MONARCH NOTES

SCOUTING THE PANTHERS

FIU is coming into the Thursday contest on a three game losing streak following losses at UAB, Middle Tennessee and Rice. The Panthers have won four games so far this season, which is one game short of their overall record last season.

Junior Jiselle Thomas leads the team in scoring, averaging 10.9 points per game. Right behind her sits Chelsea Guimaraes, who is averaging 10.2 points per game. Defensively, Guimaraes also paces the Panthers in rebounding, averaging 7.2 rebounds per game. Head coach Tiara Malcom has been at the helm of the program since the 2016-17 season.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE MONARCHS

ODU went 2-0 last week in league play, notching wins over WKU and Marshall. The Monarchs defeated Marshall, 57-46. For the second-straight game Ajah Wayne led ODU to victory by recording another double-double with 19 points and 11 rebounds. Also recorded a double-double was Amari Young. It was the first time two players recorded a double-double in the same game since Taylor Edwards and Odegua Digboke did it in 2017 against South Carolina State.

AJAH WAYNE TWO-TIME C-USA POW

This past week, sophomore Ajah Wayne was named C-USA Co-Player of the Week as voted on by the leagues 14 communications directors. She shared the honor with Nancy Mulkey of Rice. The Alabama native earned the honor for her performance against WKU and Marshall, posting back-to-back double-doubles. Earlier in the season on Nov. 18, she was named C-USA Player of the Week. Wayne scored a career-high 35 points in the Monarchs 89-77 win over Auburn on Nov. 14. Waynes performance also marked the first 30+ point game from a Monarch since March 9, 2017.

A HOP IN THE RPI

The Monarchs hold the best RPI in the league with an RPI of 37. After defeating WKU on Thursday evening and Marshall on Saturday afternoon, ODU jumped up from 44 to 37. FIU currently sits at an RPI of 307.

NEARING 1K

Junior Victoria Morris is nearing the 1,000 point mark with 842 points. Averaging 11.4 ppg, the Ohio native should reach the milestone this season if she remains on that track. Senior Taylor Edwards also nears the milestone. She currently has 775 points in her career.

FINAL FOUR GAMES ANNOUNCED

The new schedule format was passed by the league's Athletic Directors in May and Board of Directors during their annual summer meetings in June. The 18-game slate follows the men's basketball traditional play layout for the first 14 games, with consideration for competitive balance and geographical constraints to determine the remaining four games. The innovative layout was constructed to provide competitive matchups at the end of the regular season with the ultimate goal of increasing the number of C-USA teams advancing to postseason competition.

including becoming the all-time leading scorer and rebounder in ODU history with 2,719 points and 1,976 rebounds.

ODU picked up three consecutive wins while hosting the inaugural Anne Donovan Classic at the Chartway Arena. Over the three games, ODU defeated the opponents by 110 total points, most notably by 51 points over the Mount, which marked their first 50+ point win over an opponent since 2004 against Towson.

Individually, Victoria Morris was named Tournament MVP, while Aziah Hudson was named to the All-Tournament team. The pair combined for 75 points through those three games. During the Monarchs dominant win over the Mount, Morris went five-for-five from beyond the arc and scored 19 points.

After closing out the tournament with three wins, ODU went from a 64 RPI to a 59. Western Kentucky (31) and Charlotte (37) are the only two other teams in the C-USA with a higher RPI.

WEST COAST TRIP

The Monarchs traveled to Cal Poly last week, which is 2,859 miles from Old Dominion University. They came away 2-0 in California in just their first meetings against those two schools.

The last time the Monarchs traveled to the West Coast was Nikki McCray's first season at the helm of the program, where ODU competed in the Holiday Hoops Classic in Las Vegas, Nevada. The only current players on the team who made that trip were Taylor Edwards, Dejah Carter and Victoria Morris.

FIRST POWER FIVE WIN SINCE 2014-15 SEASON
ODU topped Auburn on Nov. 14, 89-77 on the road. The win marked the first victory over a Power 5 team since March 19, 2015, when ODU defeated Virginia. During the win, the Monarchs posted a program-record 14 single-game 3-pointers.

RETURNING ALL BUT TWO

Head coach Nikki McCray returns nearly her entire roster from the 2018-19 season. McCray did not graduate any student-athletes and had just two players transfer. Despite the two player loss, McCray did not lose one starter.

13-WIN IMPROVMENT IN 2018-19

The Monarchs are coming off one of the biggest turnarounds, not only in program history, but in the nation. In Nikki McCray's second season, the Monarchs went 21-11, marking a 13-win improvement from the previous season. The 13-win mark was the second-best single-season improvement in program history and the sixth-best turnaround in the NCAA last year. With the 21 wins, ODU earned an at-large bid to the WNIT, the program's seventh appearance in the WNIT and first postseason appearance since 2015.

ODU IN THE C-USA PRESEASON POLL

Released by the C-USA on October 16, the Monarchs were picked to finish 5th in the league. The poll was voted on by all 14 head coaches. See below for the entire 2019 C-USA Preseason Poll.

FIRST POSTSEASON APPEARANCE SINCE 2015

With their at-large bid to the WNIT in 2019, it marked their first postseason appearance since 2015 when ODU took a trip to the second round of the WNIT under previous head coach Karen Barefoot.

THE CHARTWAY ARENA

The Monarchs now have a new name for their home in the Chartway Arena. This change comes thanks to a 10-year, \$4.25 million branding and sponsorship agreement between Old Dominion University and Chartway Federal Credit Union. As part of the agreement, Chartway will also contribute \$25,000 annually in scholarships for ODU student athletes.

#EMPOWER

This year's social media hashtag theme is #Empower, replacing last year's motto of #RootedTogether. The #Empower theme pushes the Monarchs to be accountable, encouraging and role models to one another.

ONE LAST RIDE

Starting as a walk-on in 2016, Taylor Edwards has made huge strides on and off the court as she laces up for her final season and third overall with head coach Nikki McCray. In her junior campaign, Edwards played in all 32 games, making 30 starts, where she averaged 11.4 points, 5.0 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 1.5 steals. She also led the team and ranked fourth in Conference USA in assists.

ALL CONFERENCE ACCOLADES IN 2018-19

Victoria Morris was named to the All-C-USA Second Team and Wayne was named to both the All-Freshman Team and All-Defensive Team. Morris closed out her sophomore campaign averaging a team-leading 12.8 points to go along with 2.3 rebounds and 1.3 assists, despite missing eight games due to a right foot injury late in the season. Wayne averaged 11.9 points, 7.9 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.7 steals. She played in all but one game, making 30 starts. The Alabama native turned in one of the greatest freshman seasons in school history.

Nikki McCray-Penson is in her third season as the head coach of ODU women's basketball in 2019-20.

In 2018-19, Old Dominion posted one of the biggest turnarounds not only in program history, but in the nation, in McCray's second season. The Monarchs went 21-11, marking a 13-win improvement from the previous season. The 13+ win mark was the sixth-highest in the NCAA in 2018-19 and the second-best in program history. With the 21 wins, ODU earned an at-large bid to the WNIT, the program's seventh appearance in the WNIT and first postseason appearance since 2015. McCray also guided ODU to a nearly 15-point improvement offensively from a season ago, as the Monarchs increased their scoring average from 54.6 in 2017-18 to 68.5 in 2018-19. McCray achieved all of this, despite having the seventh youngest roster in the country entering the season. Individually, McCray helped coach Victoria Morris to Second Team All-Conference USA honors and Ajah Wayne to C-USA All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team honors.

In 2017-18, McCray and the Monarchs compiled an 8-23 record and fell in the opening round of the Conference USA Tournament. Individual highlights for ODU in 2017-18 included Victoria Morris' sensational freshman season, as Morris was named to the C-USA All-Freshman Team and ranked fifth amongst all freshmen in the nation in threes made per game, along with Kelly Loftus joining the 1,000 career point club.

McCray-Penson, who previously served as an assistant coach at South Carolina since May of 2008, helped lead South Carolina to its first-ever National Championship. A two-time Olympic gold medal winner and Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductee in 2012, McCray-Penson reunited with her former 1996 Team USA teammate when she joined head coach Dawn Staley's South Carolina staff as an assistant in May of 2008.

Following an 11-year professional playing career, McCray-Penson moved into the coaching ranks in 2006, spending two seasons at Western Kentucky before joining the Gamecocks. A three-time WNBA All-Star and the 1996-97 American Basketball League's Most Valuable Player, McCray-Penson has proven to be a standout recruiter who helped South Carolina land the nation's No. 2 recruiting class and the top player in the country in 2014.

South Carolina earned four straight NCAA Tournament No. 1 seeds, the program's first coming in 2014. Appearing in the event's Sweet 16 in five of the last six seasons, the Gamecocks reached their first NCAA Final Four in 2015. South Carolina capped the 2016-17 season with its best final national ranking, coming in at No. 1 in the USA Today Coaches Poll. The Gamecocks finished among the nation's top 10 each of the past four seasons.

McCray-Penson takes over the reign of one of the most storied women's basketball programs in college basketball. The Lady Monarchs have over 1,000 program wins, three national championships, 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, 17 conference championships and 55 All-Americans.

McCray-Penson got her start in coaching at Western Kentucky where she played a key role in recruiting. With her on the staff, she helped lead the Lady Toppers to a 49-17 record, which included a WNIT semifinal appearance in 2006-07 and a Sun Belt Tournament title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament in 2007-08.

Prior to moving into the coaching world, McCray-Penson enjoyed a nine-year career in the WNBA, following a two-year stint in the ABL. She signed her first professional playing contract with the ABL's Columbus Quest in 1996 and proceeded to lead the team to the league championship, earning league MVP honors along the way. Joining the WNBA's Washington Mystics in 1998, McCray-Penson was the team's leading scorer in each of her first two seasons and played in the WNBA All-Star game three times in her four years in Washington. She earned a starting spot in the league's inaugural All-Star game in 1999 and was the leading vote-getter among Eastern Conference guards in 2000.

McCray-Penson went on to play five more seasons in the WNBA, spending two with the Indiana Fever and one each with the Phoenix Mercury, the San Antonio Silver Stars and the Chicago Sky prior to her retirement at the end of the 2006 season. With 2,528 points, she finished her career ranked 24th on the WNBA's career scoring list. Averaging 10.1 points per game, she was a career 41.3 percent shooter.

A veteran of international basketball as well, McCray-Penson was part of the USA Basketball program on three separate occasions. Those stints were highlighted by trips to the Olympic Games in 1996 and 2000, both of which resulted in gold medals for the United States. She was a key element on the 1995-96 team that spent more than a year together in residency, something never done before in USA Basketball's history. The effort helped the group to 60-0 record in international competition and sparked two professional women's basketball leagues in the United States.

In her four-year career playing under Pat Summitt at Tennessee, McCray-Penson keyed three SEC regular-season titles, two conference tournament championships and four NCAA Tournament appearances for the Lady Vols. In addition to helping UT build a 122-11 record, McCray-Penson picked up All-America and SEC Player of the Year honors in both her junior and senior years. She scored 1,572 career points, a number that still ranks her among the Lady Vols' all-time top 15.

McCray-Penson graduated from Tennessee in 1995 with a Bachelor of Science in Education. She is married to Thomas Penson, and they have a son, Thomas Nikson Penson.
