QUICK HITS

CLEARED FOR TAKEOFF

The revamped Panther passing attack has payed dividends for FIU this season. Max Bortenschlager and company rank 20th in the country averaging 293.5 yards through the air per game.

Senior QB Borthenschlager has been the main catalyst in the revival averaging 269.2 per game, which ranks 18th nationally and is on pace to obliterate Jake Medlock's FIU record of 236.3 yards per game that was set in 2012. Borthenschlager has also broken the most passing yards in a single game record with 466 against Charlotte on 10/8. On top of all that, the Panther signal caller sits second in the the country in yards per completion with 17.51.

Biletnikoff watch list member Tyrese Chambers has been on the receiving end of those Borthenschlager passes. Chambers leads the nation in yards per reception averaging 26.28 yards per catch.

PRICE CLIMBING THE LADDER

Over the opening seven games of the 2021, D'vonte Price has rushed for 637 yards, which ranks 54th nationally, this season adding to an already accomplished career. The senior running back surpassed the 2,000 yard mark against Charlotte to become just the sixth Panther to do so.

SCOUTING THE MONARCHS

The Monarchs of Old Dominion enter this weekend's match up with a 2-6 overall record and are 1-3 in conference play.

ODU ranks 60th nationally in rushing offense, averaging 168.8 yards per game on the ground. The Monarchs also rank 49th in the country in totally defense only surrendering 354.5 yards a contest.

The visitors from Norfolk downed Louisiana Tech, 23-20 on Oct. 30 for the programs first win over a FBS team since 2018.

BACK-TO-BACK FOR PRICE

D'vonte Price earned back-to-back 100-yard games on the ground for the second time in his career, after rushing for 165 against Long Island and 111 versus Texas State to open the season. In FIU's history, there has only been nine running backs with consecutive 100-yard games. Rashod Smith's four in a row in 2004 is the all-time record. Price is only one of two Panthers to go back-to-back on two separate occasions.

PRICE IS RIGHT

D'vonte Price headlines the Panther squad heading into the 2021 season. The running back was names to the C-USA watch list, the Doak Walker watch list, and the Senior Bowl watch list prior to the season.

In his first full season as the primary tailback, Price rushed for 581 yards on 85 carries with four touchdowns along the way to being named to 2020 Conference USA honorable mention team. Price's 6.84 yards per carry topped the league and ranked 11th-best in the country in 2020.

Price rushed for over 100 yards in four of FIU's five games during the 2020 season including a career-high 178 yard performance against Florida Atlantic. The 178 yards was the eighth-best rushing outing by any Panther in FIU program history.

The Punta Gorda, Florida, native, set the FIU record for most rush yards per game in a season by averaging 116.2 yards per game in 2020.

PASSING THROUGH MOUNT PLEASANT

FIU's trip to Central Michigan proved to be one for the record books as the passing offense exploded for 395 passing yards. Max Bortenschlager went 20-38 while collecting all 395 yards. The 395 yards are the most by a Panther QB in a regulation game and the second most-ever at the time. On the receiving end, Tyrese Chambers hauled in six passes for 175 yards, which ranks fifth-most all-time for a Panther receiver and the most since Austin Maloney (178) in the 2019 Camilla Bowl. Not to be overshadowed, Bryce Singleton also filled the box score with 173 yards on six catches. The CMU game was the first time two Panther receivers went over the century mark since Glenn Coleman and Willis Wright in 2012.

WHERE BORTENSCHLAGER RANKS

Senior quarterback Max Bortenschlager has enjoyed a career renaissance under the tutelage of first-year QB coach Bryn Renner and OC Andrew Breiner. Bortenschlager ranks in the top 50 in seven different statistically categorizes.



AIRING IT OUT AGAINST CLT

Despite the loss to Charlotte on October 8, the Panther passing attack had one of the best performances in program history. Quarterback Max Bortenschlager passed for 466 yards on 19-of-30 with four touchdowns. Bortenschlager's 466 yards broke Paul McCall's record for most passing yards in a single game. The performace tied James Morgan's four touchdown against Arkansas-Pine Bluff in 2019. On the receiving end, Tyrese Chambers tied T.Y. Hilton's 201 yards against Louisville in 2011 with 201 yards of his own on three catches. Chambers also broke Hilton's average yards for catch by averaging 67 yards a pop against the 49ers secondary.





HEATHERLY NAMED TO RAY GUY WATCH LIST

Despite a covid-shortened 2020 season, Tommy Heatherly still shined enough to be named to the Ray Guy Award Watch List in July.

In 2020, Heatherly started all five games at punter for the Panthers and earned a 44.38 yard per punt average with 10 punts over 50 yards in 32 attempts. The 44.38 average ranks the highest in FIU single-season history.

Heatherly has been nothing short of sensational since arriving in Miami, averaging 43.5 yards per punt with 25 kicks of 50 or more yards since the start of the 2019 season.

The Grove, Oklahoma, native was the only non-P5 punter to be named a Ray Guy Semi-finalist in 2020.

BORTENSCHLAGER AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Despite only completing just over half of his passes through the first half of the season, Max Bortenschlager ranks second in the country in passing yards per completion averaging 17.51 yards, which is only bested by Grayson McCall (17.78) of Coastal Carolina.

DAMES' DAY

Rishard Dames had a career-day against Central Michigan. The junior totaled eight tackles while also picking off a pass. The icing on the cake was when Dames became the first Panther since 2015 to return a blocked punt for a touchdown.

PRICE CLIMBING THE LADDER

Over the opening seven games of the 2021, D'vonte Price has rushed for 637 yards, which ranks 54th nationally, this season adding to an already accomplished career. The senior running back surpassed the 2,000 yard mark against Charlotte to become just the sixth Panther to do so.

CHAMBERS NAMED TO BILET-NIKOFF WATCH LIST

During the bye week, Tyrese Chambers was named to the Watch List for the Biletnikoff Award, which is presented to the top receiver in FBS college football becoming the first panther to be named to the list since T.Y. Hilton in 2011.

Entering the ODU game, Chambers leads the nation in yards per reception, averaging 26.28 yards every catch. His 26.28 average is a full two yards clear of C-USA foe Trea Shopshire from UAB (24.18).

DAVIS PASSES CENTURY MARK

The 2019 season gave another milestone for Head Coach Butch Davis, as he officially passed the 100-win mark with a 32-17 victory over UTEP on Oct. 19. Davis has 103 career collegiate wins.

DAVIS NEARS FIU RECORD

Butch Davis only needs four wins to become FIU's all-time winningest coach in program history after earning 23 victories for the Panthers in just four seasons at the helm. Over his historic career, Davis has won 102 games.

On Nov. 15, 2016, Butch Davis was named the fourth head coach of the FIU football program, returning to South Florida where he made a name for himself as one of the premier minds in football. A man with a proven record of success and an unyielding commitment to excellence, Davis has brought an identity and a swell of energy to the FIU football program. Davis will enter his fifth season at FIU in 2021.

Davis has compiled a 102-59 overall record in 13 years as a college head coach, including three BIG EAST Championships while coaching the University of Miami (1995-00). In that span, Davis recruited and/or coached more than 120 players that made it to the NFL, 35 of which were first-round draft picks.

Davis coached in the NFL for 10 years and is still the only head coach to take the expansion Cleveland Browns to the playoffs in 2002, while winning a pair of Super Bowl rings as an assistant coach with the Dallas Cowboys in the early 1990s. During his 13-year collegiate coaching career, Davis guided his teams to 10 bowl games, winning six of them, including a 37-20 victory over the Florida Gators in the 2001 Sugar Bowl.


In just three seasons, Davis has transformed the football program and has instilled a winning tradition at FIU after taking the Panthers to three-straight bowl appearances and setting a school-record for wins (9) in 2018. Davis has also won 23 games in his first three seasons at the helm, which is the most by any Panther football coach in a threevear span.

Davis is also responsible for the program's biggest victory, after defeating the Miami Hurricanes 30-24 at Marlins Park in 2019.

Three players have been taken in the NFL Draft under Davis, with two of those being quarterbacks in Alex McGough and James Morgan. FIU joined Oklahoma, LSU and Washington State as the only schools in the country to have multiple quarterbacks drafted from 2018-2020. Furthermore, FIU has had more quarterbacks selected during the 2018-20 span than all other Florida FBS schools (Florida, Florida State, FAU, Miami, UCF and USF) combined in their last five drafts.

The 2019 season was one of resiliency. as the Panthers bounced back from an 0-2 start and injuries to earn another bowl bid to end the year. FIU finished the year with a 6-7 mark and closed out the season with a first-time trip to the Camellia Bowl in Mobile, Alabama, The Panthers lost a high-scoring affair to Arkansas State but not without setting numerous individual offensive records in the process.

The year was highlighted by a 30-24 victory over the Miami Hurricanes at Marlins Park in late November, as the Panthers pulled off the biggest win in program history. In addition to claiming bragging rights for the city of Miami, the win also made the Panthers bowl eligible for the third-straight season. James Morgan and Stantley Thomas-Oliver III were selected in the 2020 NFL Draft to cap the year, with Morgan going to the New York Jets in the fourth round and Thomas-Oliver to the Carolina Panthers in the seventh.

Coach Davis and the Panthers earned a 35-32 victory over the Toledo Rockets in the 2018 Bahamas Bowl. FIU finished the year with a 9-4 mark, which broke the school record for most wins in a single season.

In 2018, the Panthers capped the season with a 35-32 victory over Toledo at the Makers Wanted Bahamas Bowl as FIU finished the year with a school-best 9-4 mark. Additionally, the Panthers earned a 6-2 record in C-USA action, which was also a school record. The Panthers broke records statistically as well, most notably on the offensive side as FIU set new season marks in points (450), touchdowns (58), total offense (5,480), yards per play (6.38), passing touchdowns (27), passing yards (3,194), passer efficiency (154.7), completion percentage (65.5), yards per pass (8.3), rushing touchdowns (27), yards per rush (4.80) and sacks allowed (8).

Nationally, the Panthers ranked in the Top 10 among FBS schools for sacks allowed (3rd overall, 8 allowed), tackles for loss allowed (4th overall, 3.77), fumbles lost (9th overall, five lost) and turnovers lost (9th overall, 13 lost) in 2018. The FIU air attack was also highly ranked nationally, with the Panthers' passer efficiency of 154.7 ranking 12th in the country, while FIU's 34.6 points per game ranked 27th overall. Davis also saw a school-record 17 Panthers earn All-CUSA honors, highlighted

by first team selections Sage Lewis and Maurice Alexander.

Much of 2018's success on offense was due to quarterback James Morgan, who Davis coached to a C-USA Newcomer of the Year honor in his first season with the Panthers. Morgan set single-season records for touchdowns responsible for (27), total offense (2,708), passing touchdowns (26), passing yards (2,727) and passer efficiency (157.6).

In Davis' first season at FIU, the Panthers matched a school record in wins (8), before later breaking the mark in 2018. The Panthers also earned the school's first bowl berth since the 2011 season as FIU played Temple in the Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl. The 8-5 mark during the regular season was the best record of any first-year head coach at FIU.

FIU finished the 2017 regular season leading the nation in red zone scoring offense converting 98 percent of its red-zone chances (39-of-40), which includes 30 touchdowns. Davis' 2017 FIU squad not only matched the school record in wins,

FIU finished the 2017 regular season leading the nation in red zone scoring offense converting 98 percent of its red-zone chances (39-of-40), which includes 30 touchdowns. Davis' 2017 FIU squad not only matched the school record in wins, but the 2017 Panthers finished the regular season throwing for the second-most yards (3,031) and rushing for the third-most yards (2,069) in school history. The offense also totaled the third-most yards (5,100) and FIU scored the third-most points (333) in a season.

Defensively, the Panthers' 28.0 sacks ranked third in a single-season and the 75 tackles for loss tied for seventh overall. Davis also saw 12 Panthers earn All-CUSA honors highlighted by first team selection Thomas Owens.

Davis comes to FIU after serving as a college football studio analyst, while also contributing to coverage on College Football Live, ESPN Radio, ESPN.com and SportsCenter since 2014.

Before joining ESPN, Davis served as a consultant to the head coach for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers during the 2012 and '13 seasons. Prior to that, Davis had a long successful coaching career, including head coaching positions with the University of North Carolina (2007-10), the Cleveland Browns (2001-04) and the University of Miami (1995-00).

Davis spent four seasons at North Carolina, taking the Tar Heels to three-straight bowl games to end his tenure in Chapel Hill. Davis' UNC teams earned eight wins in his final three years, while capping the 2010 season with a thrilling, 30-27 victory over Tennessee in the Music City Bowl.

Davis was head coach for six seasons at Miami (1995-2000) and led the Hurricanes to a 51-20 record, three Big East Conference championships and four postseason bowl wins in as many appearances. His Hurricane teams finished ranked in the Associated Press Top 25 on four occasions, including No. 2 in the nation in 2000, when the Canes went 11-1 and beat Florida, 37-20, in the Sugar Bowl.

Davis left Coral Gables following the 2000 season to join the Cleveland Browns. In his first season in Cleveland in 2001, Davis led his young team to an impressive 7-9 record, exceeding by two the expansion club's combined victories from 1999 and 2000 (5-27).

His second season as head coach resulted in the Browns earning their first playoff appearance and best regular season mark since 1994, despite 34 of the 53 players on the team's final active roster having four years of NFL experience or less. The Browns have not returned to the playoffs since.

Cleveland was Davis' second stint in the NFL. While with the Cowboys from 1989-94, Davis helped Dallas post one of the most spectacular turnarounds in sports history as the Cowboys went from a lowly 1-15 squad in 1989 to one of the most dominant NFL programs in the 1990s.



Butch Davis enters the 2021 season in need of five wins to become winningest coach in program history.

He was the defensive line coach in the Cowboys' 52-17 win over Buffalo in Super Bowl XXVII and served as defensive coordinator in the Cowboys' 30-13 win over Buffalo in Super Bowl XXVIII. Davis was also defensive coordinator during Barry Switzer's first season as head coach in 1994 and helped Dallas reach the NFC Championship Game, where eventual Super Bowl champion San Francisco denied its bid for a three-peat. He coached three Pro Bowl starters while with the Cowboys – future Hall of Famer Charles Haley, Leon Lett and Darren Woodson.

From 1979-94, Davis had a successful 15-year association with Jimmy Johnson, first as a receivers and tight ends coach at Oklahoma State University (1979-83), then as a defensive line coach at the University of Miami and ending with the Dallas Cowboys, where he started as a defensive line coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator.

His coaching career began as a volunteer assistant in 1973 at Fayetteville High School in Arkansas. He had stints in Oklahoma at Pawhuska High School (1974-75) and Sand Springs High School (1976-77) as an assistant coach and at Tulsa Rogers High School (1978) in his first head coaching assignment before joining Johnson's staff at Oklahoma State in 1979. In addition to coaching, Davis also spent 1973-78 as a biology and anatomy teacher on the high school level.

A native of Bixby, Oklahoma, Davis earned a bachelor's degree in biology and life science from the University of Arkansas in 1974, where he played tight end and defensive end for the Razorbacks under Head Coach Frank Boyles.


