- Old Dominion returns home to Kornblau Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium to host Charlotte in the 2021 regular season finale.
- For the first time in school history, ODU defeated Middle Tennessee. Knocking off the Blue Raiders 24-17 in Murfreesboro last Saturday. Charlotte lost to Marshall, 49-28. The winner on Saturday will be bowl eligible with a 6-6 overall record.
- Blake Watson saw his streak of five-straight 100-yard rushing games come to an end, but he scored the eventual game-winning touchdown on a four-yard pass from Hayden Wolff. Watson carried 18 times for 57 yards on the day.
- Ali Jennings caught four passes for 146, including receptions of 43 and 60 yards. His shortest catch went for 19 yards.
- R'Tarriun Johnson, Jason Henderson and Terry Jones each had nine tackles, while Joe Joe Headen had three tackles and an interception.
- Linebacker Jordan Young had eight tackles in the win over FAU. Young moved into second on ODU's career tackles charts, with 328 career stops. He is 12 stops away from tying Craig Wilkins' school record of 340 career tackles.

First Season/Second Overall

Ricky Rahne is in his first season and second overall as head football coach at Old Dominion.

Rahne was the offensive coordinator at Penn State for two seasons and on the Nittany Lions coaching staff for six years.

For the past nine years, Rahne (pronounced ronnie) has developed an increasing national profile as a key component of Coach James Franklin's staff at both Penn State and Vanderbilt. The coaching staff has guided those teams to bowl games in each of the nine years and have won nine or more games in six of the last eight seasons.

"First, I love Ricky and his family. This is a bittersweet moment for our program. I am so incredibly proud of Ricky and I am super excited for him, his family and Old Dominion," Penn State head coach James Franklin said. "I am forever indebted to Ricky for his loyalty and drive in helping us succeed at Vanderbilt and Penn State. Ricky is a rising star in the industry and is built for this opportunity. He is a smart, open-minded and talented coach. His humble leadership style will resonate well with Old Dominion's leadership and players. I look forward to following his program at Old Dominion!"

"I want to thank President John Broderick for his involvement throughout the search process and his continued overall support for ODU athletics. He was a tremendous asset during the search process meeting at length with each of the final candidates and helping them understand the culture of ODU," Selig said. "Additionally, I would like to thank Senior Associate Athletic Director Bruce Stewart for his leadership role throughout the last week as we examined dozens of potential candidates. Bruce was a huge asset and worked tirelessly throughout the process helping to ensure a successful search."

Rahne has spent six seasons at Penn State, including the last two as offensive coordinator. Despite having a new starting quarterback, Rahne helped lead the Nittany Lion offense to 34 points per game this season, while six offensive players earned all-Big10 honors this season.

Known as a terrific offensive mind that can adjust to his personnel, Rahne demonstrated that again in 2019. Despite the loss of the No. 2 overall pick in the 2018 NFL Draft (Saquon Barkley), Penn State rushed for the most yards per game in the last 10 years at 204.9. PSU had nine players earn all-conference accolades, and the Nittany Lions led the Big10 with 42 red zone touchdowns, good for 16th in FBS.

Rahne was the quarterbacks coach in four of his six seasons at Penn State, as both of the quarterbacks he worked with were drafted into the NFL. In 2015, Christian Hackenberg (Jets, 2016)

became the all-time leader in career yards passing with 8,457 yards, Three years later, Rahne guided Trace McSorely (Ravens, 2019) past that mark in 2018 with 9,899 yards. He also coached the tight ends in 2016 and 2017, guiding Mike Gesicki who was drafted by the Miami Dolphins.

Penn State has played in a bowl game in every year Rahne was there, including a 2016 Big10 Championship and 2017 PlayStation Fiesta Bowl win over Washington. In that time, Penn State has had four-straight seasons of at least nine wins, and the Nittany Lions are one of five teams to rank in the Top-15 of the College Football Playoff final rankings in each of the last four years.

Prior to joining Penn State, Rahne was the quarterbacks coach at Vanderbilt for three years.

Prior to Rahne's time at Vanderbilt, the program had been to four bowl games in 121 years of football, none in consecutive seasons. The Commodores were ranked in the Top-25 in the final polls in 2012 and 2013 marking the first time they were ranked in back-to-back seasons in program history.

He spent five years at Kansas State, starting as an offensive graduate assistant before coaching the running backs and tight ends. He helped the Wildcats to two bowl appearances.

Rahne started his coaching career on the defensive side at Holy Cross coaching the defensive line. The following year he coached the running backs at his alma mater, Cornell.

He was a three-year starter at quarterback at Cornell (2002), and graduated as the Big Red's all-time leader in completions (678), passing yards (7,710), touchdown passes (54) and total offense (7,994). He was inducted into the Cornell Hall of Fame in 2014.

Rahne and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons, Ryder and Jake.

### **Showing Versatility**

Redshirt Junior Steven Williams was the second youngest quarterback to start an FBS game in 2017. He started four games at the position in 2018 before redshirting. In 2019, he played in all 12 games at wide receiver, including one start. This year, Williams has moved to linebacker and will compete for playing time at the position.

Williams has 15 tackles, two tackles for loss and a sack so far this season.

Sophomore tight end Zack Kuntz has become a fan favorite not only of Monarch Nation, but also the ODU quarterback.

Kuntz had eight grabs for 68 yards and a TD in the win at MTSU

He ranks second among FBS tight ends in receptions (66), seventh in receiving yards (656) and tied for 10th in touchdowns (5).

Kuntz also leads the Monarchs with 28 receptions that have gone for a first down.

A transfer from Penn State, Kuntz has been ODU's leading receiver in 9-of-11 games so far this season. He has five games with eight or more catches.

### Watson Closes in on 1,000

ODU running back had his streak of five-straight 100-yard rushing games snapped in the win at Middle Tennessee. Watson rushed 18 times for 57 yards, but did catch a four-yard touchdown pass. A first for the former ODU wide

Watson is 17th in the country with 103.2 yards per game and 41st in the country with 929 yards. Watson missed two games earlier in the season with an injury.

In seven league games, Watson is second only to UAB's DeWayne McBride in rushing yards

Watson would be the second Monarch to record a 1,000 yard rushing season, joining ODU's all-time leading rusher Ray Lawry, who did it twice. Lawry's freshman season in 2014 is the third highest single-season rushing total. Watson is 18 yards away from surpassing Lawry's total from that season.

### **Davis Runs Free**

Elijah Davis put ODU on top 17-10 early in the fourth quarter in the win at MTSU with a 45-yard touchdown run.

It was the seventh time this season Davis has recorded a run of 20+ yards this season, including a career-long 61 yard touchdown three weeks ago at FIU.

Watson and Davis rank seventh and eighth, respectively, on ODU's all-time rushing charts. Watson is seventh with 1,045 yards, while Davis is eighth with 1,011 yards.

### **Bringing Sacks to the Party**

ODU is ninth in the league with 20 sacks, but for the second-straight week came up with huge plays when needed. The Monarchs recorded to sacks in the win over FAU, both for safeties. Marcus Haynes and Sokoya McDuffie notched the two-point plays for the defense.

It was ODU's first safety since 2016 against Southern Miss, and the first time ODU has registered two safeties in the same game.

### **Old Man Young Getting Close to Record**

Sixth-year senior linebacker Jordan Young had eight tackles in the win at Middle Tennessee. Young has continued his steady climb on the ODU career tackle charts, as he passed TJ Ricks to move into second at MTSU.

With the regular season finale against Charlotte remaining, several things are at stake besides the record for Young.

Young's single-season high for tackles was 86 in 2019. He needs six tackles to surpasses that.

Young has never led ODU in tackles. He's finished second twice and third as a sophomore in 2018. He currently has a 12 tackle lead on second place Ryan Henry.

#### Senior Sendoff

ODU will honor 12 seniors prior to Saturday's game. Below is a brief snap shot of each senior.

#### Jordan Young - LB - Coatesville, Pa.

Young has already graduated with his degree in sport management and will graduate with his master's degree in sport mangament this December. He leads ODU with 81 tackles this season and is 13 tackles shy of becoming ODU's all-time leading tackler.

### Stone Smartt - WR - Sacramento, Calif.

Smartt was ODU's quarterback for much of 2019 before moving to wide receiver during fall camp this season. He was coming into his own at WR before an injury knocked him out of action for several weeks. He has 12 receptions for 117 yards this season.

#### Will Brocchini - CB - Sacramento, Calif.

Brocchini has played in six games this season at corner, making eight tackles with two pass breakups. In 2019, he played in seven games, recording 23 tackles, an interception and a pass breakup.

### Nigel Fitzgerald - WR - Greensboro, N.C.

Fltzgerald battled injuries during his ODU career, including this season, playing just one game in 2021, making one catch. For his career, he caught 14 passes for 228 yards.

#### Harrell Blackmon - S - Jackson, Miss.

Blackmon has recorded 46 tackles in 11 games at safety this season and has 88 tackles in his two-year ODU career. He notched his first career interception in 2019 against WKU.

### Roger Cray - CB - Lake City, Fla.

A graduate transfer from WKU, Cray was the most experienced transfer ODU brought in, having played four years for the Hilltoppers. Cray's veteran leadership has been valuable for ODU. He has recorded 30 tackles, one interception and a team-high nine pass breakups. He has also returned 10 punts for 97 yards.

### Joe Joe Headen - S - Harrisburg, Pa.

One of three sixth year players for the Monarchs, Headen has already earned his degree in finance and is working towards his master's in public administration. He intercepted his first pass of the season in last week's week at MTSU, and the third of his career. His 21 pass breakups are the second most in ODU history.

### Cory Jackson - DE - Jackson, Miss.

Mostly a special teams player in 2019, Jackson has come on in 2021, making six starts at defensive end. He has 23 tackles, three sacks and a forced fumble.

### Estefano Feliciano - DE - Tampa, Fla.

Feliciano has played in 10 games in 2021 and has found his way in the defensive line rotation for the last half of the season. He has recorded five tackles and a QB hurry. In his ODU career, he has played in 19 games and made 12 tackles. He has also been an integral member of the kickoff return team.

### Carson Ramos - DT - Loma Rica, Calif.

Ramos will graduate with a degree in management this fall. He has played in three games making one tackle, while being a key contributor on the kickoff return team. He returned a kickoff 11 yards last week at Middle Tennessee.

### Isaac Weaver - OL - Marietta, Ga.

Weaver has started 46 career games on the offensive line, tied with Jordan Young for second most in school history. This year he has started games at left tackle, center and for the first time in his career, left guard. A three-time team captain, Weaver earned his biology degree and is working on his MBA.

### Nick Rice - K - St. Petersburg, Fla.

ODU's all-time leader in field goals with 63, Rice kicked the game-winning field goal in ODU's 23-20 win over Louisiana Tech. In the win at FIU, he drilled a career long 50-yarder in the win over the Panthers. He is only the second Monarchs to score more than 300 points (302), joining former kicker Jarod Brown (388).

# Monarchs Fall in Opener at Wake, 42-10

**WINSTON-SALEM, N.C.** – Old Dominion had not played a football game in 643 days and although the Monarchs at times showed flashes of potential, they also showed the effects of the long layoff.

Wake Forest took a big early lead in large part because of ODU mistakes and rolled past the Monarchs, 42-10 Friday night at Truist Field. It was ODU's first game since the Monarchs fell to Charlotte on Nov. 30, 2019. ODU did not play last season because of the pandemic.

The game marked the head coaching debut of Ricky Rahne, the former Penn State offensive coordinator, who inherited one of the nation's most inexperienced teams. Nearly half of ODU's roster is composed of newcomers and the inexperience showed with a number of unforced errors.

In spite of giving up 42 points, ODU's defense played well. Rahne said the offense often left the defense in poor position and the defense at times gave up big plays. ODU gave up 357 yards, but that was with a defensive line that started three freshmen.

"I thought we played well on defense," Rahne said. "The yards we gave up I thought were largely because of errors.

"We've just got to continue to hone in, make sure we're in the right spot. We have to work work on our tackling, which we will. We're going go come back better next week, there's no doubt in my mind."

Wake Forest took a 28-3 lead in a first half that was much closer statistically than the score would indicate. The Demon Deacons outgained the Monarchs, 193-130, but took advantage of numerous ODU mistakes, including two interceptions and poor tackling on a kickoff return, to take the 24-point lead.

ODU drove from its own 25 to the Wake Forest 46 on its second possession, but on fourth down and inches, the Wake Forest line stacked the middle and stopped Blake Watson just short of a first down.

Three plays later, Wake running back Christian Beal-Smith ripped off a 48-yard touchdown run around the left side of ODU's defense to put the Demon Deacons up, 7-0, six minutes into the game.

ODU's defense then stepped up, stopping Wake Forest on a fourthand-one at the ODU 42 when Tre Hawkins III blitzed and caught Justice Ellison for a 2-yard loss.

The Monarchs then drove to the Wake 21, with 31 yards coming on a burst of the middle from Elijah Davis, before being forced to kick a field goal. The Monarchs then scored their first points in 22 months on a 38-yard Nick Rice field goal to trim the Wake lead to 7-3 with 28 seconds left in the first quarter.

That was to be the high water mark for the Monarchs. Two big mistakes over the next three minutes allowed the Demon Deacons to build the lead to 21-3.

Ja'Sir Taylor returned the ensuing kickoff 99 yards for a touchdown in which ODU's return team missed tackles.

Then a Mack pass glanced off a receiver's hand into the hands of Wake's Traveon Webb at the ODU 47. Four plays later, Sam Hartman passed 36 yards to A.T. Perry for a touchdown and the Demon Deacons led, 21-3, with 12:01 left in the first half.

Wake made it 28-3 when Jaquiri Roberson, the standout wide receiver, made an off-balance, one-handed touchdown reception with 2:45 left.

Wake appeared ready score again when Taylor intercepted a Mack pass and returned it 47 yards to the ODU 7 with 1:09 left.

But ODU's defense stood firm. On fourth and goal at the half-yard line, when Wake's Beal-Smith tried to vault over the goal line, he was knocked backward by Monarch freshman Chazz Wallace.

Senior linebacker Jordan Young led ODU with nine tackles.

# Monarchs Defeat Hampton in Home Opener, 47-7

NORFOLK, Va. - Old Dominion's football team gave head coach Ricky Rahne a successful and satisfying home debut at Kornblau Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium, and ended the university's longest losing streak, in resounding fashion Saturday night.

Coming off a 42-10 defeat at Wake Forest in which the Monarchs were mistake prone, ODU was nearly flawless offensively, defensively and on special teams in a record-setting, 47-7 blowout victory over Hampton.

It was also ODU's first victory in more than two years. The Monarchs last won on August 31, 2019, when they rallied to defeat Norfolk State, 24-21, in the first game played on the then newly-renovated S.B. Ballard Stadium.

It was a record setting night for the Monarchs. ODU rushed for 358 yards, breaking the school record of 340 yards set in 2009, ODU's first season of football, in a 31-10 victory over Georgetown.

The Monarchs also gave up just 187 yards, the fewest in school history, breaking the previous record of 213 set in 2016 against Marshall.

Mack completed 11 of 22 passes for 162 yards and a touchdown and ran for 57 yards and three touchdowns before heading to the sidelines midway through the third quarter.

The first home game since Nov. 30, 2019, drew a crowd of 18,363, including more than 5,000 students, the larges turnout of students ever for an ODU home game.

The Monarchs (1-1) ended any suspense early on, rolling to 408 offensive yards and a 34-0 lead by halftime.

Elijah Davis rushed eight times for 109 yards in the first half before heading to the bench with an injury. He was replaced by Jon-Luke Peaker, a true freshman from Philadelphia, who rushed 18 times for 141 yards. Peaker was fourth on ODU's depth chart when the season began.

The Monarchs were red hot from the start, driving 91 yards on their first possession, with Mack hitting Penn State transfer Zack Kuntz on a picture perfect, 43-yard catch and throw on the fourth play of the drive.

Davis finished off the drive with a 15-yard TD run with 9:22 left. Five minutes later, Nick Rice made it 10-0 with a 24-yard field goal.

The Monarchs drove 91 yards on their next possession, with redshirt freshman Keshawn Wicks running for 29 yards and catching a 10-yard pass on consecutive plays. Mack made it 17-0 with a keeper just seconds into the second quarter.

Mack finished off an 11-play, 76-yard drive with a three-yard TD run with 3:15 left. ODU had a second and goal at the 2 with three seconds left and Rice came in to kick an 18-yard field goal.

After Mack made it 41-0 midway through the third quarter with a 4-yard touchdown run, Rahne began inserting substitutes. By then, ODU had 458 offensive yards and Hampton just 90.

ODU next plays at Liberty Saturday, Sept. 18, at 6 p.m.

The Flames are 2-0 after a 21-13 victory at Troy Saturday night.

# **Football Drops 45-17 Contest at Liberty**

LYNCHBURG, Va. – Old Dominion's football team could not contain Liberty University standout quarterback Malik Willis and fell to the Flames, 45-17, Saturday night at Williams Stadium

Liberty (3-0) is arguably the best team on ODU's schedule. The Flames have most players back from last season, when they finished 10-1 and won a bowl game, and are 28th in voting for the Associated Press Top 25. They are likely to enter the Top 25 this week.

Clearly, they have one of the best quarterbacks in the college game. Willis, considered a lock as a first-round NFL draft choice, beat the Monarchs with both his legs and his arm.

He completed 21 of 28 passes for 242 yards and four touchdowns and ran for 77 yards and two more TDs, with nearly all that yardage coming in the first three quarters.

ODU quarterback D.J. Mack Jr., who turned 23 Saturday, completed 15 of 27 passes for 134 yards and a touchdown. He threw an interception, but Rahne said it wasn't a bad throw.

But Mack was often rushed from the pocket and was sacked five times. He said Mack needed to get rid of the ball quicker on some of those sacks.

ODU kept it close for a while. The Monarchs rallied in the final minutes of the first half to drive 75 yards for a touchdown that narrowed what had been a 21-3 Liberty lead to 28-17.

But the Flames asserted themselves quickly in the second half, sacking Mack twice on ODU's first possession, then driving 48 yards for a touchdown.

Willis passed 13 yards to Kevin Shaa for the touchdown and Liberty led, 35-17. The Monarchs never threatened again.

For much of the first half the Flames threatened to blow the game open. The Flames led, 21-3, on two touchdown passes and a touchdown run by Willis, who had 140 offensive yards on the Flames' first four possessions, including a 56-yard jaunt after he was nearly sacked.

But the Monarchs (1-2) got a big break when the Flames were called for roughing punter Ethan Duane that handed the Monarchs a first down at the 42. Lynchburg native Elijah Davis, an all-state pick at nearby Heritage High School, finished off the drive with a run of 17 yards, then a 1-yard TD run and the Monarchs trailed. 21-10.

ODU's defense then held, and would have had good field position at its own 42. But the Monarchs were also called for roughing the kicker. Willis then threw a near-perfect 38-yard touchdown pass to Kevin Shaa, who was well covered by Tre Hawkins III, but nonetheless hauled in the pass, and the Flames led 28-10.

ODU wasn't finished, however. The Monarchs patiently and methodically mounted a 75-yard touchdown drive sparked by two key plays. On fourth down and two, Mack tossed a 4 yard pass to freshman Jordan Bly.

On the next play, Mack found tight end Zack Kuntz at the 11, who carried it into the end zone for a 30-yard touchdown. That narrowed the lead to 28-17, and kept the Monarchs within striking distance of the Flames, albeit only temporarily.

Asked if he saw things he liked about his team, Rahne mentioned the rally late in the first half.

"I thought we battled, especially at the end of the first half," he said. "But we've got to have passion regardless of what is going on."

Headen said the Monarchs did not have a good week of practice last week and that it showed in their performance Saturday.

"We knew this was going to be a tough battle and we that we couldn't afford self-inflicted wounds," Kuntz said. "And just had too many self-inflicted wounds."

Kuntz and Stone Smartt both had four pass receptions for ODU while Davis rushed for 57 yards.

ODU hosts Buffalo this Saturday at 6 p.m. at S.B. Ballard Stadium. The Bulls (1-2) fell at home to No. 16 Coastal Carolina, 28-25, on Saturday night. Their other loss was a 28-3 defeat at Nebraska.

# ODU Comeback Falls Just Short Against Buffalo, 35-34

NORFOLK, Va. - Old Dominion lost a football game in which the Monarchs outhit, outplayed and outgained their opponent, and then lost in perhaps the most heartbreaking fashion possible Saturday night.

Trailing 35-7 after a first half in which they had a field goal blocked and returned 90 yards for a touchdown, a fumble returned 67 yards for another TD, and dropped a potential touchdown pass, the Monarchs battled back into a game that appeared lost with an inspiring comeback.

ODU dominated the second half. ODU's defense limited the Bulls to 40 yards while the offense scored 27 points and rolled to 319 yards.

But the Monarchs could not get the final point they needed to send the game into overtime when placekicker Nick Rice missed the point after touchdown, allowing the Bulls to escape with a 35-34 victory.

ODU had 10 penalties, perhaps the most hurtful came after Zack Kuntz, the tight end transfer from Penn State, leaped and caught a 19-yard touchdown pass from D.J. Mack Jr. with 19 seconds left that left the Monarchs a PAT away from overtime.

However, ODU players ran off the bench to celebrate and referees called the Monarchs for an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty. That moved the ball back to the 18, meaning it was a 35-yard PAT, the kind of kick Rice usually makes, but not a chip shot.

Rice pushed it to the right of the upright by inches. Had he kicked from the three, it likely would have been good.

There indeed were so many other mistakes that cost the Monarchs dearly, including in the second half. There was a dropped touchdown pass and a fumble at the 1-yard-line while Isiah Paige was diving for an apparent touchdown with 8:32 left.

Mack played his best game of the season, completing 24 of 41 passes for 224 yards and a touchdown in spite of the fact that at least a half dozen of his passes were dropped.

The first second-half TD was set up by a fumble caused by freshman Jason Henderson and recovered by freshman Alonzo Ford Jr. Mack was rushed from the pocket on third down and 17, took off, juked past several defenders and ran 42 yards for a touchdown.

The Monarchs then held Buffalo on downs, and drove 85 yards for a touchdown on what may have been their best-looking drive of the season, with the key play a 29-yard pass reception by tight end Isaiah Spencer. Mack carried from two yards out and ODU trailed by 14.

After an exchange of punts, ODU drove 63 yards for a touchdown, with the big play a 31-yard burst from Blake Watson in which he ran over two defenders, and an additional 15 yard penalty as he was dragged to the ground by his facemask.

Jon-Luke Peaker, rushed around the left end for ODU's third unanswered touchdown with 8:36 left and the lead was down to seven.

ODU twice more drove deep into Buffalo territory, but came away with just six points.

That the Monarchs could not quite come all the way back left the team in tears in the locker room, but also with hope.

# Late Rally Falls Short at UTEP, 28-21

**EL PASO, Texas** – As it did a week ago against Buffalo, Old Dominion's football team staged a furious second-half comeback and then lost a heartbreaker.

Trailing UTEP, 17-0 with just 51 seconds left in the first half, the Monarchs stormed back to take a 21-20 lead late in the third quarter.

But then UTEP staged a comeback of its own, driving 63 yards in seven minutes in the fourth quarter to claim a 28-21 victory in the Conference USA opener for both teams.

UTEP took a 26-21 lead after Deion Hankins carried from the three for the touchdown. The Miners went for the 2-point conversion and quarterback Garvin Hardison, found Justin Garrett on a pass to make it 28-21 with 6:59 left.

ODU (1-4, 0-1 Conference USA) then drove to its own 43 and on third down, Dy'Vonne Inyang intercepted a D.J. Mack pass with 4:16 left.

ODU's defense, which generally played well, forced UTEP to punt and ODU had the ball at its 5-yard line 1:23 left and no timeouts.

The Monarchs then gave UTEP a major scare, driving to the UTEP 31, where they had a first down with 1:07 left.

But on fourth down, Mack's heaved a pass toward 6-foot-8 tight end Zack Zuntz in the right corner of the end zone, but overthrew him.

Mack completed 20 of 34 passes for 194 yards and a touchdown and ran for another. Kuntz, the transfer from Penn State, caught a career-high eight passes for 54 yards.

ODU's offense had generated just 81 offensive yards and trailed UTEP, 17-0 with 51 seconds left in the first half, when the Monarchs did what they did in the second half last weekend against Buffalo – their offense got their act together.

ODU trailed the Bulls, 35-7, last weekend at halftime and rallied for 27 points, one short of what they needed to win.

ODU drove 75 yards in five plays in just 40 seconds.

Mack keyed the drive with a 28-yard run, then with 15 seconds left and no timeouts, launched a pass to Ali Jennings III that he caught on the goal line and lunged across with 10 seconds left.

UTEP scored first in the second on a drive keyed by a 51-yard pass from quarterback Gavin Hardison to standout wide receiver Jacob Cowing. But the defense stood firm and forced the Miners to settle for a 40-yard field goal.

But ODU then took over. ODU then drove 75 yards on a drive in which the Monarchs gambled and went for it on fourth and one at their 33. Blake Watson carried for two yards to keep the drive alive. Mack threw 21 yards to Zack Zuntz to set up first and goal and then scored from the three and ODU trailed 20-14.

Then, after holding the Miners on downs, the Monarchs blocked their fourth punt of the season, this one by Isaiah Spencer and AC White scooped up the ball and returned it 11 yards for the touchdown.

Rice then kicked the point after to give ODU its first lead of the game, 21-20, with 4:27 left in the third quarter.

Added Rahne: "We've got to execute earlier, but we've got execute and believe right from the beginning."

Cory McCoy intercepted a pass for Marshall to set up the Herd at the ODU 20 midway through the first quarter. The ODU defense held firm again and held Marshall to a four play, -6 yard drive that resulted in a 42-yard Shane Ciucci field goal.

The Monarchs countered with a nine play, 81-yard drive capped by a 33-yard touchdown pass from D.J. Mack to Ali Jennings III to take a 7-3 lead to end the first quarter.

After another ODU defensive stop, the Monarchs drove 73 yards in 13 plays as Nick Rice drilled a 47-yard field goal to put ODU on top 10-3 with 6:38 remaining in the second quarter.

Marshall cut the ODU lead to 10-6 with another field goal by Ciucci, this one a 22-yarder to cap a 76-yard, 14 play drive.

Ryan Henry totaled a career-best 12 tackles, while Terry Jones notched a career-high nine stops.

ODU hosts WKU on Saturday, Oct. 16 at 3:30 p.m. for homecoming.

### WKU Starts Fast, Tops ODU, 43-20

**NORFOLK, Va** - In a decision he kept a secret until minutes before gametime, Old Dominion football Coach Ricky Rahne started redshirt freshman Hayden Wolff at quarterback on Saturday against WKU.

And while Wolff threw well, especially in the second half, the Monarchs buried themselves with a series of early mistakes and fell to Western Kentucky, 43-20, before a homecoming crowd of 16,418 at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

It was the fourth consecutive loss for the Monarchs (1-6, 0-3 Conference USA), who lost the previous three in heartbreaking fashion.

This game was still in doubt midway through the fourth quarter, as the Monarchs staged a late comeback that trimmed WKU's lead to 13. But ODU could not overcome its poor start.

Wolff had two interceptions – the second in the waning moments when a storm whipped around S.B. Ballard Stadium with wind and rain – but had the best passing performance for the Monarchs since 2019. He completed 26 of 41 passes for 327 yards – it was the first time ODU passed for more than 300 yards since 2019, when he passed for 321 yards at Middle Tennessee.

Bailey Zappe, one of the nation's most potent passers, completed 37 of 54 passes for 397 yards and five touchdowns for WKU.

ODU wide receiver Ali Jennings III, the transfer from West Virginia, also had his best game of the season, hauling in 13 passes for 172 yards.

With WKU leading, 7-0, when Zappe fired a pass into the end zone that appeared to be picked off by safety R'Tarriun Johnson, then fumbled into the hands of WKU's Dakota Thomas.

Johnson came up with two big plays in the second half that blunted two drives that appeared headed for touchdowns, and sparked ODU's rally.

With a first and goal at the ODU 1, WKU failed to score on two runs, so Zappe rolled to his right and fired a pass that Johnson picked off. On WKU's next series, the Hilltoppers had a first and goal at the 4 after a 64-yard punt return by DeAngelo Wilson, in which he tripped just before he got to the end zone.

Johnson had a pass breakup that helped force WKU to settle for a field goal.

"I thought that sequence of events that I was maybe the most proud of a football team than I've been associated with in a long time," Rahne said.

Good things did happen. ODU scored touchdowns on back-to-back drives that trimmed the WKU lead to 33-20.

Wolff completed five passes, including three to Jennings, on a eightplay, 79-yard touchdown drive capped off by a 24-yard Elijah Davis touchdown run on the first play of the fourth quarter.

After the defense held WKU on downs, the Monarchs then drove 78 yards in eight plays that Blake Watson finished off with a 7-yard run with 10:17 left that trimmed the lead to 33-20. But needing a defensive stop, ODU couldn't quite git it. WKU drove just long and deep enough to set up a 41-yard Brayden Narveson field goal with 5:41 left that made the score 36-20. ODU turned the ball over on downs on the ensuing drive that put the game out of reach.

# Rice's Game-Winner Lifts ODU Football Over Louisiana Tech, 23-20

**NORFOLK, Va.** – Nick Rice kicked a 46-yard field goal with no time left to give Old Dominion a 23-20 win over Louisiana Tech on Saturday evening in Norfolk.

The game-winning kick was the third field goal of the game for Rice, as he tied the score with a 29-yard field goal with 1:52 remaining in the fourth quarter.

On the ensuing drive, LA Tech drove to the ODU 45, but on 4th and 3 quarterback JD Head's deep pass down the sideline was incomplete giving the Monarchs the ball back with 28 seconds left.

On first down, Hayden Wolff hit Zack Kuntz for a 10-yard completion and Blake Watson ran for gains of five, three and eight to set Rice up for the game-winner at the 29-yard line.

Louisiana Tech (2-6, 1-3) took its first lead of the game with 12 minutes left in the fourth quarter on a seven-yard touchdown run from Marcus Williams.

ODU tied the score on Rice's field goal, which capped a 20-play, 58-yard drive that took over 10 minutes.

Rice got the scoring started with 3:56 left in the second quarter with a 36 yard field goal, but the bulldogs followed with a 32 yard touchdown pass from Austin Kendall to Isaiah Graham to take a 7-3 lead.

The lead was short-lived as LaMareon James returned the kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown to put ODU back on top 10-7.

Jacob Barnes added a field goal with three seconds left to end the half and tie the score at halftime.

# ODU Picks Up First Road Win at FIU, 47-24

MIAMI - Old Dominion's offense has struggled much of the season but got untracked early on, and ODU's defense played a typically strong game, as the Monarchs claimed their first winning streak since 2018.

The Monarchs burst for 24 first-quarter points and rolled to 565 offensive yards to power past Florida International, 47-24, Saturday night at FIU Stadium in Miami.

ODU (3-6, 2-3 C-USA) broke a five-game losing streak last week with a 23-20 victory over Louisiana Tech. The Monarchs last won two in a row when they beat VMI and North Texas in November of 2018.

Running backs Blake Watson and Elijah Davis both broke the 100-yard rushing mark and quarterback Hayden Wolff, a Venice, Florida native, completed 22 of 42 passes for 283 yards and two touchdowns.

Watson rushed a career-high 28 times for 158 yards and two touchdowns. It was Watson's fourth consecutive game with 100 yards or more. Davis, who has been slowed with injuries, rushed 10 times for 114 yards and a touchdown.

Tight end Zack Kuntz caught a career-high tying nine passes for 102 yards.

ODU's defense, the strongest in school history, sacked quarterback Max Bortenschlager five times and scored a touchdown on the first play of the fourth quarter to give the Monarchs some breathing room in what had been a two-score game.

ODU came into the game averaging 23 points per game but surpassed that number with 27 seconds left in the first quarter, when Watson capped a 49-yard drive with a 3-yard run to give the Monarchs a 24-7 lead.

ODU's defense came up big the rest of the game, holding FIU on downs after two turnovers, and coming up with a huge touchdown early in the fourth quarter.

Defensive end Deeve Harris, a redshirt freshman who transferred from Minnesota, intercepted a Bortchenslager pass on the first play of the fourth quarter. He then turned into a running back, twice breaking against the grain of Panthers to return the INT for a 33-yard touchdown.

ODU scored quickly on its first drive, with Wolff completing 3 of 4 passes for 58 yards on a 6-play drive. Wolff passed 20 yards to Kuntz to make it 7-0 four minutes into the first quarter.

Miami native Ryan Henry, a senior playing his first college football game in his hometown, forced a fumble on FIU's next possession. Rice, another Florida native, made it 10-0 when he kicked a career-long 50-yard field goal a minute later.

FIU trimmed the lead to 10-7 when Bortchenslager passed 43 yards for a touchdown with 8:22 left in the first quarter, in which an ODU defensive back fell down.

Davis then burst for a 61-yard TD to make it 17-7. ODU led 24-10 at the half.

The teams exchanged 63-yard TD passes in the third quarter. Wide receiver Darius Savedge, who had been sidelined with an injury, caught a Wolff pass for the ODU touchdown. Bortenschslager then passed 63 yards for Bryce Singleton to make it 30-17.

Harris then gave ODU breathing room with his interception.

# ODU Tops FAU, 30-16

**NORFOLK, Va.** – Old Dominion continued a dramatic turnaround in its football fortunes and won one of the most unusual games ever played, to extend its winning streak to three games.

ODU's defense scored two safeties, the most in a Conference USA game since 1996, and the offense exploded in the second half as the Monarchs claimed a 30-16 victory over Florida Atlantic Saturday night at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

In all, ODU scored two points on four different plays, an achievement that has rarely occurred elsewhere. There were also five fumbles, including two lost by ODU in the game's opening minutes.

After losing five of its first six games, ODU (4-6, 3-3 Conference USA) has beaten Louisiana Tech, FIU and now FAU (5-5, 3-3) in its last three outings. Once last in the C-USA East Division, the Monarchs have pulled into a four-way tie for third place with FAU, Charlotte and Middle Tennessee, all at 3-3 in league games.

Wolff completed 21-of-33 passes for 289 yards and a touchdown with no interceptions. He threaded the needle on several long passes, including a 48-yard pass to Ali Jennings and a 46-yard pass to tight end Donta Anthony.

Running back Blake Watson rushed 23 times for 163 yards and a touchdown as the Monarch offense rolled to 448 yards. It was Watson's fifth game in a row with more than 100 rushing yards.

ODU's defense held FAU to 308 yards, and that occurred in part because the offense was on the field much of the game. The offense had 75 plays to 55 for the D.

ODU scored two safeties in the first half, the first when Marcus Haynes tackled FAU quarterback N'Kosi Perry in the end zone that narrowed an Owls lead to 3-2 with 6:16 left in the first quarter.

The defense gave ODU a 4-3 lead with its second safety minutes later. With FAU facing a second down at its own 1, defensive tackle Sokoya McDuffie forced Perry to throw a hurried pass out of bounds. Perry was penalized for intentional grounding, and ODU was awarded a safety.

ODU scored twice more on two-pointers in the second half.

Freshman Jason Henderson blocked an extra point attempt, which was picked up by R'Tarriun Johnson and returned 80 yards for two points, and the Monarchs converted a two-point conversion on the final score. Wolff threw to Jennings at the four, and he tossed the ball to a streaking Blake Watson, who bulled his way into the end zone with 2:48 left to build the lead to 30-16.

ODU led at the half, 11-3, and drove deep into FAU territory on its first three drives of the second half and each time, settled for Nick Rice field goals of 30, 28 and 20 yards. Rice broke his own school record with his 18th field goal of the season.

FAU, meanwhile, got TDs from Brandon Robinson on a 59-yard pass reception and Johnny Ford on a 2-yard run.

Ford's run narrowed the lead to 20-16.

But then ODU's special teams came up big, as Henderson blocked the extra point which was returned by Johnson.

ODU then put it away on a drive keyed by Wolff's 37-yard pass to freshman Jordan Bly. Two plays later, Wolff found Isiah Paige, the freshman from Richmond's Varina High, with a 14-yard touchdown pass, the first TD of Paige's career.

### **ODU Defeats MTSU, 24-17**

**MURFREESBORO, Tenn.** – The Old Dominion football team, once written off by wide swaths of the media as a poor team headed toward a miserable season, is now one victory away from a potential bowl bid.

ODU exploded for 14 points in a three minute and 7 second stretch during the fourth quarter and defeated Middle Tennessee, 24-17, Saturday at Floyd Stadium.

Elijah Davis ran virtually untouched for a 45-yard touchdown with 12:06 left, and then Blake Watson ran for a four-year touchdown run three minutes and 7 seconds later.

Jaylin Lane hauled in a 26-yard touchdown pass with 4:06 left that pulled Middle Tennessee within seven. But ODU recovered an on-side kick, and the Monarch defense came up big with 2:23 left, when freshman linebacker Jason Henderson forced an MTSU fumble, which was recovered by defensive tackle Devin Brandt-Epps..

The victory was the fourth in a row for ODU (5-6, 4-3 Conference USA) and keeps the team's hopes of a bowl bid very much alive. ODU hosts Charlotte Saturday at 2 p.m. at S.B. Ballard Stadium in the annual Oyster Bowl in a game with a lot on the line.

Because ODU won and Charlotte (5-6, 3-4) lost at Marshall, the winner of the regular-season finale next weekend is bowl eligible while the loser is finished for the season. MTSU (5-6, 3-4) travels to Florida Atlantic this weekend, with the winner also likely to clinch one of Conference USA's seven bowl bids.

The victory also ended a vexing drought to Middle Tennessee, which had beaten ODU in all four previous games. All four were blowouts and in 2017, the Blue Raiders knocked ODU out of bowl contention.

Going 1-0 has been his weekly mantra and by that he means focusing only on the next game, indeed the next day of practice, and not looking ahead.

"That's how we've kept things together," said senior cornerback Joe Joe Headen, who had an interception, one of two takeaways by the Monarchs. "Honestly, we did a great job of ignoring the noise and staying within ourselves," he said. "We always trusted each other. We believed in each other.

ODU dodged a bullet at the beginning of the fourth quarter, when Middle Tennessee lined up for what would have been a 24-yard field goal attempt that never happened.

A poor snap was bobbled by the holder, who was smothered by ODU's R'Tarriun Johnson. That left the score tied at 10-10.

ODU then began what would be a critical drive at its 18, with Hayden Wolff completing three passes, including two to Isiah Paige. Facing third and 3 at the 45, Davis burst up the middle and ran untouched for the touchdown.

ODU's defense then forced a three and out and the Monarchs quickly scored again.

Wolff tossed a short pass to Ali Jennings, the transfer from West Virginia, who sprinted 60 yards to the MTSU 6. Two plays later, Wolff threw a pass to Blake Watson, and he rumbled into the end zone

Nick Rice's kick gave ODU a 24-10 lead with 9:59 left.
