Tip-off between the Bears and Monarchs is set for 7 p.m. at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in Norfolk and will air live on CSN/Cox 11 with Ted Alexander making the call and Charlie Woollum providing color. The Bears then travel to Cameron Indoor Stadium to take on the Duke Blue Devils in a battle of top 10 teams (No. 4 vs No. 10) and top 10 offenses (No. 3 vs No. 7).

## CALIFORNIA HEAD COACH LINDSAY GOTTLIEB



Lindsay Gottlieb, a former associate head coach of the California women's basketball team, returned to Berkeley as the ninth head coach in program history, taking over for the 2011-12 season.

In her first season at the helm in 2011-12, Lindsay Gottlieb took the Bears back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2009, with her Bears advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament, and became the first coach in Cal program history to win 20 games in her first season at the helm.

Gottlieb also led the Bears to a second place Pac-12 finish, just the third time since joining the Pac-10 in its inaugural season (1985-86) that the Bears have finished in second place and it is only the second time that Cal has finished with sole possession of second.

Before returning to Cal, Gottlieb spent three seasons as the Head Coach at the University of California at Santa Barbara. In her three seasons with UCSB, Gottlieb led the Gauchos to two postseason berths and a pair of Big West Conference championships, amassing a 56-39 (.589) record in addition to 2009 Big West Coach of the Year honors.

In 2010-11, Gottlieb guided the Gauchos to their second Big West title in her three seasons at the helm, amassing a 19-12 record (12-4 in the Big West) before falling in the first round of the WNIT to USC. Gottlieb's first team in 2008-09 amassed a 22-10 overall record and a 15-1 mark in the Big West, claiming the conference's regular-season and tournament crowns to earn an NCAA Tournament appearance. Gottlieb was the first-ever coach at UCSB to win 20 games in her first season and became one of only seven active coaches nationwide to win 20 games in her first year and also be named Coach of the Year.

Other accolades for Gottlieb include becoming the first coach in UCSB history to win her first 11 conference games and the first coach in school annals to finish her inaugural season with a winning record.

Prior to UCSB, Gottlieb initially joined the Cal staff as an assistant coach under Joanne Boyle in 2005-06, a position she held for two seasons before being elevated to associate head coach in 2007-08. Gottlieb was integral to the development of Cal's post players, including Devanei Hampton, the 2006-07 Pac-10 Player of the Year and a two-time All-Pac-10 selection, and Ashley Walker, an All-American and Cal's first player to be selected in the first round of the WNBA draft.

Gottlieb spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Richmond under Boyle before the two came to Cal. The Spiders posted 20-plus wins each year and advanced to the postseason three times. In 2004-05, Richmond finished with a 23-8 record and earned the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in 14 years. The Spiders were invited to the 2003 and 2004 WNIT.

Prior to Gottlieb's stint at Richmond, she served as an assistant coach at New Hampshire in 2001-02 under head coach Sue Johnson and as an assistant coach for two years at Syracuse with Marianna Freeman at the helm. While at Syracuse, she earned her Master's degree in Philosophy of Education.

The Scarsdale, N.Y., native graduated from Brown in 1999 with a Bachelor's of Arts degree in Political Science and was a member of the women's basketball team. Gottlieb was a student assistant coach during the 1998-99 campaign and received the Team Heart and Soul Award in 1999.

Old Dominion enters the weekend unbeaten at 4-0 with wins over Virginia Tech, VCU, USC Upstate and UMES. Senior **Jackie Cook** leads the Monarchs with 18.8 ppg and 7.3 ppg, and junior college All-American **Shae Kelly** averages a near double-double at 10.5 ppg/8 ppg.

### CALIFORNIA-OLD DOMINION SERIES HISTORY

California and Old Dominion have met three times with the Monarchs enjoying a 2-1 series advantage after winning the last meeting between the teams, 80-58, in Berkeley in the 1995-96 season. Cal's lone win in the series was a 78-70 victory on January 14, 1984.

### OLD DOMINION HEAD COACH KAREN BAREFOOT

Coach Barefoot is in her 2nd season at Old Dominion after winning traditions at Lehigh-Rhyne and Elon. The Monarchs went 11-21 in her first season in Norfolk.

**GAME RECAP:** **Layshia Clarendon** scored 10 points in the opening four minutes and finished with a season-high 20 to be named the Cal Classic by Doubletree MVP after No. 11 California toppled Georgetown, 72-56. **Talia Caldwell** earned 12 points and nine rebounds in the final, and **Brittany Boyd** dished a new career-high of 14 assists to go with six points and three steals for the Bears. Over two games of the Cal Classic, Boyd tallied a stat line of 19 points, 24 assists and 11 steals. **Gennifer Brandon** registered her fourth double-double in five games this season with a 13-point, 13-rebound effort, and senior **Eliza Pierre** had a season-high 10 points along with two assists and two steals.

**IN THE RANKINGS:** California improves one spot to No. 10 in the Associated Press and held steady at No. 11 the USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Polls, the highest rankings for the Bears since the 2008-09 team climbed as high as No. 4 in the country. That team, led by **Alexis Gray-Lawson**, went on to advance to the NCAA Sweet 16 with a 27-8 final record. Four teams on this year's schedule - Stanford (1/1), Duke (4/4), UCLA (19/21), and Kansas (20/20) - are ranked this week in addition to Georgetown and Utah receiving votes in the polls.

**A LOOK AHEAD:** The Bears remain on the road with a trip down I-5 to take on Cal State Bakersfield on Friday, Dec. 7, before taking 10 days off of competition during finals week.

**BALANCED ATTACK:** One thing Coach Gottlieb is preaching this season is the balanced options that her team possesses on the offensive end of the court, and the numbers back up that assertion. Six Bears average double figures scoring in the early going of the season, and a different Bear has led the team in scoring in every game\* (**Gennifer Brandon** and **Talia Caldwell** both scored 15 points vs EWU, making Brandon the lone Bear with the top output in two games).

**BRANDON'S DOUBLE-DOUBLES:** Junior **Gennifer Brandon's** has posted four double-doubles in Cal's five games to open the 2012-13 season. Her double-double (17p-10r) against Lehigh in the opener was the 16th of her career, and she followed that effort with double-doubles against Saint Mary's (14p-14r), Cal poly (18p-11r) and Georgetown (13p-13r). The Sylmar native collected six double-doubles as a freshman in 2009-10 and nine double-doubles as a redshirt sophomore in 2011-12.

**CAL ON THE BOARDS:** Senior **Talia Caldwell** and junior **Gennifer Brandon** combine to make the Cal post players possibly the most dominant on the boards in the Pac-12. Caldwell is the active Pac-12 leader with 783 rebounds, and Brandon is not far behind at No. 4 on the active list with 695 boards. No other duo in the league combines for over 1,200 rebounds, let alone the 1,478 by these two.

**BOYD'S BREAKOUT:** Sophomore **Brittany Boyd** had a weekend to remember at the Cal Classic by Doubletree with a two-game average of 9.5 points, 12.0 assists and 5.5 steals. Boyd broke her career-best in assists in back-to-back games, dishing 10 times against Eastern Washington before getting 14 assists against Georgetown. The Berkeley native came two steals shy of her first career triple-double against EWU with 13 points, 10 assists and 8 steals.

**CALDWELL APPROACHES 10:** Senior **Talia Caldwell** currently has 783 career rebounds, a mark that is six shy of matching **Ingrid Dixon** for No. 10 in the California all-time record book at 789.

**JEMERIGBE'S JUMPER:** Junior **Afure Jemerigbe** has seen a marked improvement in her jumper after working with **Coach Kai Felton** on it in preparation for the season. Jemerigbe's numbers - especially her 3pt shot - have seen big spikes in the early part of the season with the junior shooting .487 from the field and .455 (10-of-22) from beyond the arc. In her first two seasons, Jemerigbe was a .329 3pt shooter (FR-.257; SOPH-.380).

**CLARENDON NAMED TO NAISMITH LIST:** Senior guard **Layshia Clarendon** was selected as one of 50 players to watch in the early Naismith Watch List. Clarendon is the fourth Golden Bear to be selected to the list in the past 10 seasons for the prestigious national player of the year award.

**BECOMING ELITE:** The Bears speak this season of becoming one of the "elite" teams in NCAA women's basketball after seeing flashes in 2011-12 but not quite making the jump with close losses to No. 2 Stanford, No. 12 Ohio State, No. 16 Rutgers, No. 24 Texas and No. 4 Notre Dame. The first test in 2012-13 was a Georgetown team that was on the fringes of the top 25, and the Bears responded with a 72-56 victory. The next ranked team on the schedule is No. 4 Duke on the road - a big step in early evaluation of the new Cal.

**PIERRE STEALS THE LIST:** Count senior **Eliza Pierre** as one of the top defensive players in Cal history. Pierre stands at No. 5 in the Cal history books with 211 career steals after her three-steal effort against Lehigh pushed her past **Laura Baker's** 204 along with two against both Saint Mary's and Georgetown. The record of 295 steals is held by **Mazetta Garrett** (1979-84). Pierre also stands at No. 2 in the Pac-12 active career list behind **Chucky Jeffery** of Colorado (212).

**MAKING THEM SEE GRAY:** Sophomore **Reshanda Gray** scored 22 points in Cal's win over Cal Poly, just one shy of her career-best of 23 set against UNLV last season. Gray was led by a 10-of-14 effort from the charity stripe to become the first Golden Bear in two years to hit 10 free throws in a game. The last to do so was DeNesha Stallworth at Oregon on Mar. 25, 2010.

**POINT GUARD DELIGHT:** Sunday's game will be a matchup of the top point guard in the country in sophomore **Brittany Boyd** and Duke's Chelsea Gray. Gray (4th) and Boyd (5th) are some of the top in the NCAA in assists per game.

**CAL ADDS FOUR FOR THE FUTURE:** Head coach **Lindsay Gottlieb's** first signing class at California consists of **Hind Ben Abdelkader** (Bruxelles, Belgium), **Mercedes Jefflo** (Compton, CA / Centennial Senior HS), **Courtney Range** (Stockton, CA / Manteca HS) and **Kendall "KC" Waters** (Oakland, CA / Bishop O'Dowd HS). With two players considered among the top 55 players in the country according to ESPN HoopGurlz rankings, the incoming group gives California its fourth top 20 recruiting class in the last five years - the lone exception being last season when the Golden Bears did not sign any players. The incoming group is ranked No. 13 by the All Star Girls Report and No. 20 by the BlueStar Basketball Report.

**BEARS ON THE SCREEN:** California will make a minimum of 13 TV appearances this season with the emergence of the Pac-12 Networks broadcasting a majority of conference games. The Bears will play in their first televised game on a road trip to Old Dominion that will be broadcast regionally (Norfolk, Va.) on Cox 11. Once the Bears hit conference play, 12 of 17 games will be broadcast by either the Pac-12 Networks or the ESPN family of networks, beginning with the conference opener at Utah on Jan. 4, 2013.

**NO. 2 IN THE PAC-12:** The Bears were selected to finish second in the Pac-12 Coaches' and Media Polls, a statement across the region that the Bears are solidly in the upper echelon of Pac-12 programs entering 2012-13. The Bears received one first-place vote (out of 12) in the coaches' poll and two first-place votes (out of 14) in the media poll. Stanford was the preseason favorite in both polls to win the league. "That's probably where we would have expected to be coming off of last year," head coach **Lindsay Gottlieb** said. "We finished second. The difference for us this year is almost the entire same group comes back. Last year it was about establishing ourselves and who do we want to be, what brand of basketball do we want to play and making a name for ourselves. We're trying to become one of the few elite teams in women's college basketball." California finished second in the regular season and in the conference tournament last season.

**CLARENDON NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE:** Senior guard **Layshia Clarendon** has been selected as one of 30 candidates for the 2012-13 Senior CLASS Award for women's basketball, presented annually to a senior student-athlete who excels both on and off the field. Candidates are chosen based on their dedication and achievement in four areas: Classroom, Character, Community and Competition. Clarendon was the only women's student-athlete from the Pac-12 to be named a candidate for the collegiate basketball award. From the list of 30 candidates, 10 finalists will be selected midway through the regular season and placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote. The winner will be announced at the 2013 NCAA Women's Final Four in New Orleans, La., April 7-9.

**CLARENDON PICKS UP PRESEASON HONORS:** Senior guard **Layshia Clarendon** was selected to the Preseason All-Pac-12 team as voted by members of the media. Clarendon helped lead California to an NCAA Second Round berth and Pac-12 runner-up finish last season in addition to being named a WBCA All-American for the first time in her career. The All-Region VIII honoree was also named to the All-Pac-12 first team, averaging 12.8 ppg. After scoring 20 points in the conference final against Stanford, she was also named to the All-Pac-12 Tournament team. Clarendon will head into the 2012-13 campaign 138 points shy of being in the top-10 in program history in career points scored (1,230).

**FRESH NEW FACES:** The Bears will not have to break in any players this season with no freshmen or eligible transfers on the roster in 2012-13. California enters the year as one of the most experienced programs in the Pac-12 with an active lineup of three seniors, four juniors and three sophomores. Cal did welcome one new player, junior guard **Brittany Shine** (Sacramento, Calif.) from the University of Florida, who will sit out this season per NCAA transfer rules.

## HAAS PAVILION | BERKELEY, CALIF.

On the same site where the beloved Harmon Gym stood for more than 60 years, the Water A. Haas Jr. Pavilion has risen as a modern sports facility that retains the old building's famous spirit.

The \$57.5 million arena opened in the fall of 1999 and though the structure is 37 feet taller, 28 feet wider and a capacity of 11,877 that doubles that of Harmon Gym, it has continued to keep fans close to the action.

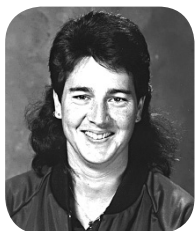
The building is named for Haas '37, who, with his wife, Evelyn, provided the lead gift for the renovation. A member of the tennis team while an undergraduate at Cal, Haas enjoyed a long career with Levi Strauss & Co., as both chief executive officer and chairman of the board during his tenure with the company. In 1953, Haas and his wife created the Evelyn and Walter Haas Jr. Fund, which has provided more than \$260 million in grants to nonprofit organizations, primarily in the Bay Area.

The playing surface in the arena is named for Pete Newell, the Hall of Fame coach who directed Cal to the 1959 NCAA championship and later coached the U.S. team to a gold medal at the 1960 Olympics.

Cal is in its 14th season competing at Haas Pavilion. Since Haas opened, the Bears have posted a 127-69 (.648) mark at home.



CALIFORNIA 1,000 POINT CLUB



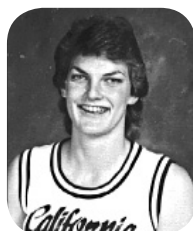
