Old Dominion freshman Shakeva Richards had a good look from the top of the key to send the contest into an extra stanza, but her jumper hit back iron as the buzzer sounded. The Lady Monarchs suffer their first loss of the season and drop to 2-1 on the year.

NC State led 62-57 with 41 seconds remaining, but senior Alena Voronina drilled a triple to cut the lead to two. The Lady Monarchs elected not to foul on NC State's next possession and the move paid off as the Wolfpack turned the ball over with 7.3 seconds remaining. After a timeout, Parker dribbled the length of the court and got the 2. Old Dominion ball to classmate Shadasia Green, who found an 3. Delaware open Richards. The freshman had to rush the shot 4. Hofstra as the clock wound down and as the jumper hit 5. VCU back iron, the game ended. Parker, who was just 6. Drexel one point shy of her career-high in scoring, added 7. William & Mary to her stat line with a career-high tying six steals and six rebounds. Junior Tia Lewis, ODU's leading scorer entering the game, was plagued with foul trouble and only played 15 minutes, scoring four points. Voronina was in double figures for the third consecutive game with 10 points and six rebounds.

Old Dominion continues to rise in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll. The Lady Monarchs jumped three spots and are currently No. 2 in the latest poll, which was released Tuesday. Green Bay, which is also ranked in the Coaches Poll, sits atop the rankings, while James Madison (No. 10) and Delaware (No. 12) also represent the CAA. ODU garnered 673 points this week and one first-place vote.

Senior guard Jasmine Parker is inching closer to becoming the 28 all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her season-high 23 points at NC State on Tuesday, she now sits with 951 points.

Old Dominion topped Atlatic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
