Quick Hits:

- ODU has won two straight and 10 of 11 to take over sole possession of first in the league standings; ODU has the tiebreaker over Drexel in second place and will play third-place VCU again next week
- The Lady Monarch schedule through 23 games still ranks the toughest in the CAA; ranked as high as #1 this season, it is now slated as the 38th toughest in the nation
- Sophomore Tia Lewis is averaging 10.9 ppg and 7.9 rpg after averaging a double-double during her first season at UCF
- Despite just 92 points her freshman year as a reserve player, senior Jessica Canady now has 950 career points; she needs just 50 more to become the 27th Lady Monarch with 1,000 career points
- Junior Jasmine Parker has been on fire since the CAA season started, leading the team in CAA-only scoring with 12.8 ppg; she has 802 career points in her third year, ranking fourth among active CAA juniors
- INJURY ALERT: Jackie Cook sat out two games with a bruised knee; she also suffered a broken nose against Hofstra and will play with a mask when she returns -- she is likely to return vs. Georgia State
- GSU started the season 10-2 but has suffered nine losses in their last 12 games
- Danyiell McKeller is one of the top scorers in the league, ranking 5th in the CAA with 11.4 ppg; she's also second in the league in steals with 2.6 per contest

Recap:

Senior Jessica Canady and sophomore Tia Lewis both recorded double-doubles for Old Dominion, which improved to 7-9 overall and 5-1 in league play with the 58-54 win over Georgia State. Lewis recorded her fifth double-double of the year with 14 points and 11 rebounds, while Canady posted her second in the last five games with a team-high 15 points and a game-high 14.

In the first half, ODU got 11 points and six rebounds from Canady, who continued her stellar league play this season with the first half effort, knocking down 5-of-6 shots. The Lady Monarchs struggled to create distance though, despite shooting 48.3% on 14-of-29 shooting.

Georgia State hung around for the bulk of the first period behind leading scorer Danyell McKeller's shooting effort. ODU led by as many as seven in the first half, but McKeller kept the Panthers within striking distance, scoring 14 points on 7-of-16 shooting.

Returning to the floor, the two teams battled in a back-and-forth affair for the second half. The Lady Monarchs fell behind by four to the Panthers with 13:05 remaining on an Angelique Burtt's fast break lay-in, but would score eight of the next ten points to re-take the lead.

Georgia State would not lead again, though they would tie the score four more times before the game was out, including a 54-54 tie with 32 seconds remaining. After the make, Green banked in her go-ahead shot with 21 seconds remaining for the gamewinning score.

The Lady Monarchs struggled from long range, going just 1-for-12 on 3-pointers, but shot 41.5% from the field on 22-of-53 shooting. Canady collected eight rebounds in the second to set a new career-high in CAA play with 14 total rebounds.

All-Time Series

Against Georgia State:

Georgia State took their first victory in the all-time series last season, defeating ODU in Atlanta, 75-62. Prior to the win, ODU had won seven straight to open the series, dating back to the 2005-2006 season when the Panthers joined the CAA. With the win earlier this season, ODU now holds a 8-1 advantage in the all-time series.

About the Panthers:

Georgia State had a stellar non-conference season this year, going 9-2 in out of league games. The Panthers pieced together a six-game winning streak and their only losses in the first 12 games came to the ACC's Florida State University and Georgia Tech.

However, Georgia State has struggled in league play, losing in 9 of their last 12 games. The Panthers won against Towson and William & Mary at home and also on the road vs. George Mason

GSU has been led by returning star Danyell McKeller, among the league leaders in scoring. McKeller is averaging 18.8 points per game and is also second on the team in rebounding, hauling in 6.3 rebounds per game. She is fifth in the league in scoring and is shooting 41.4% from the field. She is among the league leaders in thefts, stealing 2.6 per game, tied for second in the CAA.

Speaking of steals, the Panthers are one of the best in the league in takeaways, averaging 11.0 per game, behind only VCU. Georgia State leads the conference in assists and assist/turnover ratio, led by point guard Crystal Johnson. Johnson is averaging nearly six assists per game, leading the league.

Georgia State lost second-leading scorer Chan Harris for the season to a foot injury and have seen Shay Rawls step into the starting slot.

Streaking to the Top

Old Dominion won ten of their last eleven games to take over sole possession of first place in the CAA. ODU was locked in a three-way tie for first until the win against UNC Wilmington, when Drexel and VCU both lost to give the Lady Monarchs sole possession of first place. VCU answered with a win over ODU to tie the Lady Monarchs at the top of the standings again, but the next game, VCU fell to Hofstra while ODU defeated Delaware, taking sole possession again.

51's Enough

Old Dominion defeated Hofstra this season by a final of 51-46. The 51 points scored tied the lowest scored in a win for Old Dominion since 1973-74. Twice prior, ODU has won with just 51 points scored, against UVA in 1980-81 and an overtime win against UNC Wilmington in 2002-03.

Whew! That Was Close

ODU is excelling in tight ball games this season, winning eight of their ten games decided by single digits, including six straight. Three came on the road (JMU, Towson and UNCW) and ODU also defeated Georgia State, Hofstra and Delaware at home by single digits. Old Dominion's closest game this season was a 1-point win at Delaware, powered to victory by Jasmine Parker taking a charge and knocking down a go-ahead 3-point-er late in the game.

Big Win in Harrisonburg

The Lady Monarchs earned their first win against JMU in Harrisonburg since 2005, snapping a four-game losing streak over that span. The win also snapped JMU's nine-game home winning streak and was just the ninth loss suffered on the home floor in the last 75 home games for the Dukes. Old Dominion won 67-58, holding off a second half surge from the Dukes after taking a 15-point halftime lead. Junior Jasmine Parker nearly had a triple-double, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds and dishing a career-high tying six assists to go with her ten points. Senior Jessica Canady led the way with 14 points.

Three-Point Defense

JMU, one of the nation's top long-ball teams, was able to knock down just a pair of 3-pointers on 23 attempts against the Lady Monarchs. For the season, ODU ranks third in the CAA in 3-pt FG percentage defense, allowing just 29.7% from beyond the arc. In conference only games, ODU leads the league, allowing an abysmal 23.3% from long range (40-for-172).

Hot Conference Shooting

ODU can be found among the league leaders in several statistical categories. In conference games this season, sophomore Tia Lewis is third in the league in field goal percentage, knocking down 53.7% of her shots. ODU holds two of the top five spots as senior Jessica Canady is fifth in the league, with 52% of her shots falling.

As a team, ODU is second in the league in shooting percentage. ODU is shooting at a 42.4% clip while Delaware leads at 42.7% as a team. The Lady Monarchs are also scorching from long-range, shooting 32.8% from beyond the arc in CAA games, fourth in the league. ODU also ranks second in free-throw shooting, knocking down 77.1% from the charity stripe.

12-for-12

Junior Jasmine Parker helped lead ODU past Drexel with a perfect 12-for-12 night at the free-throw line. It was a career-best, a new Constant Center record and the second best performance by a Lady Monarch in the history of the program. Only Nancy Lieberman had a better night from the line, going 15-for-15 in 1978.

1200 And Counting...

With the non-conference finale against Tennessee, the Lady Monarchs reached 1200 games played in the history of the program. ODU joins a select group of just eight programs to play 1200 games in their histories. They are Tennessee Tech, Tennessee, Stephen F. Austin, Long Beach State, Kansas State, James Madison, and Hofstra. ODU ranks second in winning percentage among these eight teams, going 903-310 over the past 41 years for a .744 success rate.

Senior Moments

ODU has just one senior this season, First Team Pre-season All-CAA forward Jessica Canady. Canady has worked her way back from offseason surgery and has now started 14 straight games after being forced to sit through half of the non-conference schedule. She broke out in a big way against Northeastern, scoring 18 points and hauling in a team-high 12 rebounds while playing a career-high 36 minutes. The Lady Monarch senior has breached the 900-point plateau and is now also over 600 career rebounds. Canady was a reserve player her freshman year, scoring only 92 points, making her 950 career all the more impressive, averaging 11.0 points per game since her sophomore season.

A Rare Occurrence

ODU lost to Tennessee by a final score of 102-62 in the non-conference finale this season, marking just the sixth time in program history the Lady Monarchs allowed a team to reach 100 points. Northeastern then posted its first ever 100-point game against ODU, marking just the seventh occurrence against the Lady Monarchs.

Stop! Thief!

Jasmine Parker is among the CAA leaders in steals this season, averaging 2.6 per game with 59 thefts. The ODU junior now has 155 career steals, averaging 1.7 per game in her career.

Still Toughest Schedule in the CAA

Old Dominion's schedule is the toughest in the CAA, and among the strongest in the country. After closing out the non-conference schedule, Old Dominion had the fifth toughest schedule in the nation. Heading into today's game, ODU's schedule was listed as the 38th strongest and the Lady Monarchs RPI is also listed as #61 after 23 games. Both numbers come from rpiratings.com's weekly report.

Magic Number 24

Three players have tallied new career highs early this season, all with 24 points scored. Jasmine Parker scored 24 against Maryland to set a new career-high, while Tia Lewis and Shadasia Green both scored 24 against Louisville to set their new mark.

17 Again...

Sophomore forward Tia Lewis tied her career-high with 17 rebounds against Ole Miss, taking over the top spot in the CAA with 9.2 rebounds per game at the time. Lewis had 17 in a game against North Florida during her freshman year while playing for Central Florida and the 17 hauled in against Mississippi tied that mark for the first time as a Lady Monarch. She also posted her first double-double in the game, scoring 15 points for Old Dominion. She notched a new CAA-high with 13 rebounds against VCU.

Potent Parker

In the second game of the season, Jasmine Parker scored a career-high 24 points and is now second on the team, averaging 11.5 points per game this season. She came out of the locker room on a torrid pace, scoring 12 of Old Dominion's first 20 points and giving the Lady Monarchs the lead against the 20th ranked team in the nation. She finished with 24 points, four assists, four rebounds and three steals in her second consecutive solid game against a nationally ranked opponent.

Parker is knocking down scoring marks this season, breaching the 600-, 700- and 800-point plateaus as a junior. She is one of two active Lady Monarchs to reach 800 points, as senior Jessica Canady has over 900.

Welcome to the Ted

Since the doors opened at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in 2002, the Lady Monarchs have enjoyed a 99-19 record. ODU suffered just its third CAA loss ever at the Ted earlier this season, when VCU defeated the Lady Monarchs 75-56 on February 7, 2010. Of the 19 losses in the Constant Center, TEN have been to nationally ranked opponents.

The Lady Monarchs are just one win shy of 100 in the Constant Center. Head Coach Wendy Larry is also approaching yet another milestone, just 18 wins shy of her 600th.

Individually, Jessica Canady is just 50 points shy of becoming the 27th Lady Monarch to reach the 1,000 point mark.

900 WINS!

With the 51-46 win over Hofstra on January 31, the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 903-310 (.744) in over 40 years of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

Toughest Schedule in the Nation

Though it's early, the Lady Monarchs schedule has been ranked the toughest in the nation through six games by rpiratings.com. According to the same source, ODU had the 74th best RPI, even with just the 1-5 record. Through six games ODU faced four teams receiving votes in the national rankings and the six teams combined had gone 39-8.

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish third in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the head coaches. Defending champions Drexel were pegged as the top team heading into 2009-10 with James Madison also selected ahead of ODU.

Startin' Out Right

Jasmine Parker played extremely well against the second ranked Cardinal in the season opener, scoring a team-high 16 points and adding five rebounds, four assists, a career-high five steals and a perfect 5-for-5 night from the free-throw line. Despite a poor first half, Tia Lewis also came away with a stellar first game, finishing just one rebound shy of a double-double. Lewis finished with 15 points and nine rebounds in her first game as a Lady Monarch. Junior Shadasia Green continued her hot play of late with 11 points and seven rebounds. She averaged 16 ppg and 7 rpg in the two exhibitions.

Season Openers

The Lady Monarchs are 27-14 in season openers, falling to 2nd ranked Stanford at home in this season's opener. ODU has dropped six of their last eight season-opening games.

Home Openers

In home openers, Old Dominion is 29-12, including a 4-4 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Last season, ODU opened the regular season home schedule with an upset of 11th ranked UVA by a final score of 78-70. It was the second straight win over the nationally ranked opponent at the Ted, including the overtime thriller in the NCAA Tournament the year before, and the seventh win over a nationally ranked opponent at the Constant Center. ODU lost to #2 Stanford in this season's home opener.

Exhibition Recap - Shaw

In the final tune-up of the 2009-10 preseason, ODU took care of the Shaw Lady Bears by a final score of 82-48. Senior Jessica Canady returned to the floor for her 2009-10 debut and dazzled, scoring 13 of her 15 points in the first half. She also grabbed five rebounds in 21 minutes of play. Junior Shadasia Green again had a stellar outing, posting 16 points in her second straight exhibition and added five boards. Tia Lewis joined Green and Canady in double figures with 10, despite only scoring two points in limited action in the first half due to foul trouble. Lewis finished 4-for-6 from the field. Rookie point guard Carolann Cloutier distributed eight assists in the game while newcomers Jackie Cook and Kquanise Byrd each dished four. Cook added eight points in the game and Byrd had two thefts. Sophomore center Mairi Buchan got on the boards for a second straight game, rebounding a team-high six missed shots against Shaw.

Exhibition Recap - Chowan

In the first look at the Lady Monarchs, ODU won in front of nearly 3,000 fans with ease, 85-52. Junior Shadasia Green led the way, with 16 points and 9 rebounds, just shy of a double-double. Newcomers Tia Lewis and Kquanise Byrd also showed off what Lady Monarch fans can expect to see this season with 11 and 12 points respectively. Byrd added four steals off the bench and went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line, while Lewis hauled in six boards. Leading the way on the glass after Green was sophomore center Mairi Buchan, grabbing eight boards. ODU had a commanding rebounding edge with 59 in the game compared to just 30 for Chowan.
