- The Hokies are coming off a disappointing season that saw them go 7-23 overall and 3-13 in the ACC.
- Virginia Tech was picked to finish 11th out of 12 teams in the 2012-13 ACC preseason poll.
- Junior forward transfer Uju Ugoka was named to the newcomer watch list
- VT returns their top four scorers and six of their top seven scorers from a year ago.
- Junior guard Monet Tellier (13.7ppg, 4.5 rpg) and senior guard Aerial Wilson (12.1 ppg, 2.4 rpg) led the returns for the Hokies

### About Old Dominion

- The Lady Monarchs return seven letterwinners and three starters from last season when they went 11-21.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot added five newcomers in the offseason as six new faces will see action in the 2012-13 season.
- Incoming freshmen include guards Galaisha Goodhope and LaQuanda Younger and center Brittany Martin. Transfers in to ODU include forward Shae Kelley and guard Stephanie Gardner.
- ODU was picked to finish fifth in the preseason CAA poll.
- Sophomore guard Ashley Betz-White was named to honorable mention list for All-CAA preseason accolades.
- In their exhibition game on Sunday, three Lady Monarchs scored in double figures, led by Shae Kelley who scored 18 and picked up nine rebounds in the 70-50 victory over Elizabeth City State.

## Karen Barefoot

ODU head coach Karen Barefoot enters her 14th year as a head coach in 2012-13 and 200 plus wins in her career as she leads the Lady Monarch program in year two. As head coach at the Apprentice School in 2001, she led the Builders to a National Championship while taking Lenoir-Rhyne the NCAA Tournament in the 2002-03 season. In 2010-11 while at Elon, she led the Phoenix to the WBI, the schools first ever women's basketball tournament appearance.

## Exhibition Victory

Sophomore Shae Kelley just missed a double-double as she led all scorers with 18 points and grabbed nine rebounds to go along with five steals, two blocks and an assist in her first game with the Lady Monarchs to help ODU to a 70-50 win over Elizabeth City State on Sunday.

After a slow start to begin the game, the Lady Monarchs went on a 19-7 run to end the first half and took a 32-21 lead into halftime. In the second half, ODU pulled away behind a smothering defense that racked up 19 steals, forced 35 turnovers, registered eight blocks, scored 42 points off turnovers and had 13 fast break points.

Senior Jackie Cook added 13 points, six rebounds, two blocks and two steals while sophomore Tiffany Minor provided 11 points, three steals, a rebound and an assist off the bench.

## Captains

Senior guard Jackie Cook, senior forward Mairi Buchan and sophomore forward Jackie Cook have been selected as team captains for the 2012-13 season.

## Lady Monarchs Picked Fifth

Old Dominion was picked to finish fifth this season in the CAA pre-season poll. The voting was done by the league's head coaches. Delaware was picked to win the CAA, followed by James Madison, Hofstra and Drexel. Old Dominion and Northeastern followed, while George Mason and UNCW tied for seventh. Towson and William & Mary tied for ninth, followed by Georgia State.

## Betz-White Preseason All-CAA

Sophomore Ashley Betz-White was listed as honorable mention on the preseason All-CAA teams. Last season, she was named the CAA Rookie of the Year and to the All-CAA Rookie Team after leading all CAA freshmen in points per game (8.1), assists per game (3.4) and minutes per game (31.3). Betz-White became just the sixth player in program history to record over 100 assists in her first year.

## Kelley A Key

Sophomore forward Shae Kelley has already made a big impact on her teammates as she was selected as one of the team captains for 2012-13 despite not having played a single minute yet for Old Dominion. The Colorado native powered the Lady Monarchs in the exhibition win over ECSU on Sunday as she just missed a double-double with 18 points and nine rebounds.

## Betz-White Shines in First Year

Sophomore Ashley Betz-White was named the CAA Rookie of the Year in 2011-12 and finished the season with 110 assists which made her only the sixth Lady Monarch in school history to have 100 assists her rookie season.
