VCU TALKING POINTS

- VCU rebounded from a two-game losing ski with a 61-55 comeback win against Buffalo on Thursday
Taya Robinson scored 20 points as VCU used a 13-2 run to end the game and retake the lead for good
Sarah Te-Biasu, the true freshman point guard, has started every game for VCU and earned A-10 Rookie of the Week honors earlier this week after scoring 12.7 ppg, 4.7 rpg and 3.3 apg in the GSE Tipoff
VCU begins the season playing away from home for nine of its first 10 games with Thursday's game against Buffalo the lone home contest until Jan. 13 against George Mason
VCU entered the season as the preseason favorite in the Atlantic 10 for the second consecutive year
Overall, the Rams returned five of the top six scorers from last season led by Tera Reed and Taya Robinson who have first first and second in scoring for VCU each of the three seasons they have been on campus
This season, five Rams are averaging double figures so far led by Reed (22.0 ppg), Madison Hattix-Covington (13.0 ppg), Robinson (12.8 ppg), Janika Griffith-Wallace (12.5 ppg) and Te-Biasu (12.0 ppg)
VCU has a ton of starting experience on this roster with five players who have started at least 39 games during their career. In addition, eight Rams have each played in at least 58 games during their career
Reed, who averaged a career-high 15.2 ppg last season, is a two-time All-Atlantic 10 First Team selection. After a hand injury prior to last season, she came on strong later in the year and averaged 16.9 ppg against A-10 foes
Taya Robinson was named to the All-Atlantic 10 Third Team and All-Defensive Team for the second straight season. She finished second on the team in scoring (11.5 ppg) last season and ranked second the A-10 in 3-point FG percentage at 44.6 percent during the regular season
Madison Hattix-Covington was named the Atlantic 10 Sixth Woman of the Year after averaging 8.1 ppg and shooting 38.3 percent from 3-point range during the regular season
VCU ranked 18th nationally in blocked shots per game a year ago at 5.1 and 15th in total blocks (164). Both of those marks were first in the A-10. VCU currently ranks 4th nationally in total blocks (17)
VCU was 26th nationally in scoring defense (56.7 ppg) and 35th in FG percentage defense (36.4 percent) last season
VCU reached its second straight A-10 Championship game last year, the first back-to-back appearances in program history
The Rams are 26-6 the past two seasons during A-10 play, the best mark in the A-10
The Rams went 16-5 last season when allowing 59 or less and were 8-0 when allowing less than 50 points. In 2018-19, the Rams were 22-4 in games where opponents scored 59 or fewer points last season.
The Rams led the A-10 in both in free throws made and attempts a season ago
Gone from last year's team is Danielle Hammond, the A-10 Defensive Player of the Year. She averaged 2.72 blocks per game and ranked 16th nationally in that category. She set a VCU single-season record for blocks and broke VCU's all-time career blocks record. Hammond also led the A-10 in field goal percentage at 63.1
Also departed due to graduation was three-year starting point guard Nyra Williams who finished her career 8th all-time at VCU in assists and started 90 games

OLD DOMINION QUICK HITS

- VCU beat ODU in the meeting last season in Richmond, 62-49. The visiting team in the series hasn't won on the road since the 2011-12 season when VCU won in Norfolk
The Rams and Monarchs were longtime CAA rivals until VCU left the CAA for the A-10 and the Monarchs left to C-USA
ODU is coming off a 70-47 win against William & Mary after falling to A-10 member George Washington 55-37 in the season opener
ODU was picked to finish third in C-USA after going 24-6 last year
Amari Young and Ajah Wayne are the leaders for ODU, both being named C-USA Preseason All-Conference



## // KEY STORYLINES //

### RUNNING IT BACK

VCU returns five of its top six scorers from a season ago. It marks the third straight season that VCU has returned its top two scorers.

VCU also returns three student-athletes who were named to All-Atlantic 10 Teams a year ago. First Team selection Tera Reed, Third Team choice and All-Defensive Taya Robinson and A-10 Sixth Woman of the year in Madison Hattix-Covington.

### EXPERIENCE MATTERS

VCU has a ton of starting experience on this roster with five players who have started at least 39 games during their career. In addition, eight players overall for VCU have played in at least 58 Division I games during their career.

Sydnei Archie has started 77 of 94 career games  
Taya Robinson has started 83 of 87 career games  
Tera Reed has started 84 of 88 career games  
Sofya Pashigoreva has started 45 of 70 career games  
Janika Griffith-Wallace started 39 of 58 games\*  
\*all starts occurred at Murray State

### ALL IN THE FAMILY

VCU has two players on the roster from the Richmond area and both were coached by former VCU Men's Basketball standouts. Taya Robinson is a Huguenot High School graduate while Sydnei Archie went to St. Catherine's High School.

Robinson was coached by Bo Jones who played from 1998-2001 and averaged 15.2 ppg as a Ram. Jones also played alongside Alex Shtam, the son of current VCU Women's Basketball Director of Player Development Vladimir Shtam.

Archie's high school basketball coach, Ed Sherod, starred at VCU and is a member of the school's Hall of Fame. Sherod was also the VCU women's basketball head coach from 1988-1990 and went 26-30 (.464) overall.

Archie and Robinson have each started more than 77 games during their careers entering their senior season.

Last season, Robinson ranked second on the team in scoring overall at 11.5 points per game. Robinson was named to the A-10 Third Team and All-Defensive Team for the second straight year.

### STOLEN GOODS

VCU after three games is ranked third in the nation in steals with 43. The Rams led the A-10 in turnovers forced last season with 17.00 per game.

### TERA-FFIC

Tera Reed led the team in scoring for the third consecutive season and averaged a career-high 15.2 ppg last year. She was named to the All-Atlantic 10 First Team for the second consecutive season after being named to the All-Atlantic 10 Preseason First Team. She was an All-Rookie Team selection as a freshman. She's the first VCU player to achieve the feat since Courtney Hurt in 2011 and 2012.

Reed, in 2016-17, became the first freshman to lead the program in scoring since Quanitra Hollingsworth in 2005-06. She was also the first VCU player to be named to the A-10 All-Rookie team since Keira Robinson earned the honor in 2013-14.

Reed's mother, Justine, is a New Zealand native and played Division I basketball at the University of San Diego. Her father's family is from New Orleans, La. and was in the U.S. Navy when he met her mother in San Diego after a game. Tera is a dual citizen but grew up in New Zealand until coming to the U.S. in high school at Life Center Academy.

Reed's mother is currently the New Zealand Women's Basketball FIBA 3v3 head coach.

### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

VCU has posted top 35 defenses nationally each of the last two seasons.

Last season, VCU currently ranks 27th nationally in scoring defense at 56.9 ppg and 39th in field goal percentage defense at 36.75 percent. As a team, VCU ranks 18th nationally in blocked shots per game at with 5.1.

In 2018-19, the Rams ranked in the top five nationally in scoring defense, field goal percentage defense and 3-point defense.

VCU returns back-to-back All-Atlantic 10 Defensive Team member Taya Robinson. Robinson is often tasked with guarding the opposition's best guard.

### SYD THE KID

Sydnei Archie's father, Torrance, played at VCU and was the team's second-leading scorer in 1996-97 and 1997-98. She wears his same number (22).

Archie's mother also attended VCU and was a manager for the men's basketball team. Archie has started 69 of 85 career and finished second on the team in rebounding last year with 5.3 rpg. She has overcome two knee injuries that she suffered in high school including a torn ACL.

### QUEENS OF THE A-10

VCU has an extremely impressive record of 26-6 during regular season A-10 games dating back to 2018-19. That is the best mark in the league, just ahead of Dayton who is 25-7.

VCU went 13-3 in conference play last season after also going 13-3 during 2018-19 season.

Against A-10 opponents the past two seasons, including tournaments, VCU is an A-10 best 30-7.

### BLOCK PARTY

VCU through three games is ranked 11th nationally in total blocks (18) after ranking 18th nationally in blocks per game (5.1) last season and 15th in total amount of blocked shots (164).

Now graduated Ram Danielle Hammond was a big reason for that as she set the school record for total blocks at VCU with 182 and is third all-time at VCU in blocks per game at 1.7. Hammond ranked 16th nationally in blocks per game with 2.67 and 9th nationally in total blocks with 87.

Junior guard/forward Kseniya Malashka currently ranks seventh all-time at VCU in blocks per game over a career at 1.0. She has 62 career blocks including a career-high of seven at Arizona State (11/27/20) this season.

### GOING GLOBAL

VCU features nine total student-athletes from Australia, Belarus, Canada, Lithuania, New Zealand and Russia. Four of the six international players have experience with their national team systems, whether at the youth or senior levels.

## // KEY STORYLINES //

### GUNNING FOR THREE

Senior guard Taya Robinson finished second in the A-10 in 3-point field goal percentage a season ago after the regular season.

For the entire season, Robinson shot 42.6 percent from deep.

Teammate and redshirt sophomore guard Madison Hattix-Covington is also a shooter as she shot at a clip of 37.9 percent from deep. She shot 25-66 from 3-point range a season ago.

### MAKE IT A DOUBLE

Sydnei Archie and Taya Robinson have both recorded double-doubles during their career.

Taya Robinson had one at Richmond last season (17 points, 10 rebounds) as well as one her freshman year (11 pts, 10 reb) at Richmond.

Archie recorded the second double-double of her career last season against St. Bonaventure (10 points, 10 rebounds) after having one as a sophomore at N.C. A&T (10 pts, 10 reb).

### 59 IS MORE THAN FINE

VCU had a record of 16-5 when holding opponents to 59 points or less last season. That mark is a remarkable 39-10 since 2018-19 out of the overall 69 games played during that span. The Rams are 1-1 in those games this season.

The Rams have held opponents to 59 points or less in 49 of their last 70 games. This means 70 percent of VCU's opponents the last two seasons have scored 59 or less points. VCU went 22-4 in 2018-19 when holding opponents to 59 points or less.

### COACH'S KIDS

VCU has two players who are the daughters of women's basketball coaches.

Tera Reed's mother Justine recently was appointed as the head coach of the New Zealand 3x3 Women's Team. Justine also coaches regularly for the Harbour Basketball Association. Justine also coached the Under 18 3x3 team to the silver medal at the FIBA Women's U18 3x3 World Cup last year.

Kseniya Malashka's mother also has coaching experience including men's teams in Russia. Kseniya grew up going to her mother's practices.

### "ARMY BRAT"

Madison Hattix-Covington, the A-10 Sixth Woman of the Year, comes from a military family as both of her parents served over 20 years in the Army.

Hattix-Covington's parents are both retired and travel to almost every single one of VCU's games, usually in their RV.

Hattix-Covington redshirted her freshman season after suffering an ankle injury in the preseason.

After playing a reserve role as a redshirt freshman, Hattix-Covington elevated her game on her way to being named the A-10 Sixth Woman of the Year last season.

### IN IT TO WIN IT

VCU head coach Beth O'Boyle is second all-time in win's at VCU with 108 and won her 200th overall career game against Saint Mary's in the season opener on Nov. 25. She has a history of turning programs into winners and twice during her career has posted program turnarounds that were in the top 10 nationally, including one at VCU. She has qualified the Rams for the postseason each of the last two seasons\* and three of the last five.

O'Boyle is in her seventh season with VCU after serving as the head coach at Stony Brook most recently. She has been a head coach for 12 seasons across Montclair State, Stony Brook and VCU.

### FROM RUSSIA WITH LOVE

VCU has two players who call Russia home in seniors Sofya Pashigoreva and Olga Petrova.

Pashigoreva has started 45 games during her career out of 70 total games while Petrova led the team in 3-point percentage as a sophomore, shooting 40.3 percent and has played in 64 career games.

Both players joined the Rams in January of 2018 and played major minutes during Atlantic 10 play. Pashigoreva suffered a hand injury and was limited to nine games in 2017-18 while Petrova played in 16 games. Both players have been limited by injuries this season.

Both Pashigoreva and Petrova have appeared for Russia's youth national teams on various levels.

VCU Director of Player Development Vladimir Shtam is a former professional women's basketball coach in Russia for Dynamo Moscow. Shtam, who's son played at VCU, has been at VCU for four seasons.

### THREE'S COMPANY

VCU signed three student-athletes to their National Letters of Intent during the early signing period for the 2021 recruiting class.

#### Grace Hutson

A guard from Christiansburg, Virginia, attends St. Josephs Central Catholic High School and plays AAU for the West Virginia Thunder. She was named the West Virginia Gatorade Player of the Year during the 2019-20 season after she averaged 19.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.6 steals and 1.9 assists last season.

She led her team to a 22-1 record and a No. 24 national ranking before the remainder of their season was cancelled. Hutson is ranked the No. 43 guard nationally by ESPN and is listed as a 3-star recruit.

#### Adebukola Akomolafe

Attends Americas High School in El Paso, Texas and plays AAU for Team Fusion, averaged 13.9 points and 10 rebounds per game as a sophomore and 5.9 points and 7.6 rebounds per game as a freshman. Akomolafe suffered a knee injury that forced her to miss her junior season.

#### Skye Robinson

A local product from Ruther Glen, Virginia plays at TLPS Christian Academy and AUU for Team Loaded. She averaged 12.2 points and 11.7 rebounds per game as a junior last season at TLPS Christian Academy.

# 2019-20 ATLANTIC 10 POSTSEASON AWARDS

---

**NEWPORT NEWS, Va.** – VCU Women’s Basketball had four student-athletes earn Atlantic 10 honors highlighted by Danielle Hammond being named the Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Year and Tera Reed earning All-Atlantic 10 First Team honors. The awards were announced by the conference office on Thursday.

Hammond was named the Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Year as well as All-Atlantic 10 Second Team and All-Defensive Team. Reed, a junior guard, was named to the All-Atlantic 10 First Team for the second consecutive season. Taya Robinson earned All-Atlantic 10 Third Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second year in a row while Madison Hattix-Covington was named the Atlantic 10 Sixth Woman of the Year.

Hammond, a senior center, played in 29 games with career-high 20 starts. She set a VCU single-season record for blocked shots with 76 while averaging 11.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. Hammond averaged 2.6 blocks per game were 19th nationally and her 76 total blocks ranked 15th nationally.

Hammond became the first VCU player to be named Defensive Player of the Year since Kita Waller received the honor from the Colonial Athletic Association in 2010. On the offensive end, her field goal shooting percentage of 63.7 lead the A-10 for the second straight season.

Junior guard Tera Reed was tabbed First Team All-Atlantic 10 for the second straight year, making her the first Ram to earn the honor in back-to-back seasons since Courtney Hurt in 2011 and 2012. Despite missing games due to injuries, Reed averaged a career-high 15.8 points, 3.9 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals per game across 24 games. She was tied for fourth in the A-10 in scoring average during the regular season, fifth in free throw percentage at 81.3 percent and was 14th in field goal percentage at 44.0 percent.

Junior guard Taya Robinson earned a spot on the All-Atlantic 10 Third Team and the A-10 All-Defensive Team for the second year in a row. Robinson made 24 starts in 25 games and averaged 10.9 points per game while shooting 44.6 percent from 3-point range, the second-best mark in the A-10. She made at least one 3-pointer in the final 13 games of the regular season while scoring in double figures in 12 of VCU’s last 13 games. Robinson also added 4.2 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.1 steals per game.

Hattix-Covington, a redshirt sophomore guard, gave the Rams a huge lift off the bench this season as she averaged a career-best 8.1 points, 3.4 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game while knocking down 38.3-percent of her 3-point attempts. She ranked second on the team in both 3-pointers made and in 3-point percentage. Hattix-Covington played in all 29 games for VCU.

# BETH O'BOYLE

**HEAD COACH**  
**SEVENTH SEASON AT VCU**  
**GETTYSBURG ('98)**  
**108-85 AT VCU, 7TH SEASON**  
**201-168 OVERALL, 13TH SEASON**

Beth O'Boyle became the 13th head coach in VCU Women's Basketball history on April 29, 2014. She enters her seventh season at VCU and 13th overall as a head coach.

The Rams posted a second consecutive 20-win season in 2019-20 going 20-12 overall and 13-3 in A-10 play, reaching the Atlantic 10 Championship game for the second consecutive season. VCU had secured the league's automatic berth to the WNIT before the season was canceled due to COVID-19.

VCU went 24-10 in 2018-19 en route to the program's first conference championship after posting a 13-3 mark in A-10 play. O'Boyle was named the Atlantic 10 Coach of Year for her efforts and also led the Rams to be tied for the 12th-best turnaround in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball history.

In 2015-16, O'Boyle led the Rams to a 23-10 overall record with a 10-6 mark in conference play. VCU defeated a ranked Arizona State squad and earned six victories over NCAA Tournament teams. The Rams were rewarded with a WNIT bid, the program's seventh postseason berth since the 2007-08 season.

In her first season at the helm of the Rams in 2014-15, she led the team to 16 wins, marking the eighth time in the past nine seasons that VCU has posted a winning record.

O'Boyle assumed the reigns at VCU after she led Stony Brook to a remarkable turnaround in three seasons on Long Island. The Seawolves improved by 10 wins in each of the last two seasons, including the 2013-14 campaign, when O'Boyle guided the club to a school Division I record 24 wins (24-9), and a WNIT bid, the program's first postseason appearance since 2006. Stony Brook reached the America East Championship Game last season, the school's first appearance in the final since 2001-02. O'Boyle was also pivotal in the development of 2014 America East Defensive Player of the Year Chikilra Goodman.

In 2012-13, Stony Brook's 10-win turnaround was the seventh-best in the country. O'Boyle was 42-51 overall in three seasons with the Seawolves. During O'Boyle's tenure, Stony Brook was known for its stout defense. In each of her three seasons, the Seawolves ranked in the top 50 nationally in scoring defense. In 2013-14, SBU allowed just 60.5 points per game, the 45th-best mark in the country. The Seawolves also ranked 20th nationally in rebounding margin (+7.7).

Prior to guiding the Stony Brook program, O'Boyle spent four seasons as an assistant at Canisius. She helped steer the program to its best season in 2008-09, when the Golden Griffins won 24 games and advanced to the MAAC Championship Game. Canisius also received a WNIT bid for the first time in program history.

Hired as an assistant coach at Canisius in 2007, O'Boyle was elevated to associate head coach in November 2009. Responsible for all recruiting activities, as well the development of the Golden Griffin guards, O'Boyle coached seven All-Conference players at Canisius, including 2009 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) Defensive Player of the Year Brittané Russell, 2009 MAAC Sixth Player of the Year Ellie Radke and 2011 MAAC Rookie of the Year Jamie Ruttie.

O'Boyle has also shown a commitment to developing the total student-athlete. Dani Klupenger earned America East All-Academic status in 2012-13 for her work on the court and in the classroom. At Canisius, she monitored the academic progress of a Golden Griffins team that was recognized in the NCAA Top 25 for team grade point average. In total, Canisius has had 18 selections to the MAAC All-Academic team since O'Boyle's arrival, including Marie Warner, who was also named a ESPN the Magazine third-team Academic All-American in 2009.

O'Boyle came to Canisius after serving as the head coach at Montclair State University in Montclair, N.J., for three seasons. O'Boyle led the Red Hawks to the ECAC Division III Metro Women's Basketball Championship in 2006-07 and was named the New Jersey Athletic Conference Co-Coach of the Year following the 2005-06 season. She compiled a 51-33 record in her three seasons there, and the Red Hawks also produced their first All-American in 15 seasons under O'Boyle's guidance.

Prior to taking over at Montclair State, O'Boyle spent four seasons as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Rochester. During her first two seasons, Rochester won back-to-back ECAC Upstate New York championships and in her last two seasons, the team made consecutive appearances in the NCAA Division III Final Four. In 2004, the team was ranked No. 1 in the nation for a three-week period according to the USA Today/ESPN/WBCADivision III poll and the D3hoops.com poll.

A 1998 graduate of Gettysburg College, O'Boyle earned four letters with the basketball and soccer programs at Gettysburg and served as a two-time captain in each sport. O'Boyle earned her master's degree from the Rochester's Warner School of Education in 2001. O'Boyle is a native of Rockville, Md., and attended the Academy of the Holy Cross High School in Kensington, Md.

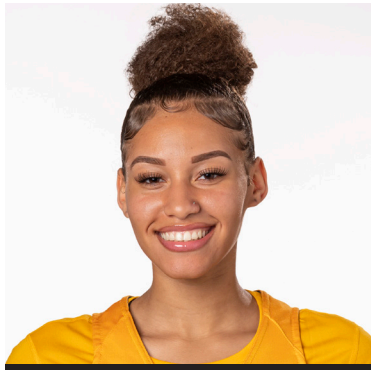
