan Pym contributed 12 points each and sophomore Jessica Canady came off the bench to add 11.

Penn State (5-2) had only leading scorer Tyra Grant in double digits. She finished the night with 12 points.

The Lady Lions committed 30 turnovers, the most by an Old Dominion opponent this season, resulting in 28 Lady Monarch points.

Old Dominion (5-2) started off the game shooting just 3-of-16 from the field as Penn State capitalized on the slow start by the Lady Monarchs to take an 17-6 lead with 9:38 remaining in the opening half. Senior Megan Pym began the Lady Monarch surge with a bucket on the following possession as Old Dominion managed to diminish its 11-point deficit down to two, 17-15, while holding the Lady Lions scoreless for four minutes.

Pym gave the Lady Monarchs its first lead since the early moments of the game at the 4:05 mark, 21-20, but two free throws by Penn State's Janessa Wolff returned the advantage back to the Lady Lions. Grant completed the traditional three-point play following three missed attempts by the Lady Monarchs on their end of the court to put Penn State up by four. However from there the Lady Lion lead would disappear for the rest of the game.

The Lady Monarchs closed out the final three minutes of the opening stanza with four points from senior Tiffany and a lay-up from Williams to enter the locker room up, 27-25.

The second half was all Old Dominion as the Lady Monarchs outscored the Lady Lions, 29-25. Old Dominion shot a blistering 50 percent in the second half, going 15-of-30 from the field.

The half began with the Lady Monarchs going on a 11-2 run for a 40-29 edge with 16:18 left. Twice Penn State would cut its disadvantage down to single digits, but after Jordan was fouled on a three-point attempt and knocked down all three shots from the line with 12:38 remaining, Old Dominion would lead by double figures the rest of the way.

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. (AP) -- Angie Bjorklund scored 19 points and Candace Parker added 14 as top-ranked Tennessee beat No. 24 Old Dominion 83-51 Wednesday night.

Nicky Anosike added 13 points and seven rebounds for the Lady Vols (7-0), who defeated the Lady Monarchs for the 27th time in their last 28 meetings. Tennessee now leads the series 32-9. Tiffany Green scored 14 points to lead Old Dominion (6-3), which played without leading scorer T.J. Jordan.

Tiffany Green scored a season-high 14 points, while Jazzmin Walters and Shadasia Green were the only other Old Dominion players in double figures with 10 points each.

Tennessee, which gave up a school-record 57 rebounds against North Carolina in their previous outing, was more successful against Old Dominion, outrebounding the Lady Monarchs 45-35. However, they were beaten 16-13 on the offensive end.

Meanwhile, Old Dominion entered the Top 25 for the first time since 2002 this week. The Lady Monarchs have made 15 straight NCAA tournament appearances and 24 overall. Only Tennessee and Louisiana Tech have more. ODU has won three national titles, the last in 1985. They lost to the Lady Vols in the 1997 NCAA title game.

The Lady Monarchs' three 2007 losses have come against teams ranked in the top five. Their previous defeats were against No. 2 UConn and fourth-ranked Stanford.

NORFOLK, Va. -- Senior Megan Pym, junior Tiffany Green, and sophomore Jessica Canady all collected double-doubles to help the No. 25 Old Dominion women's basketball team to a 70-28 route of Delaware State on Thursday afternoon at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

The Lady Monarchs head into break 7-3 overall and ranked in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll for the third straight week. Delaware State, the defending MEAC champions, playing in its third game in four days fell to 3-7 overall having dropped four straight.

Canady, in her first double-double of her career, and Pym, tying her career mark for the third time, each registered a game-high 12 points. Green meanwhile netted 11.

Canady, Pym, and Green combined for 37 of the Lady Monarchs' 62 rebounds. Together the three Lady Monarchs outrebounded the Hornets by nine as Delaware State was limited to only 28 boards the entire game. Canady led the rebounding corps with 13, which included 10 boards at the half, while Green and Pym each hauled in 12 apiece.

The 28 points scored by Delaware State was the fewest points scored by an Old Dominion opponent since they defeated Towson, 66-27, back on February 3, 2002. It was the 21st time in school history holding an opponent to less than 30 points.

Old Dominion held a 20-12 lead at the half and outscored Delaware State 40-16 in half number two. At the intermission, the Lady Monarch defense only allowed three members of the Hornet squad to score. Ashlee Burbage was the only starter to hit a bucket and ended the half with four points. Keyhana Wakefield came off the bench to net six points, while Brittany Washington had a bucket, coming off the bench as well.

The Old Dominion defense held Delaware State to 19.7 percent (12-of-61) from the floor, while the Lady Monarchs shot 43.8 percent (28-of-64).

Freshman Jasmine Parker and junior Jen Nuzzo each dished out six assists. It was a new career high for Parker, while Nuzzo tied her career mark.
