### LADY MONARCH MOMENTS:

- Since joining the CAA in the 1991-92 season, Old Dominion has captured the league tournament title each season for an NCAA record 17 consecutive league titles and owns a 50-1 record in CAA Tournament action, including Friday's 61-56 win over UNC-Wilmington in the quarterfinals.
- Old Dominion improved to 40-0 all-time against UNC-Wilmington. The Lady Monarchs improve to 6-0 against the Seahawks in the CAA Tournament including a 3-0 record in the CAA Tournament quarterfinals.
- It is the second straight season the Lady Monarchs have defeated the Seahawks in the tournament quarterfinals. Last season, Old Dominion advanced to the semifinals following a 82-65.
- Junior Jessica Canady captured a game-high 21 points en-route to her fourth 20+ point performance of the season and the seventh of her career. Her 21 points are also a new CAA Tournament mark for the 6-0 forward. She scored the first ten points of the second half.
- Junior Jessica Canady hauled in a game-high 13 rebounds for her 11th double digit rebounding performance of the 2008-09 season and 16th of her career.
- Junior Jessica Canady poured in her ninth double-double of the season and 14th of her career with her 21-points, 13-rebound performance in the CAA quarterfinal victory over UNC-Wilmington.
- Junior Jessica Canady was one block shy of her career mark with five Seahawk rejections.
- Sophomore Jasmine Parker tied her career mark in steals with four. She has recorded four steals on five occassions this season.
- With her seven rebounds on Friday, senior Tiffany Green moved into a tie for seventh on the all-time ODU rebounding list with 986 career boards. She is tied with Nyree Robers (1994-1998). She needs just 14 more rebounds to become just the seventh Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000 career rebound mark.

### **ABOUT DREXEL:**

The Drexel Dragons enter Saturday's semifinal match-up with the Lady Monarchs sporting a 22-8 overall mark and are winners in their last 14 contests. CAA Coach of the Year, Denise Dillon, currently hold the ninth longest win streak in the country, which included the Dragons' 53-48 win over No. 8 Towson in Friday's quarterfinals. The Dragons are led by junior CAA Player of the Year Gabriela Marginean who is averaging 23.6 points per contest as the nation's third leading scorer. She set the CAA's single-season scoring record after collecting 19 points in Friday's win over the Tigers and now has 712 points this season. Next on the Dragon stat sheet is Jasmine Rosseel, who is averaging 10.9 points a game.

### ALL-TIME SERIES WITH DREXEL:

Old Dominion holds a 14-2 record against Drexel as these two teams became annual rivals when the Dragons entered the CAA in the 2001-02 season. Both of the Dragons' victories were at the Daskalakis Center with ODU dropping the 2005 regular season finale, 71-68, and falling 55-67 on February 12th of this season. In the 2005 rematch, Old Dominion edged out Drexel, 64-63, in the CAA Tournament semifinals en-route to the Lady Monarchs' 14th straight CAA title.

### ALL-TIME SERIES WITH DREXEL IN THE CAA TOURNAMENT:

It will be the third meeting between the Lady Monarchs and Dragons in CAA Tournament action. Last time the two teams met was in 2007 with topseeded Old Dominion taking a 66-55 victory over the ninth-seeded Dragons in the quarterfinals enroute to title number 16. Saturday will be the second meeting with Drexel in the tournament semifinals. The two squads squared off in 2005 with second-seeded Old Dominion squeaking by the thirdseeded Dragons, 64-63.

### LAST TIME VS. DREXEL:

CAA Preseason Player of the Year Gabriela Marginean exploded for 40 points to help lead the Drexel Dragons to a 67-55 victory over Old Dominion on February 12th at the Daskalakis Center to give the Lady Monarchs its fourth conference loss of the year. Marginean scored 23 of Drexel's 33 first half points as the Lady Monarchs entered the lockerroom down 33-25 at the half. Marginean posted 16 of the Dragon's first 18 points helping her squad to a 18-9 lead with 9:43 left in the half. Drexel led by double figures a majority of the second half. Old Dominion got as close a nine following a pair of three throws by junior Jessica Canady with 18:38 left in the game. From that point, the Dragons outscored the Lady Monarchs 20-9 capped by an Andrea Peterson jumper for a 20-point, 56-36 advantage, Drexel's largest lead of the night, with 8:44 remaining. Sophomore Jasmine Parker scored 11 of her career-high 21 points during the final five minutes of the contest. Parker who was one of two Lady Monarchs in double figures finished the night going 5-of-10 from the field and 12-of-13 from the line. Senior Tiffany Green netted 10 in the loss as the other Lady Monarch in double digits. Peterson joined Marginean in double figure scoring for the Dragons with 12 points. Marginean also hauled in 11 boards for her sixth double-double of the year.

### LAST TIME VS. DREXEL IN THE CAA TOURNAMENT SEMIFINALS:

Old Dominion escaped with a narrow 64-63 win over fourth-seeded Drexel Friday in the 2005 CAA Tournament semifinals at the Patriot Center. It was the closest margin of victory in 51 tournament contests for ODU as the game came down to the final possession. George Mason took ODU to overtime in the 2002 semifinals but the Lady Monarchs prevailed 68-63. The game featured eight ties and 10 lead changes in the final 11 minutes of play. ODU senior guard Shareese Grant, the three-time Most Outstanding Performer of the CAA Championship, drove the right side of the lane and was fouled by Drexel junior forward Candice Williams with 1:07 to go. Grant calmly stepped to the line and knocked down two foul shots in what proved to be the winning points of the contest. ODU junior guard Lawona Davis attempted to collect a loose ball on the sideline with :17.2 remaining but she stepped out of bounds, giving the ball back to the Dragons. Drexel senior forward Katrina Martin drove the left side and had a shot blocked by freshman forward Tiffany Green which resulted in another held ball and a Drexel possession with :5.8 on the clock. The Dragons called a timeout to set-up a play under their own basket and Old Dominion called a break of its own after the teams returned to the court. Drexel freshman guard Nicole Hester attempted to inbound the ball to Martin who was momentarily open in the paint. The Lady Monarchs' Tish Lyons stepped in front and forced a tie-up. The possession arrow gave it back to ODU with :3.5 left. Drexel freshman forward Anna Karlssom-Gonzalez fouled Grant before the ball was inbounded and sent the senior guard to the line for a one-and-one. Grant missed the front end but Green collected her gamehigh 11th rebound and was immediately fouled to earn a trip the line with :2.2 left. Green missed both attempts but Drexel was unable to gain possession as the horn sounded sending the Lady Monarchs to their 14th consecutive conference finals appearance. Sophomore forward Sherida Triggs had a team-high 11 points for ODU and Grant added 10 after going just 2-of-14 from the floor. Green and freshman guard TJ Jordan added nine apiece and Davis had eight to go along with a game-high five assists and three steals. The Lady Monarchs, who have dominated opponents on the glass this season, held a 46-26 advantage on the boards. Drexel was paced by freshman guard Narissa Suber's game-high 22 points on 6-of-13 shooting, including four of nine from behind the arc. Junior forward Catherine Scanlon had 13 points and seven rebounds and Martin had 11 points and seven rebounds. Junior guard Jackie Falsom added 10 points for the Dragons.

**COLONIAL DOMINANCE:** Old Dominion has captured 17straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 323-24 overall record, which includes eights seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 169-3 record at home and a 154-21 road record. Only three CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February ■19, 1992, the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005, and the third a 67-72 loss to James Madison on January 125, 2009. Three schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Northeastern (7-0), UNC-Wilmington (40-0), and Towson (13-0).
