### WHAT WILL IT TAKE FOR 500?

Head Coach Wendy Larry is rapidly approaching the 500 victory mark in her career. To date she needs one victory to reach the mark. She currently holds a 499-184 overall record in her 23rd season as a head coach. Additionally, Coach Larry just recently captured her 450th victory as the head coach at her alma mater with a 57-46 win over Delaware State on November 25. She holds a 450-153 record in her 20th season at the helm of the Old Dominion program.

### **ABOUT OLD DOMINION:**

The Old Dominion women's basketball picked up its first two wins of the 2006-07 season last week. ODU defeated former CAA rival East Carolina, 77-66, and downed Delaware State, 57-46, in the first ever meeting between the two schools. Against the Pirates on Tuesday, the Lady Monarchs earned their first win of the season and snapped a two-game losing skid. Junior T.J. Jordan led the team in scoring for the third straight game with 16 points, connecting on 4-of-7 from the field, 3-of-6 from three-point range, and a perfect 5-of-5 from the free throw line. In a rare occurrence, East Carolina outrebounded Old Dominion. The Pirates held a 45-33 advantage on the boards, which included holding the Lady Monarchs to just seven offensive rebounds. On Saturday, Wendy Larry earned her earned her 450th win as the head coach of the Lady Monarch program and moved to within one game of collecting her 500th career win as Old Dominion with the victory over the Hornets. Junior T.J. Jordan and senior Sherida Triggs led Old Dominion with 12 points each.

### **ABOUT DUKE:**

The Blue Devils enter Wednesday's contest with the Lady Monarchs with a 5-0 record and ranked fifth in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. Duke has already played two future ODU opponents in CAA rival Northeastern and the Lady Monarchs' next opponent in Penn State. The Blue Devils opened the season against the Huskies, 102-49, and downed Penn State, 70-42. After opening the season with four straight home games, Duke is coming off its first road game, a 92-47 win at Michigan. Abby Waner is one of four Blue Devils averaging double figures, leading the offense with 15.0 points per game. Following Waner is Alison Bales (11.8 ppg), Lindsey Harding (11.2), and Carrem Gay (10.0). Bridgette Mitchell leads the team on the glass (7.2 rpg). Duke enters the game having outscored their opponents by an average of 38.6 points.

### **SERIES WITH DUKE:**

The Lady Monarchs are looking for their first win over the Blue Devils since the 1996 season. Duke owns a 4-6 advantage in the alltime series having won the last three meetings, including last season's 93-56 victory as the nation's number one team in the Associated

Press Poll took on the Lady Monarchs in its season opener. Old Dominion's last victory came on December 7, 1996 with an 89-77 win in the Central Fidelity Classic. In Durham, the Lady Monarch are 1-2 with the lone win in Cameron Indoor Stadium on January 21, 1989 with a 77-70 win. In Norfolk, Old Dominion is 2-2 against the Blue Devils and in neutral site match-ups, Duke owns the advantage 2-1.

### LAST TIME VS. DUKE

Abby Waner scored 17 points to lead No. 1/2 Duke to a 93-56 defeat of Old Dominion on November 20, 2005 at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. For ODU, guard T.J. Jordan poured in 17 points to lead the team. The Blue Devils got off to a torrid start in the first half, opening up a 26-4 advantage in the first 8:53 minutes of the game. ODU would make a run of their own, using nine consecutive points by Jordan to cut the Duke lead to 39-20. Old Dominion would get no closer than 17 points the rest of the game. Jazzmin Walters and Paula Muxuri were bright spots for the Lady Monarchs. Walters dished out eight assists in her career debut, and Muxuri scored 12 points on 5-of-8 shooting. Tish Lyons hauled down five offensive rebounds in the losing effort. Jordan would bury two treys, the only three point shots made by the Lady Monarchs on the afternoon. Waner shot 7-of-9, and 2-of-4 from three point lead to earn her 17 points on the day. Wanisha Smith dished out a game-high 11 assists, and Monique Currie totaled 15 points and nine boards, almost notching a double-double.

The Lady Monarchs have already faced Kentucky, falling to a #21 (AP)/24 (ESPN/USA Today) Wildcat squad 55-69 in their home opener back on November 18th. Other teams still left on the schedule include Tennessee (Dec. 22) and Rutgers (Dec. 30). Virginia, Penn State, and Middle Tennessee have also been scene in the "receiving votes" categories in both polls. Old Dominion fell 72-92 at Virginia in the season opener and will meet Penn State on Sunday and Middle Tennessee on Dec. 19.

### SO WE MEET FOR THE FIRST TIME:

When you look at the Old Dominion Lady Monarch schedule, you can always count on familiar teams such as Tennessee, Rutgers, and Penn State along with various other teams they play on again and off again. Three teams grace this years schedule who the Lady Monarchs have never met. First up is Delaware State, who the Lady Monarchs handed a 57-46 loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion will also have its first meeting in school history at home against Chicago State and at Middle Tennessee State.

### **D-D-D-DEFENSE:**

In their 57-46 win over Delaware State, the Lady Monarchs held the Hornets to 29.0 percent (18-of-62) from the floor, the lowest percentage by an ODU opponent this season.

### **FREE POINTS:**

One aspect of Saturday's game against Delaware State Old Dominion would like to improve upon would be free throw shooting. The Lady Monarchs shot just 45.7 percent from the free throw line (16-of-35). Senior Sherida Triggs did manage to go perfect hitting all four free throw attempts as did freshman Jessica Canady who hit both her attempts.

### WE CAN HIT THEM:

Although the Lady Monarchs did not manage as well as they would like from the line last game, Old Dominion does have several good free throw shooters. Senior Tish Lyons is still perfect from the line (8-of-8) and although junior Megan Pym has only attempted two free throws so far this season, she is perfect as well (2-of-2). In all, five Lady Monarchs are shooting 86 percent or better from the charity stripe - Junior T.J. Jordan (17-of-19 - .882), senior Sherida Triggs (13-of-15 - .867), and freshman Jessica Canady (7-of-8 - .875).

### SHE SHOOTS...SHE SCORES...A LOT:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan has led the Lady Monarchs in scoring in all four games this season. Jordan has led Old Dominion in scoring on 19 occasions during her career, including 12 times serving as the team's point guard last year.

### **NOT SEEN VERY OFTEN:**

In a rare occurrence, the opposition outrebounded Old Dominion in a victory. The East Carolina Pirates held a 45-33 advantage on the boards, which included holding the Lady Monarchs to just seven offensive rebounds. The Lady Monarchs were outrebounded in only nine of its 31 games last year and none by double digits. Five of the nine times Old Dominion was outrebounded resulted in a loss for the Lady Monarchs. In six of those nine occasions, the opponent outboarded Old Dominion by four rebounds or less. Florida International and James Madison, in the first meeting of the year, both held an eight board advantage over Old Dominion, the most of the season.

### 0-2...SO WHAT?:

The Lady Monarchs may have started the 2006-07 season 0-2, but that's no reason to think the sky is falling. Last season, Old Dominion opened the season 0-2 and finished the year with a 22-9 overall mark and their 15th straight CAA title. The 2003-04 Lady Monarchs opened 0-2 and picked up ranked wins over #7 Penn State and #12/13 North Carolina. They finished 25-7 along with the CAA title. The 2002-03 Lady Monarchs opened 0-3 but managed a 20 win season going 21-9 with a CAA title. The 2000-01 season saw Old Dominion go 0-2 and also finished with a 21-9 mark and a CAA title. The 1992-93 women's team started the year off 0-4, but ended the year 22-8 overall, with yes...another CAA title and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

### **KEEP SHOOTING PARTNER:**

Junior guard T.J. Jordan came off the bench in the 72-92 season opening loss at Virginia to net a team-high 21 points. Shooting 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range, the third year Lady Monarch set new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted. The Lady Monarchs' three-point specialist, she holds the single season three-point attempt mark (2005-06 - 248).

## BREAKING DOWN THE OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 25-13 in season openers, suffering a 72-92 set back in this year's opener at Virginia. Of the previous 38 season openers, Old Dominion has opened the season three times with Virginia with a win in 1977, a loss in 2002 with the opening of ODU's Ted Constant Convocation Center, and a loss in 2006 at the opening of UVA's John Paul Jones Arena. In home openers, the Lady Monarchs

are 27-11 including a 2-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion fell to #21/24 Kentucky in its 2006-07 home debut, 55-69.

### **OPEN THE DOOR:**

The Lady Monarch women's basketball team helped the Virginia Cavaliers open their new building - The John Paul Jones Arena - in ODU's first regular season contest on Saturday, November 12th. It was Virginia back on November 22nd, 2002 that helped Old Dominion open the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

### BACK TO THE POLLS:

The Lady Monarchs received votes in both the Preseason Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll. The Lady Monarchs have received votes over the last few seasons and are looking to return to the Top 25 in both polls. Old Dominion's last Top 25 ranking in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll was November 18th, 2003. Old Dominion's last appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 was the final poll of the 2002 season as the Lady Monarchs danced their way to the "Elite Eight".

### STREET & SMITH:

Street and Smith Magazine has listed the Old Dominion women's basketball team at No. 18 in its in their annual College Basketball Yearbook which went on sale on Oct. 1. Included on this year's schedule are five teams also appearing in Street and Smith's list including No. 5 Tennessee, No. 7 Duke, No. 14 Rutgers, No. 15 Kentucky and No. 20 Virginia.

## WHAT THE LADY MONARCHS WELCOME BACK:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team welcomes back four starters and nine letterwinners from last year's team that went 22-9 overall and captured its 15th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association title. Seventy two percent of the offense returns including the four of the five leading scorers and three of the four leading rebounders from a season ago. This year's group of seniors - Tish Lyons, Sherida Triggs, Shantel Wilson - enter the 2006-07 season having collected three CAA titles, three NCAA appearances, a 69-25 overall record and 49-5 mark in CAA matchups. Triggs joins junior guard T.J. Jordan on the Preseason Second Team All-CAA list. Triggs led the CAA in field goal percentage, was second on the ODU squad in scoring, and led the Lady Monarch rebounding corps. Jordan led the team in scoring and reset the single season three-point attempt record.

### **UP NEXT:**

The Lady Monarchs travel to Penn State in a game to be televised locally by Cox Cable. While Old Dominion holds a 4-0 record when playing the Lady Lions in Norfolk, the Lady Monarchs are looking for their first win in State College since 1983. Penn State holds a 3-1 series advantage on their home court.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 14straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 269-15 overall record, which includes eights seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 143-2 record at home and a 128-13 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, Ithe former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (2-0), George Mason (39-0), Northeastern (2-0), UNC-Wilmington (33-0), and Towson (9-0).

The Hornets closed out the first half on a 10-2 run, only letting freshman Jessica Canady (Jamestown, Va.) hit two free throws during the span. Old Dominion held on to a 29-22 lead at the half.

Old Dominion came out of the locker room and after missing their first two shots at the rim, Triggs collected the rebound and was fouled. Her traditional three-point play pushed the Lady Monarch lead to 10 with Old Dominion ahead 32-22.
However a 10-point lead quickly became only a two-point lead three minutes later.
Delaware State proceeded to take a 9-1 run, which was helped by Old Dominion's performance from the line. During the Hornet run, the Lady Monarchs got to the free throw line four times, but only connected on one attempt. A Jordan three helped stop the drought and Delaware State would get no closer than trailing 36-33 with 15:09 remaining.

Ahead 39-35 with the clock reading 11:11, the Lady Monarchs held the Hornets scoreless over the next four and half minutes while rattling off eight unanswered points. Ransburg capped the ODU run with two of her nine second half points to return a double figure edge back to the Lady Monarchs. Old Dominion went ahead 47-35 at the 6:58 mark and kept a double digit advantage over Delaware State for almost the rest of the way.

Old Dominion shot 42.2 (19-of-45) from the floor, but only shot 45.7 percent from the free throw line (16-of-35). Triggs did manage to go perfect hitting all four free throw attempts. The Lady Monarchs held the Hornets to 29.0 percent (18-of-62) from the floor, the lowest percentage by an ODU opponent this season.
