- The No. 6 Lady Vols are 7-3 and coming off a 97-80 loss at No. 4 Stanford on Dec. 20
- Senior Shekinna Stricklen leads the team with 17.3 points per game and is second on the team with 7.4 rebounds per game.
- Tennessee has three other players averaging in double-figures; Glory Johnson at 13.7, Taber Spani at 11.9 and Meighan Simmons at 10.4.
- Johnson leads the team with 8.3 boards per game and is tied for the team lead with nine blocks.
- Freshman Ariel Massengale has played in just seven of 10 games but leads the team with 36 assists.

Game Day Notes

Three in a Row

Senior Tia Lewis continued her impressive play with her third-straight 20-point performance in the 71-58 win over North Carolina A&T. The senior had 24 points and 13 rebounds to produce her fourth double-double of the year.

20 Again for Lewis

Tia Lewis scored 20-points for the fourth time this year and the second-straight game with 27 points in the win over Wofford. She tied her career high she set in the win over Alabama earlier this year.

Buchan's Back

Mairi Buchan had her best game of the year to date against Wofford with a season-high 13 points and tied her career best with nine rebounds.

Cook Career-High

Junior guard Jackie Cook registered a career-high 17 points in the CAA opener Sunday at George Mason. She had 13 of the 17 by halftime, finishing 4-of-7 from the floor and 8-of-10 from the foul line. Her previous career-high was 17 points last season at Hofstra.

Lewis Heating Up

Senior Tia Lewis has been a standout performer for the Lady Monarchs, producing her seventh-straight double-figure scoring effort (at the time) with 20 points at George Mason on Sunday. It was her third 20-point outing of the year and she just missed her fourth double-double with nine boards.

CAA Openers

The loss to George Mason was the first ever to open CAA play. ODU drops to 20-1 all-time in openers. ODU is now 48-2 all-time against George Mason.

Double-Double for Two

Tia Lewis and JoNiquia Guilford became the first ODU teammates to record a double-double in the same game in the loss at GW since Lewis (14 pts., 11 reb. and Jessica Canady (15 pts., 14 reb.) did it on Jan. 21, 2010 against Georgia State.

Lewis Gets Third-Straight

Tia Lewis recorded her third-straight double-double with 19 points and 14 rebounds in the overtime loss at George Washington. She was 7-of-18 from the floor and 5-of-5 from the foul line.

Guilford Gets First

JoNiquia Guilford recorded her first career double-double in the 58-52 OT loss at George Washington, with 12 points and 14 rebounds. She came off the bench and shot 5-of-11 from the floor including knocking down a three-pointer. The 14 boards are a career best.

With four double-doubles this season and 33 for her career, Tia Lewis is eighth on the NCAA Division I active list for career double-doubles.

Tia Leaders ranks among the top-10 in the CAA in five categories; scoring (4th at 18.7), rebounding

(5th at 9.5,) offensive rebounds (6th at 3.7), defensive rebounds (5th at 5.7) and minutes played (2nd at 35.3). Ashley Betz-White is fifth in free-throw pct. at 81.3.

Double-Double

Senior forward Tia Lewis recorded her second double of the season against Seton Hall with 11 points and 16 rebounds in the U.S. Virgin Islands at the Paradise Jam Tournament. Lewis averaged 20.7 points and 10.7 rebounds a game at the Paradise Jam Tournament, earning all-tournament team honors.

Back to 20

Senior Tia Lewis had her second-straight 20 point effort with 24 points against Louisiana Tech at the Paradise Jam Tournament. She also registered her first double-double of the season.

Career-High (Part One)

Sophomore Shakeva Richards poured in a career-best 18 points against La. Tech. The sophomore went 4-for-5 from the foul line and pulled down five rebounds.

Career-High (Part Two)

She's only played in 10 games, but Myeisha Hall had her most impressive game of the season in just 12 minutes against Louisiana Tech. Hall went 5-of-8 from the floor, scoring 14 points and making her first two career three-pointers.

Senior Tia Lewis scored a career-high 27 points in the 77-76 win over Ala-

bama. Lewis made a career-best 12 field goals as well and went 3-of-6 from the line.

At the Buzzer

Sophomore Becca Allison knocked in the game-winner with just 1.2 seconds left in ODU's 77-76 win over Alabama. Allison wasn't the most likely last second shooter, going just 2-of-6 on the day with five points, but she was the right shooter as she drained the jumper.

Back at It

Freshman Ashley Betz-White finished with 20 points and went 10-of-12 from the foul line in the win over Alabama. It is the third time this season she has had at least 18 points in a game.

Lady Monarchs Picked Fifth

Old Dominion was picked to finish fifth this season in the CAA preseason poll. The voting was done by the league's head coaches. Delaware was picked to win the CAA, with VCU, James Madison and Hofstra rounding out the top four. ODU was tied for fifth

with Drexel, followed by UNCW, George Mason, William and Mary, Georgia State, Towson and Northeastern.

Senior Tia Lewis was the lone Lady Monarch selected to the preseason All-Conference team. Lewis is ODU's only returning starter, and led last year's squad with 12.1 points per game and 7.8 boards a game.

Buchan is Back

Junior Mairi Buchan is back after redshirting last season due to an injury. The Scotland native will add another post presence to go along with Tia Lewis.

As a sophomore, Buchan averaged 4.8 points per game averaging 15 minutes a game coming off the bench.

Barefoot Brings in Five

Head coach Karen Barefoot brought in five student-athletes in her first recruiting class. They are Michelle Brandao, Ashley Betz-White, Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor and Queen Tiye Jackson.
