COLONIAL ROAD TRIP

ODU heads on the road for the final weekend road trip of the season. This weekend ODU will face two of the CAA's finer teams this season, as both VCU and James Madison are unbeaten in Colonial play. The Lady Monarchs face the Rams Friday night and the Dukes on Sunday. ODU has struggled against VCU recently, losing five of the last six matchups. The series is tied 5-5-3 all-time. JMU has also given ODU trouble in the past, as ODU is iust 5-10-1 against the Dukes. However, two of the ODU wins came last season, including the CAA Tournament Championship game.

In The Polls

JMU, VCU and ODU are all ranked in the SOCCER BUZZ Mid-Atlantic Regional Rankings. James Madison is also ranked 30th in the nation by Soccer Buzz.

Nationally Ranked

Janna Pearson ranks 27th in the nation in assists per game at 0.56. Shavon Knight is listed among the nation's top 100 scorers. Knight ranks 59th in goals per game (0.6) and 74th in points per game (1.4). Lauren Tupman is also ranked among the top 100 keepers in save percentage. She ranks 78th in the nation with an 0.82 percentage.

SCOUTING REPORT:

IN CAA ACTION. THE RAMS DEFENSE HAS RECORDED SIX SHUTOUTS IN ITS LAST SEVEN MATCHES. THE TEAM HAS THE SCHOOL RECORD FOR SHUTOUTS WITH EIGHT. HOWEVER, THEY HAVE ALSO BEEN SHUT OUT FIVE TIMES THIS SEASON. THEN AGAIN, ANY GAME THEY'VE SCORED, THEY'VE WON. JUNE HARTMAN LEADS THE ATTACK WITH FIVE GOALS.

SCOUTING REPORT:

THE RAMS ARE AT THE TOP OF THE LEAGUE AFTER GOING 4-0 JMU, CURRENTLY RANKED #30 BY SOCCER BUZZ, HAS RUN OFF A HISTORIC 10-1-1 START. THEY ARE 3-0-1 IN THE CONFERENCE WITH A TIE AT DREXEL. UP FRONT, THE DUKES DUKES ARE LED BY SENIOR ANNIE LOWRY, WITH SEVEN GOALS AND 17 POINTS. JMU IS UNDEFEATED AT HOME THIS SEASON (8-0) AND WILL BE PRIMED TO COMPETE AFTER FALLING TO ODU IN THE CAA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME LAST SEASON.

THE COACHES

VCU: Tim & Tiffany Sahaydack are in their first season as co-head coaches at VCU. The pair were stars on the national level as players and have already forced VCU into the limelight with a 7-4-1 start. They are assisted by Ronnie Pascale and Tresy Ross.

JAMES MADISON: David Lambardo, in his 18th season as the head coach of the Dukes has compiled a 216-136-3 record, including this season's 10-1-1 start. He ranks sixth all-time among NCAA Division I programs in wins, and is nearing 300 for his coaching career. He is assisted by Bobby Johnston, Whitney P. Sajko and Jason Moore.

OLD DOMINION: Head Coach Joe Pereira, two-time CAA Coach of the Year, leads the Lady Monarchs for his 13th season. His 257 career victories currently ranks him 25th on the NCAA All-Time wins list with 130 of them coming at Old Dominion. He coached the Lady Monarchs to the programs first ever NCAA Tournament last season in the finest season of ODU Women's Soccer history. He is assisted by Kim Francis & Stephanie Miller.

LAST TIME OUT

ODU came away with one loss and one tie in the second weekend of CAA play last week. The Lady Monarchs tied Northeastern on the road before falling to Hofstra. The 1-1 Northeastern game was tied by Shavon Knight, who scored her teamleading sixth goal on the season. The team struggled against Hofstra though, and were shutout for just the third time in the last 33 games. Old Dominion fell to 5-3-2 with the weekend results and are 1-2-1 in the conference.

POTENT ATTACK

Last season, the Lady Monarchs were extremely difficult to shutout. In 23 games, ODU was held empty just once, a new record for the program. It wasn't until the final game of the season when the Lady Monarchs faced the tenth seeded Wake Forest team on the road that they suffered their only shutout of the season.

The loss ended Old Dominion's 22 match streak of games with at least one goal scored. The Lady Monarchs continue to be an extremely potent offense and have scored at least one goal in all but three of the last 33 games. They are currently averaging 1.71 goals per contest, giving ODU the 88th best scoring offense in the nation.

CLIMBIN' THE CHARTS

Junior Shavon Knight is already among the programs historically best scorers and continues to climb. With her five goals already this season, she is now in the top five all-time with 24.

Her 56 career points has trampolined her into sole possession of fifth all-time behind Jen Henley (109), Beeman (86), Melanie McGovern (74) and Jennifer Gillespie (63). She is also tied for 9th all-time in assists with nine.

Fellow junior Janna Pearson also is among the top ten in points (36), goals (12) and assists (12). Also among the leaders is senior Lisa McKenzie with 39 points, 14 goals, and 11 assists.

Passin' Pearson

Junior forward Janna Pearson has been stellar passing the ball early this season as she has a league-high 5 assists in seven games, two fewer than the other leaders. She ranks 27th in the nation in assists per game (0.56) while she is second in the Co-Ionial in that category. She has nine points already, just four off her career high.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

The Monarchs have only allowed more than one goal in a game once this season. This obviously can be attributed to stellar goalkeeping (Lauren Tupman and Colby Owen have combined for a 0.95 GAA) but more importantly, the back four for the Monarchs have been near impregnable.

Dani Hammer, Saratu Dodo, Marilee Mastaler, Lizzy Brewster and ODU's first off the bench Brittney Kortz have been as solid as it comes. The defense in the second half has been especially impressive, allowing just 49 shots and three goals in the second frame this season. That's good enough for under five shots a game in the second half. For the game, ODU is allowing just 11 shots per game.

Last season, ODU broke a team record with a goals against average of 1.06. The Lady Monarchs back line is working to ensure they best that mark again in 2007.



OFFENSE A BREWIN'

Lizzy Brewster has come on VERY strong since being moved to the front line earlier this year. Brewster was an anchor on the defensive line until being moved up front during the NC State game. She has scored five goals in her first seven games up front and she's already eclipsed her two-year total for points in her career in just five games.
