About Old Dominion

- Old Dominion is coming off its second win over a major conference team this season. The Lady Monarchs topped Louisville, 69-65 Friday and defeated Georgia Tech earlier this season.
- Senior Jasmine Parker scored a career-high tying 24 points on 9-of-15 shooting to lead ODU against the Cardinals. Parker also canned three of the five triples she attempted.
- Junior Tia Lewis posted her first double-double of the season and 22nd of her career against Louisville. Lewis netted 15 points and pulled down a season-high 10 rebounds in the win.
- Five of ODU's first six games, including tonight, are against teams from the ACC, BIG EAST & SEC.

Game Day Notes

Louisville Recap

Senior Jasmine Parker tied her career-high with 24 points and junior Tia Lewis had her first double-double of the season with 15 points and 10 rebounds as Old Dominion topped BIG EAST foe Louisville, 69-65, in front of 3,038 fans at the Constant Center Friday evening. Parker, who had 23 points at NC State on Tuesday, shot 9-of-15 from the field and 3-of-5 from beyond the arc to lead Old Dominion (3-1). Senior Shadasia Green chipped in 10 points, including six during a critical 12-0 ODU second half run.

With the game tied at halftime, Louisville came out of the locker room hot. The Cardinals commenced the second half on a 16-9 run to go up 51-44 at the 12:21 mark. Old Dominion responded with its biggest run of the game, a 12-0 spurt that gave the Lady Monarchs a 56-51 lead midway through the second stanza. Green had the final six points of the run, which gave ODU its largest lead of the contest. Louisville scored the next seven points and a Becky Burke three-point field goal gave the Cardinals a 61-60 lead with 4:52 remaining. On ODU's next possession, Parker canned a deep triple and the Lady Monarchs wouldn't relinquish the lead from that point. After a UofL basket tied the game at 63, Lewis converted a traditional three-point play to give Old Dominion a three-point advantage with just over three minutes on the clock. With Louisville trailing 67-65 with 41 seconds remaining, Schimmel missed the front end of a one-and-one and Parker raced the length of the court and converted a lay-in to seal the game.

Mid-Major Riser

Old Dominion continues to rise in the Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll. The Lady Monarchs jumped three spots and are currently No. 2 in the latest poll, which was released Tuesday. Green Bay, which is also ranked in the Coaches Poll, sits atop the rankings, while James Madison (No. 10) and Delaware (No. 12) also represent the CAA. ODU garnered 673 points this week and one first-place vote.

Tracking Parker

Senior guard Jasmine Parker is inching closer to becoming the 28 all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her 24 points against Louisville, she now sits with 975 points.

Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just nine wins shy of her 600th career victory. She has piled up a 591-224 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 542 career wins at ODU.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs will play one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against four teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel).

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 911-314 (.744) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

2009-10 Recap/2010-11 Preview
