### THE SHOOTAROUND

- It will be the third meeting between ETSU and Old Dominion
- The all-time series between the two programs is all tied at 1-1 with ODU winning in 2004 and ETSU winning in 2015
- Last season, ETSU defeated Old Dominion, 56-52 in Norfolk, Va.
- In ETSU's last contest, the Bucs defeated Coppin State, 70-58 on Dec.20 at the Miami Holiday Tournament
- Against Coppin State, ETSU has three players score in double figures for the second time this season
- At the Miami Holiday Tournament, ETSU finished third going 1-1, falling to Maine in their first contest
- Junior Tianna Tarter was named to the Miami Holiday All-Tournament Team averaging 17.5 points per game
- Tarter has recorded nine straight games scoring in double figures
- Senior Shamauria Bridges vs. Coppin State became ETSU's all-time career leader in three's made
- Bridges now ranks first at ETSU in three-pointers attempted and three-pointers made
- Tianna Tarter ranks first in the NCAA in minutes played with 499 minutes
- Tarter ranks 6th in the NCAA in total points (283) and 19th in the NCAA in points per game (20.2)
- ETSU as a team ranks second in the SoCon in scoring offense, recording 65.7 points per game
- ETSU ranks 5th in the NCAA in total free-throw attempts at 296
- Sophomore Carley Lytton has recorded back-to-back double digit performances scoring 12 vs. Maine and 10 vs. Coppin State
- The Bucs are 3-4 in Johnson City inside Brooks Gym this season
- ETSU is outscoring it's opponents, 266-238 in the fourth quarter this season
- ETSU has three of their next four contests on the road

### THE TIP-OFF

Coming off the holiday break ETSU has an overall record of 7-7 after splitting two games at the Miami Holiday Tournament. In their first contest in the sunshine state, the Bucs fell to mid-major power Maine, 61-48. The blue and gold rebounded the next day defeating Coppin State, 70-58 behind three Bucs scoring in double figures. ETSU concludes non-conference play versus Old Dominion.

### SCOUTING THE BUCCANEERS

Despite the record the Bucs are one of the most potent offensive teams in the SoCon ranking second with 65.7 points per game. A large reason for that is the play of junior Tianna Tarter who ranks first in the conference with 20.2 points per game. ETSU also ranks as one of the best from the three-point line making a league-leading 86 three's.

### SERIES HISTORY VS. OLD DOMINION

It will be just the third meeting all-time between the Bucs and the Lady Monarchs. The series is tied at 1-1 with ODU winning back in 2004 and the Bucs winning a season ago. Last year, ETSU used a 14-2 fourth quarter run to win on the road at Old Dominion, 56-52.

### LAST TIME OUT FOR ETSU

In their last contest, ETSU saw three players score in double figures for the second time this season as the Bucs ran away with a 70-58 victory over Coppin State.

### BRIDGES MAKES HISTORY IN MIAMI

In her home state of Florida, senior Shamauria Bridges with just nine seconds into the second quarter knocked down a three from the right wing to become ETSU's all-time career leader in three-pointer's made. Bridges has now recorded 242 career three's, passing Michele Devault for the most all-time. Bridges owns the career record for both made three-pointer's and three-pointer's attempted.

### TARTER NAMED MIAMI HOLIDAY ALL-TOURNEY TEAM

After averaging 17.5 points, 5 rebounds and 5 assists in two games, junior Tianna Tarter was named to the Miami Holiday All-Tournament team.

### STREAKING

The Bucs have a multiple statistical streaks that are in progress:

- Tarter has 9 straight double digit point games
- Carley Lytton has recorded double digits in 2 straight

### A TRIPLE THREAT

In their last game vs. Coppin State, the Bucs got production from three different scorers as for the second time this season ETSU had three players in double figures. Tarter led the way with 23 points followed by Bridges with 21 and Lytton with 10.

### A "SCHURR" THING

Against Coppin State junior Mallorree Schurr dominated the board coming away with a career-high 11 rebounds. It was the fourth time this season Schurr has led the Bucs in rebounding.

### TARTER JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

With 2:23 left in the third quarter vs. Elon, junior Tianna Tarter hit nothing but net on a free-throw to become the 23rd member of ETSU's 1,000-point club. Tarter scored her 1,000 point in her 66th career game as ETSU has now had consecutive years in which a Junior has reached 1,000 points as Shamauria Bridges did so a year ago.

### ROAD WARRIORS

Three of the next four games for the Bucs will be on the road. After Christmas ETSU will have one home game vs. Old Dominion before beginning SoCon play with three straight road contests at Samford, Mercer and at Chattanooga.

### CONSISTENT NON-CONFERENCE

Since 2013, the Bucs are 27-28 in non-conference play having won at least 7 games during the non-conference schedule the past three years.

### HOME SWEET HOME

Since 2014, the Bucs have been dominant inside Brooks, compiling an overall record of 24-10. For the first time since 2009, 2010, the Bucs have recorded back-to-back 10+ win seasons at home as ETSU went 10-3 last season in Johnson City.

### FOURTH QUARTER SWITCH

ETSU has outscored its opponents, 266-238 this season in the fourth quarter.

**3's COME AT A PREMIUM**

The Buccaneer defense has been stifling from behind the three-point line this season as ETSU has held it's opponents to a .272 shooting percentage from beyond the three-point line. The .272 opponent shooting percentage from three ranks second in the SoCon.

**BRIDGES RANKS IN THE NCAA**

With 242 career three-pointers this season, Shamauria Bridges ranks 7th in active career leaders in the NCAA.

**NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP IN JOHNSON CITY**

The sophomore trio of Raven Dean, Carley Lytton and Sadasia Tipps have been productive for the Bucs this season. Raven Dean is third on the team with 7.1 points per game. Carley Lytton ranks second on the team with 20 three's made. Sadasia Tipps leads the Bucs with 35 offensive rebounds and ranks sixth in the SoCon with 2.5 offensive rebounds per game.

**STIFF COMPETITION**

ETSU's next four opponents (Old Dominion, Samford, Mercer, Chattanooga) in the past two seasons have combined to register 110 victories and a winning percentage of 63 percent.

**FINISHING IN REGULATION**

ETSU has not had to go to an overtime game since 2014

**THIS DATE IN HISTORY**

On December 28 all-time the Bucs have played nine games compiling an overall record of 4-5 on Dec.28. It's ETSU's first game on the day since 2013 versus George Mason.

**LYTTON IT UP**

Off the bench this season, sophomore Carley Lytton has been a consistent offensive threat for the Bucs. Lytton is averaging 5.1 points per game and ranks second on the team with 20 three's. Lytton was on fire at the Miami Holiday Tournament recording two double digit games.

Since 2015, ETSU has a 14-4 record when scoring the first basket. On the contrary, when ETSU didn't score the first basket of the game, the Bucs were 9-16.

**75 IS THE MARK**

Since the 2002-03 season, the Bucs are 127-21 when they hit the 75-point plateau. The winning percentage grows even higher since 2006-07 as the Bucs have a record of 95-16 when scoring at least 75 points.

**BENCH PLAY LOOMING LARGE**

ETSU has gotten solid play from their bench this season as the Buccaneers have scored 285 of the total 920 points from the bench. ETSU has recorded eight games in which the bench has scored more than 20 points including a 31 point bench performance vs. No.13 Tennessee on Nov.15

Tarter had a night against Vanderbilt that ETSU fans will never forget pouring in a career-high 35 points on 15-of-28 shooting from the field. Tarter's 35 points was the most by a SoCon player this season while her 15 made field goals ranks as the 3rd most in the NCAA this season.

**WOMEN'S BASKETBALL SETS ATTENDANCE RECORD**

Against No.13 Tennessee, the ETSU women's basketball program set a new attendance record of 6,072 as the Bucs and the Lady Vols hit the court. Due to the amount of people the game was moved into the ETSU/MSHA Athletic Center, marking the first time ETSU has played a basketball game in the mini-dome since 2013.

**HISTORIC PERFORMANCES**

ETSU has had multiple historic and record breaking performances this season:

- Tarter makes 11 free-throws at Butler, fifth most in a single-game at ETSU
- Bridges has six three's vs. Northern Kentucky, fourth most in a single-game in ETSU history
- Tarter goes 12-of-19 at Austin Peay, the 12 field goals is the third most in a single-game at ETSU.
- Tarter's 35 points vs. Vanderbilt is second most in a single-game in ETSU history

**BUCS LEADS NATIONALLY RANKED LADY VOLS**

ETSU held a led over No.13 Tennessee for 4:27, recording as big as a four-point lead midway through the first quarter. In the past two seasons, ETSU has led the nationally ranked and heavily favored Lady Vols for a total of 7 minutes and 30 seconds.

**COMING THROUGH IN THE CLUTCH**

The past three seasons ETSU is 10-4 when games are decided by less than three points.

**BRIDGES, TARTER NAMED PRESEASON ALL-SOCON**

For the second straight year both Shamauria Bridges and Tianna Tarter earned Preseason All-SoCon honors. Tarter despite missing eight games led the Bucs with 17 points per game. Bridges a season ago connected on 76 three's which ranked first in the SoCon

**BUCS PICKED FOURTH IN PRESEASON SOCON POLL**

This season the Buccaneers were picked to finish fourth in the preseason coaches' and media poll.

**YOUNG BUT EXPERIENCED**

Heading into the 2016-17 campaign, the ETSU coaching staff is one of the youngest in the NCAA. With an average age of 36 years old, the Bucs currently rank top 20 in the nation. Last season, ETSU had the second youngest coaching staff in the NCAA.

**TWIN-WINNING**

ETSU is one of only a few programs in the country to have twins on the 2016 roster. The Bucs have two local products in freshman Kayla Marosites and Kelci Marosites.

**DOUBLE DUTY**

Junior forward Mallore Schurr takes after her head coach by making the most of her time in college playing two sports (Basketball and Softball). As a sophomore Schurr played in 30 games, starting 10 and averaged 3.3 points and 4.8 rebounds. On the softball diamond, Schurr hit .257 with one home run and eight RBI's in 25 games played.

**HARD WORK IN THE CLASSROOM**

Not only does the ETSU women's basketball team work hard on the court but in the classroom as well. Last season the Bucs posted a cumulative GPA of 3.179, which is 0.59 points higher than non ETSU athletes. The blue and gold boasted two perfect 4.0 GPA's while 8 players made the SoCon Academic Honor Roll.

**DEAN MAKING HER OWN LEGACY**

Sophomore Raven Dean is the daughter of former NFL Wide Receiver Muhsin Muhammed. Muhammed played 14 seasons in the NFL for the Carolina Panthers and Chicago Bears, appearing in two Super Bowls.

**EZELL INKS THREE**

Fourth year head coach Brittney Ezell and her staff signed three during the early signing period. The Bucs welcome Erica Haynes-Overton, Alayjah Sherer and Britney Snowden to Buccaneer Family.

**BRITTNEY EZELL** became the eighth head coach in the 48-year history of East Tennessee State University women's basketball on May 8, 2013.

The 2016 season features a rigorous non-conference schedule for ETSU including home contests against Vanderbilt, Old Dominion and the University of Tennessee. Ezell has constructed difficult non-conference schedules year in and year out since being hired in 2013, playing a total of 13 teams from power five conferences.

During the 2015-16 season, Ezell guided the Bucs to their third straight winning season including a perfect 6-0 record at home against non-conference opponents. Ezell and the ETSU Women's Basketball program captured a signature victory early in the season when the Bucs defeated Old Dominion on the road. ODU is the third winnigest program in NCAA Division I women's basketball history.

In 2014-15, ETSU experienced an unbelievable turnaround under Ezell with a 16-game win progression from 2013-14 where the Bucs went 9-21. The total win improvement was the second best in the country. The 2014-15 win total of 21 marked the first time since the 2009-10 season that ETSU reached 20 wins. Led by Ezell, the Bucs made it to the Southern Conference Tournament championship game falling to No. 1 seed Chattanooga in overtime, 61-56. ETSU appeared in the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT) for the third time in school history falling short to NC State, 73-59.

In three years at Belmont University, Ezell navigated the Bruins through their final two seasons as a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference (2011-12) and inaugural season in the Ohio Valley Conference (2013).

In 2012-13, Ezell directed the Bruins to 11 conference victories and a league tournament No. 3 seed in the program's final Atlantic Sun Conference campaign. Senior Haley Nelson ranked among the NCAA leaders in double-doubles, field goal percentage, blocked shots and rebounds en route to First Team All-Atlantic Sun honors.

Ezell took the helm of the Belmont program after spending the previous two seasons as head coach at the University of Montevallo. Inheriting a Falcon program that recorded one winning season in its previous 12 years, Ezell directed Montevallo to a 14-13 record in 2009-10. The Falcons also ranked second in the Peach Belt Conference in scoring defense.

Prior to Montevallo, Ezell spent three seasons as head coach at Okaloosa-Walton Junior College (now Northwest Florida State College) in Niceville, Fla. The Lady Raiders went 57-28 under Ezell's watch, including an appearance in the 2006 NJCAA Regional Tournament. During her tenure, Ezell developed 14 All-Panhandle Conference performers, 12 of whom would go on to sign national letters of intent with NCAA Division I schools. The Lady Raiders also had 12 Academic All-Conference honorees.

Ezell's coaching career began at the University of Alabama, where she spent five years as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. She was credited with delivering back-to-back top 15 ranked recruiting classes for the Tide, with four guards developing into All-SEC players.

Ezell was a four-year starting point guard for the Tide, helping lead the team to a 95-34 record and four consecutive NCAA Division I "Sweet Sixteen" appearances from 1995-98. She ranks in the top 20 in career scoring with 1,022 points and is second all-time in career assists (620) and games started (114). She was a Second Team All-SEC selection in 1998 and was named to the SEC All-Tournament Team in 1996. In 1998, Ezell was a candidate for the Francis Pomeroy Naismith Award, given to the top point guard in the country and was named to the inaugural WBCA/Honda All-Star game for the nation's top 20 players. She was also invited to the WNBA Rooke Combine in Chicago.

Additionally, Ezell became the first female two-sport athlete at Alabama in over a decade when she joined the Tide softball team. A two-time Golden Glove recipient and two-year starter at third base and shortstop, Ezell started at third base for UA's first SEC Tournament Championship team in 1998.

Ezell earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Alabama in 1999 and a master's degree in education administration from the University of Nebraska in 2005. A native of Franklin, Tenn., Ezell was a prep standout at Franklin High School. She was a three-time District MVP, tallying over 2,000 points and 600 assists in her career.

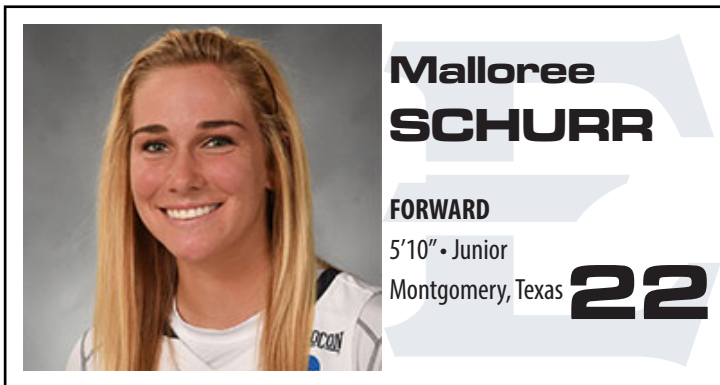
