- ODU faces VCU tonight at 7 p.m. in Richmond. The contest will be featured on ESPN3.
- Old Dominion is coming off its second-straight CAA win after a 73-70 victory at Northeastern Sunday.
- The Lady Monarchs made a season-best 11 three-pointers, shooting 47 percent from beyond the arc. The 11 three's were just one off the school record of 12 set against UNCW in 1997.
- Junior Jackie Cook and freshman Myeisha Hall set career highs and combined for seven three's. Cook had 19 points and Hall had 15, all on 3's.
- Lewis leads the team with 18.1 points per game and 9.3 rebounds per game.
- This is the fourth head coaching stint for Karen Barefoot, as she comes from Elon where she led the Phoenix to their first ever women's basketball postseason tournament (WBI). She also coached Apprentice School and Lenoir Rhyne.

- VCU is 9-5 overall and 2-1 in CAA play this season.
- Senior forward Courtney Hurt leads the Rams, averaging a double-double with 23.1 points and 12.3 rebounds per game. She is second on in the CAA in points per game and sixth in the nation. She leads the conference in rebounding and is second in the nation.
- Senior guard Andrea Barbour is second on the team with 17.4 points per game and leads the team with 39 steals. She is sixth in the league in scoring and fourth in steals.
- Both teams have only one common opponent so far this season as VCU and ODU lost to Richmond.

About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion defeated Northeastern in Boston 73-70 for its first road win of the 2011-12 season.
- Jackie Cook recorded a career-best 19 points in the win over NU. She shot 6-of-12 from the field and was a perfect 5-for-5 at the foul line.
- Freshman Myeisha Hall had 15 points and was 5-of-6 from three-point range. Prior to Sunday, Hall was just 2-of-21 from beyond the arc this year, with both makes coming against Seton Hall November 26.
- Tia Lewis added 16 points, 14 in the first half in the win over NU.

Game Day Notes

Lewis Closing in on Milestone
ODU senior Tia Lewis is closing in on another milestone, as she is just 21 rebounds shy of becoming the seventh Lady Monarch to reach 1,000 career rebounds.

She is also just eight points shy from passing Lucienne Berthieu for 20th on ODU's all-time scoring list. Lewis has 1,375 career points.

Stepping Up

Junior Jackie Cook stepped up in a big way Sunday with a career-high 19 points in the win at NU. Cook shot 50 percent from the floor and was a perfect 5-of-5 from the foul line.

Beyond the Arc

Freshman Myeisha Hall has struggled shooting the ball this season, but not last Sunday, as she was 5-of-6 from three-point range for a season-high 15 points. Hall was just 2-of-21 from beyond the arc this year before Sunday with both makes coming against Seton Hall November 26.

Then there Was Lewis

Tia Lewis had a great first half at NU with 14 points, but got into foul trouble in the second half and finished with 16 points.

Stepping up (Part Two)

With 15:12 to play in the second half and trailing by one, Tia Lewis picked up her fourth foul. For the next 10 minutes with Lewis on the bench, instead of struggling with their leader off the floor, ODU grabbed a 67-63 lead, one they would keep the rest of the way.

Career-High, Again

Senior Tia Lewis pumped in a career-best 30 points in ODU's win over Georgia State on Jan. 4. She also had 10 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season. It was the third different team she

has set her career-high this season.

Lewis Leads the Way

In ODU's four wins, Tia Lewis is averaging 27 points and 9.3 rebounds per game. She scored 27 in the wins over Alabama and Wofford, 24 against NC A&T and 30 vs. GSU.

In the 10 losses, Lewis is only averaging 14.7 points per game.

Three in a Row

Senior Tia Lewis continued her impressive play with her third-straight 20-point performance in the 71-58 win over North Carolina A&T on Dec. 18. The senior had 24 points and 13 rebounds to produce her fourth double-double of the year.

20 Again for Lewis

Tia Lewis scored 20-points for the fourth time this year and the second-straight game with 27 points in the win over Wofford Dec. 7. She tied her career high she set in the win over Alabama earlier this year.

Buchan's Back

Mairi Buchan had her best game of the year to date against Wofford with a season-high 13 points and tied her career best with nine rebounds.

Cook Career-High

Junior guard Jackie Cook registered a career-high 17 points in the CAA opener Sunday at George Mason. She had 13 of the 17 by halftime, finishing 4-of-7 from the floor and 8-of-10 from the foul line. Her previous career-high was 17 points last season at Hofstra.

Lewis Heating Up

Senior Tia Lewis has been a standout performer for the Lady Monarchs, producing her seventh-straight double-figure scoring effort (at the time) with 20 points at George Mason on Sunday. It was her third 20-point outing of

the year and she just missed her fourth double-double with nine boards.

CAA Openers

The loss to George Mason on Dec. 4 was the first ever to open CAA play. ODU drops to 20-1 all-time in openers. ODU is now 48-2 all-time against George Mason.

Double-Double for Two

Tia Lewis and JoNiquia Guilford became the first ODU teammates to record a double-double in the same game in the loss at GW Nov. 30 since Lewis (14 pts., 11 reb. and Jessica Canady (15 pts., 14 reb.) did it on Jan. 21, 2010 against Georgia State.

Lewis Gets Third-Straight

Tia Lewis recorded her third-straight double-double with 19 points and 14 rebounds in the overtime loss at George Washington. She was 7-of-18 from the floor and 5-of-5 from the foul line.

Guilford Gets First

JoNiquia Guilford recorded her first career double-double in the 58-52 OT loss at George Washington, with 12 points and 14 rebounds. She came off the bench and shot 5-of-11 from the floor including knocking down a three-pointer. The 14 boards are a career best.

Among the Leaders

With four double-doubles this season and 35 for her career, Tia Lewis is eighth on the NCAA Division I active list for career double-doubles.

CAA Leaders

Tia Leaders ranks among the top-10 in the CAA in five categories; scoring (4th at 18.1), rebounding (6th at 9.) field goal percentage (5th at .518), free throw percentage (15th at 70.4) and minutes played (5th at 34.5). Ashley Betz-White is fourth in free throw shooting at 79.2 percent.

Double-Double

Senior forward Tia Lewis recorded her second double of the season against Seton Hall with 11 points and 16 rebounds in the U.S. Virgin Islands at the Paradise Jam Tournament. Lewis averaged 20.7 points and 10.7 rebounds a

game at the Paradise Jam Tournament, earning all-tournament team honors.

Back to 20

Senior Tia Lewis had her second-straight 20 point effort with 24 points against Louisiana Tech at the Paradise Jam Tournament. She also registered her first double-double of the season.

Career-High (Part One)

Sophomore Shakeva Richards poured in a career-best 18 points against La. Tech. The sophomore went 4-for-5 from the foul line and pulled down five rebounds.

Career-High (Part Two)

She's only played in 10 games, but Myeisha Hall had her most impressive game of the season in just 12 minutes against Louisiana Tech. Hall went 5-of-8 from the floor, scoring 14 points and making her first two career three-pointers.

Leading the Way

Senior Tia Lewis scored a career-high 27 points in the 77-76 win over Alabama. Lewis made a career-best 12 field goals as well and went 3-of-6 from the line.

At the Buzzer

Sophomore Becca Allison knocked in the game-winner with just 1.2 seconds left in ODU's 77-76 win over Alabama. Allison wasn't the most likely last second shooter, going just 2-of-6 on the day with five points, but she was the right shooter as she drained the jumper.

Back at It

Freshman Ashley Betz-White finished with 20 points and went 10-of-12 from the foul line in the win over Alabama. It is the third time this season she has had at least 18 points in a game.

Lady Monarchs Picked Fifth

Old Dominion was picked to finish fifth this season in the CAA pre-season poll. The voting was done by the league's head coaches. Delaware was picked to win the CAA, with VCU, James Madison and Hofstra rounding out the top four. ODU was tied for fifth with Drexel, followed by UNCW, George Mason, William and Mary, Georgia State, Towson and Northeastern.
