

2021 Game Notes vs. Old Dominion

2021 GAME 2 - AT OLD DOMINION

Hitting the road for the first time in 2021, the Pirates head just across the water to take on the Monarchs of Old Dominion. This will be the sixth all-time meeting with ODU winning the previous five, including the last one in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT

HAMPTON, Va. - Hitting the field for the first time since Nov. 23, 2019, the Hampton Pirates got 143 yards from Darran Butts and 136 from Elijah Burris as they defeated Virginia Union 42-28 on Saturday night.

Hampton got on the board with a pair of first quarter touchdowns as Jett Duffey connected with Jadakis Bonds on an 11-yard slant pass to cap off a 13-play, 83-yard drive and put the Pirates up 7-0.

After forcing a Panther punt, the next scoring drive was a quickie as Butts broke several tackles and outraced the secondary to the end zone for an 85-yard score and a 13-0 Hampton lead with 5:47 left in the opening quarter.

Virginia Union found its stride in the second quarter and put up a pair of touchdowns as Domantay Rhem finished off a 12-play, 75-yard drive with a one-yard plunge on the opening play of the second quarter. The Panthers took a 14-13 lead at the 3:42 mark as Khalid Morris connected with Rodney McKay on a five-yard pass.

The third quarter saw each team put up a touchdown as Burris got the first of his three touchdowns on a two-yard scamper on the opening possession of the quarter. A two-point conversion pass from Duffey to James Stanley put Hampton up 21-14 at the 12:17 mark.

The Panthers answered taking advantage of a short field after a punt with a trick play as wide receiver Jaden Reavis connected with Charles Hall on a 39-yard quick strike to tie the game at 21-all with 8:50 left.

In the fourth, Hampton took another one score lead as Duffey found KeyRon Catlett on an 18-yard touchdown pass with 12:42 left and a 28-21 Pirate advantage.

The Panthers responded again covering 75 yards in 94 seconds with Morris finding Desmond Smith for the last 40 with a scoring strike to tie the game at 28 at the 11:08 mark.

Burris set up the next Hampton score with a 51-yard kickoff return down to the VUU 29. A 24-yard completion to Romon Copeland got the Pirates down to the four, before Burris finished it with a one-yard score and a 35-28 lead with 9:05 remaining.

He completed his trifecta of touchdowns as Hampton with consecutive 30-yard runs. After starting on the Hampton four, a pair of seven-yard Will Robinson runs sandwiched a 22-yard Duffey-to-Bonds connection as Hampton clawed out to the 40. Burris' first 30-yard run put the ball at the Virginia Union 30 and he closed out the 96-yard drive with a 30-yard burst with 3:29 left.

Hampton amassed 611 yards of total offense with 369 on the ground and 242 in the air. Bonds was the leading receiver with seven for 62 yards, while Robinson grinded out 62 yards on 12 carries.

The Pirates defense forced three turnovers with Caleb Brown recording a pair of interceptions. The last of which killed the Panthers hopes as he snared one to end their final possession

at the Hampton 35. DeAndre Faulk had seven tackles, while Donald Smith had six and two pass breakups. KeShaun Moore and Andy Matthews each had five tackles.

KILLER B'S STRIKE PANTHERS

The running back tandem of Elijah Burris (136) and Darran Butts (143) became the sixth tandem since 1986 to run for 130 or more yards in the same game last week. Burris scored three touchdowns, including the go-ahead and clincher in the fourth quarter. Butts scored on an 85-yard run late in the first quarter.

BIG SOUTH HONORS

On the heels of his 136 yard, three touchdown performance Elijah Burris was named Co-Big South Freshman of the Week. He accounted for 194 all purpose yards with a 51 yard kickoff return to set up the go-ahead touchdown and catching two passes for seven yards.

Also earning Big South honors after the opening week was senior Caleb Brown who took home Defensive Player of the Week accolades for a two-interception performance. Brown was the first Pirate since 2014 to snare two interceptions in one game.

STATS PERFORM FCS NATIONAL FRESHMAN HONOR

Elijah Burris earned national FCS Freshman of the Week honors by Stats Perform after his debut against Virginia Union. With his 194 all-purpose yards, he became the first Pirate in at least the last five years to get a national honor

HEAD COACH ROBERT PRUNTY



Robert Prunty, a veteran with more than 30 years of football experience as a player and coach and a four-time conference recruiter-of-the-year honoree with two different Football Bowl Sub-division (FBS) programs, is entering his fourth season as head coach at

The Pirates saw action in Mississippi, South Carolina, Iowa, New York and New Jersey for their road games in 2018 and ended the season with a six-game winning streak. Offensively, the Pirates put up 50+ points on three occasions and had two games scoring in the 40s.

Prunty served the 2017 season as East Carolina University's associate head coach, defensive coordinator and defensive line coach. Prior to that, he served four years as the University of Cincinnati's associate head coach and defensive ends coach and three years as co-defensive coordinator. Before impacting the Bearcat program, Prunty spent three seasons under Tommy Tuberville at Texas Tech, 2010-2012, directing the Red Raiders' defensive ends.

In seven combined seasons at the FBS level, Prunty has been part of five bowl appearances, a conference co-championship and was recognized by Scout.com as the Big 12 Conference Recruiter-of-the-Year in 2010-11 and 2011-12 before earning similar honors as the American Athletic Conference's (AAC) top recruiter in 2012-13 and 2013-14.

Prunty helped guide the Bearcats to the Belk, Military and Hawai'i Bowls in 2013, 2014 and 2015, respectively, and worked with 10 All-AAC defensive selections. Linebacker Eric Wilson was a first-team pick in 2016 after leading the league and standing fifth nationally with 10.8 tackles per game, while Cortez Broughton (2016), Silverberry Mouhon (2015, 2013), Terrell Hartsfield (2014) and Jordan Stepp

Hampton University.

"I am excited to welcome Coach Prunty back to our Home by the Sea," said Hampton University President Dr. William R. Harvey. "Coach Prunty's record of consistent, sustained outstanding performance will take our football program to the next level. I enthusiastically welcome him to Hampton Nation."

The 2019 season saw Hampton move into the Big South Conference on the gridiron as the Pirates learned new opponents and finished with a 5-7 record. Jadakis Bonds and Shai McKenzie were named to the Big South Conference All-Conference First Team, while Christian Angulo was a second team honoree.

In his first season, the Pirates ventured far and wide playing a FCS independent season and finished with a 7-3 record.



(2013) were all honored as the conference's top linemen.

While at Texas Tech, he was part of a strong defensive turnaround in 2012 as the Red Raiders finished the regular season ranked 39th at the FBS level in total defense after standing 114th in 2011. Lineman Kerry Hyder was an All-Big 12 selection after ranking third on the squad with 56 tackles and a team-leading 14.0 tackles for lost yardage and six sacks. He tallied 10.5 TFLs during Big 12 play alone to lead the conference.

Prunty, who joined the Red Raiders in 2010 from Hargrave Military Academy, put his mark on the TTU football program almost immediately after playing an integral part in signing the highest-rated recruiting class in school history in 2011. In addition to Scout.com, he was honored by Rivals.com as the Big 12 Conference's top-rated recruiter.

His player evaluation and relationship cultivation skills produced Texas Tech's second-highest rated class in school history in 2012 and his efforts were saluted by both Scout.com and Fox Sports.

From 2002 to 2009, Prunty served as head football coach at Hargrave Military Academy where 27 of his players went on to the National Football League - two as first-round draft choices.

Prior to his tenure at Hargrave, Prunty led a resurgence at Gretna (Va.) High School, redirecting a program that lost 44 consecutive games between 1991 and 1995 into

an 11-1 product during his final season in 2001. Gretna went on to become a powerhouse, winning multiple state championships.

Prunty is a Chatham, Va., native and a 1983 Hargrave Military Academy graduate. He split his collegiate career between Hampton University and Alabama A&M, where he graduated in 1988.

He is married to Kimberly and has one son Robert Prunty, Jr. and a daughter Gabrielle.
