- ODU has won three straight and 11 of 12 to take over sole possession of first in the league standings; ODU has the tiebreaker over Drexel in second place and will play third-place VCU again next week
- The Lady Monarch schedule through 23 games still ranks the toughest in the CAA; ranked as high as #1 this season, it is now slated as the 38th toughest in the nation
- ODU has 99 victories in the Ted Constant Convocation Center - today's game will be the first attempt to reach the 100-win mark in the building, opened in 2002
- Despite just 92 points her freshman year as a reserve player, senior Jessica Canady now has 965 career points; she needs just 35 more to become the 27th Lady Monarch with 1,000 career points
- Junior Jasmine Parker has been on fire since the CAA season started, leading the team in CAA-only scoring with 12.1 ppg; she has 805 career points in her third year, ranking fourth among active CAA juniors
- INJURY ALERT: Jackie Cook has sat out three games with a bruised knee; she also suffered a broken nose against Hofstra -- she is likely to return vs. James Madison
- JMU, nationally ranked earlier this season, earned just the third CAA win ever f or an opponent in Norfolk last season -- ODU is 151-4 in Norfolk since joining the CAA
- All-American candidate Dawn Evans has battled through injuries and ranks fourth in the nation in scoring, with 25.3 ppg

Old Dominion University is participating in their seventh annual Hoops for a Cure game with today's WBCA Pink Zone game as they face off against the James Madison University Dukes at 3:00 p.m. This year, the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced that over 1,550 schools and organizations were committed to participating in the 2010 Pink Zone initiative.

The WBCA Pink Zone initiative is a global, unified effort for the WBCA's nation of coaches to assist in raising breast cancer awareness on the court, across campuses, in communities and beyond. As with many other school's during the February 12-21 Pink Zone timeframe, the Lady Monarchs are asking fans to PINK OUT THE TED to help raise breast cancer awareness and funding.

Prior to the opening tip, Old Dominion will have a survivors reception and march to honor the strong women who have battled this terrible disease. During the game, the game officials will be using pink whistles and players will be in pink uniforms from head to toe, including pink shoelaces.

The effort has seen increased success across the nation every year. In 2008, over 1,200 teams and organizations raised over \$930,000 and in 2009 more than 1600 participants raised an incredible \$1.3 million.

Add one now...that's all the Lady Monarchs need to reach 100 victories in their beautiful arena, opened in 2002. The ODU women have averaged over 12 home wins per year at the Ted Constant Convocation Center and will be looking for their eighth such victory this season, today.

Georgia On Her Mind

Sophomore Tia Lewis must have been thinking "Home Sweet Home" when she knocked down the game-winning layup with 0.6 seconds remaining at Georgia State. The ODU forward is from Poulan, Georgia and in her first trip to her home state as a Lady Monarch, she was the hero. As the defense collapsed onto junior Jasmine Parker, she found Lewis on the left side of the paint for a wide-open bucket and was fouled. She converted the old-fashioned three-point play to put ODU up by two with less than a second to play. She finished with 10 points and nine rebounds in the game.

ODU Clinches Bye

After their 63-61 victory against Georgia State and the rest of the league finals on Thursday night, the Lady Monarchs found out that they had clinched a first round bye in this year's 2010 CAA Tournament. At worst, the Lady Monarchs will finish in a tie for fourth place, and owns tiebreakers over both Delaware and Hofstra. The CAA Tournament this year is being held at the JMU Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. and will begin on March 11 through March 14.

All-Around Parker

Jasmine Parker is having a terrific all-around season for the Lady Monarchs in her third year. She was leading the team in scoring for some time and is still the team leader in points per game for conference games only. But more than the scoring, Parker has been a top notch defender and great facilitator for her teammates this season. The Norfolk native has etched career-highs in assists (89) and steals (61) this year and is among the league leaders in both categories. She is also likely to set a new career-high in rebounds in today's game, as she is just two shy of her previous mark with 75 total boards this season. Offensively, she is ODU's top deep threat, hitting 37 three's this season, and ranks second on the team in scoring currently, with 11.1 points per game.

Ticha and Clarisse were also selected as the only women's basketball representatives among the 25 SILVER STARS, announced by the CAA as the 25 individuals who had the greatest impact on the conference over the last 25 years. Penicheiro and Machanguana join three other ODU athletes, giving Old Dominion the most representatives in the group, with 5 of the 25 total.



CAA Dominance at Home

Since Old Dominion joined the CAA in 1992, the Lady Monarchs have only lost four games in Norfolk. The most recent was last Sunday as VCU posted a 19-point win over the Lady Monarchs, the largest margin of defeat ODU has suffered in a home conference game. Old Dominion is now 151-4 in regular season conference games at home since joining the CAA. Including the eight CAA Tournaments held in Norfolk, Old Dominion has a 174-4 overall record against CAA opponents.

Streaking to the Top

Old Dominion has won 11 of their last 12 games to take over sole possession of first place in the CAA. ODU was locked in a three-way tie for first until the win against UNC Wilmington, when Drexel and VCU both lost to give the Lady Monarchs sole possession of first place. VCU answered with a win over ODU to tie the Lady Monarchs at the top of the standings again, but the next game, VCU fell to Hofstra while ODU defeated Delaware, taking sole possession again.

51's Enough

Old Dominion defeated Hofstra this season by a final of 51-46. The 51 points scored tied the lowest scored in a win for Old Dominion since 1973-74. Twice prior, ODU has won with just 51 points scored, against UVA in 1980-81 and an overtime win against UNC Wilmington in 2002-03.

Whew! That Was Close

ODU is excelling in tight ball games this season, going 9-2 in the eleven games decided by single digits this season, including seven straight. Four have come on the road (JMU, Towson, UNCW and GSU) and ODU also defeated Georgia State, Hofstra and Delaware at home by single digits. Old Dominion's closest game this season was a 1-point win at Delaware, powered to victory by Jasmine Parker taking a charge and knocking down a go-ahead 3-pointer late in the game. They were also forced to win on a last second shot at Georgia State, when Tia Lewis converted an old-fashioned three-point play with 0.6 seconds remaining for the two-point win.

Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points.

Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks second in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 29.4% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 23.1% from long range (42-for-182).

Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, sophomore Tia Lewis is third in the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 54.5% of her shots. ODU holds two of the top seven spots as senior Jessica Canady is seventh in the league, with 51.3% of her shots falling.

As a team, ODU is second in the league in shooting percentage. ODU is shooting at a 42.5% clip while Delaware leads at 43.5% as a team. The Lady Monarchs are also shooting well from long-range, shooting 32.4% from beyond the arc in CAA games, fifth in the league. ODU also ranks second in free-throw shooting, knocking down 76.6% from the charity stripe.

12-for-12

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978.

1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 904-310 over the past 41 years for a .745 success rate.

Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has worked her way back from offseason surgery and has now started 15 straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. The Lady Monarch senior has breached the 900-point plateau and is now also over 600 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 965 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.1 points per game since her sophomore season.

A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker is among the CAA leaders in steals this season, averaging 2.5 per game with 61 thefts. The ODU junior now has 157 career steals, averaging 1.7 per game in her career.

Still Toughest Schedule in the CAA

Old Dominion's schedule is the toughest in the CAA, and among the strongest in the country. After closing out the non-conference schedule, Old Dominion had the fifth toughest schedule in the nation. Heading into today's game, ODU's schedule was listed as the 38th strongest and the Lady Monarchs RPI is also listed as #61 after 23 games. Both numbers come from rpiratings.com's weekly report.

Magic Number 24

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion. She notched a new CAA-high with 13 rebounds against VCU.

Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now second on the team, averaging 11.5 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

Parker is knocking down scoring marks this season, breaching the 600-, 700- and 800-point plateaus as a junior. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 800 points, as senior Jessica Canady has over 950.

Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 99-19 record. ODU suffered just its third CAA loss ever at the Ted earlier this season, when VCU defeated the Lady Monarchs 75-56 on February 7, 2010. Of the 19 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

The Lady Monarchs are just one win shy of 100 in the Constant Center. Head Coach Wendy Larry is also approaching yet another milestone, just 17 wins shy of her 600th.

Individually, Jessica Canady is just 35 points shy of becoming the 27th Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000 point mark.

900 WINS!

With the 51-46 win over Hofstra on January 31, the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 904-310 (.745) in over 40 years of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish third in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the head coaches. Defending champions Drexel were pegged as the top team heading into 2009-10 with James Madison also selected ahead of ODU.

Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
