- Old Dominion returns home after a two game road trip at Georgia Tech and No. 5 Stanford to play 3-0 Richmond.
- The Lady Monarchs take on Richmond for the 27th time in school history. ODU had a 21-game winning streak over the Spiders snapped last season with a 65-43 loss in Richmond.
- Head coach Karen Barefoot is the sixth head coach in school history, takes over for Wendy Larry, who coached ODU for 24 years, winning 17 CAA Championships and advancing to the NCAA Championship game in 1997.
- This is the fourth head coaching stint for Barefoot, as she comes from Elon where she led the Phoenix to their first ever women's basketball postseason tournament (WBI). She also coached Apprentice School and Lenoir Rhyne.
- Richmond is 3-0 on the year with wins over Navy, William and Mary and Boston University.

## Game Day Notes

### Leading the Way

Senior forward Tia Lewis led the Lady Monarchs with 11 points at No. 5 Stanford on Thursday. Lewis leads ODU with 12.7 points a game.

### Coming on Strong

Freshman Tiffany Minor had eight points and two three-pointers at No. 5 Stanford. The points and three's are career highs for the freshman from Maryland.

### Starting on Fire

Sophomore forward Shakeva Richards had a career-best game on Sunday at Georgia Tech. Richards scored 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting, including her first career three-pointer.

### For the First Time

Ashley Betz-White and Becca Allison made their first career starts on Friday and Sunday, respectively. Betz-White started in her first career-game Friday against Virginia Tech, while Allison got the start on Sunday at Georgia Tech.

### Starting on Fire

Freshman Ashley Betz-White was the only true freshman to start for ODU on Friday and the Mechanicsburg, Pa. native did not disappoint.

Betz-White made her first five shots from the field, including three 3-pointers on her way to a 22-point night.

The 22 points are the most for a freshmen in their first game since Donna Harrington put up 31 against Virginia Tech in the 1985 season-opener.

### New Faces on the Bench

Head coach Karen Barefoot is not the only new face on the ODU coaching staff this season. Bare-

foot brought three new assistant coaches on staff. Amaka Agugua joins the staff after two years at Indiana and before that spent three seasons at VCU. She played collegiately at Hofstra, where she still holds the record for field goal percentage (.551). Agugua will hold the title of recruiting coordinator.

Former Lady Monarch star Adrienne Goodson is back for her second tenure as an assistant coach, also serving as an assistant from 2004-05. Goodson ranks 11th in school history with 1,574 points and was inducted into the ODU Hall of Fame in 1999.

Tom McConnell rounds out the coaching staff for the Lady Monarchs. He joins ODU after spending the last four years at Colorado, helping the Buffs reach the WNIT Semi's in 2008.

Also new is Director of Operations, Sarah Teachey. She also returns, as she was the Director of Operations during the 2005-06 season.

### Lady Monarchs Picked Fifth

Old Dominion was picked to finish fifth this season in the CAA preseason poll. The voting was done by the league's head coaches. Delaware was picked to win the CAA, with VCU, James Madison and Hofstra rounding out the top four. ODU was tied for fifth with Drexel, followed by UNCW, George Mason, William and Mary, Georgia State, Towson and Northeastern.

### Lewis Preseason All-CAA

Senior Tia Lewis was the lone Lady Monarch selected to the preseason All-Conference team. Lewis is ODU's only returning starter, and led last year's squad with 12.1 points per game and 7.8 boards a game.

### Buchan is Back

Junior Mairi Buchan is back after redshirting last season due to an injury. The Scotland native will add another post presence to go along with Tia Lewis.

As a sophomore, Buchan averaged 4.8 points per game averaging 15 minutes a game coming off the bench.

### Barefoot Brings in Five

Head coach Karen Barefoot brought in five student-athletes in her first recruiting class. They are Michelle Brandao, Ashley Betz-White, Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor and Queen Tiye Jackson.

### Battle Against the ACC

ODU looks to make it back-to-back years with a win over an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent.

## Game Day Notes

ODU defeated Georgia Tech in last year's opener 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC team since a 78-70 win over Virginia in 2008.

The Lady Monarchs will have two chances this season, starting with the Hokies tonight, and again against the Yellow Jackets on Sunday in the first road game of the season.

### Openers

ODU lost to Virginia Tech in the Season-Opener on Friday night, as the Lady Monarchs are now 28-15 all-time in season openers. It was the first time ODU played an ACC opponent in its opener since the 2006-07 season, when the Lady Monarchs began the season with a 99-72 loss at Virginia.

It was the second time in school history opening up against Virginia Tech. ODU began the 1985-86 season against Virginia Tech at the scope. VT won 73-72. It is the eighth time opening against an ACC foe.

### Exhibition Success

ODU defeated Davis and Elkins 93-32 last week in their only exhibition contest. Freshman Tiffany Minor led four Lady Monarchs in double figures with 17 points. Mairi Buchan and JoNiquia Guilford each had a double-double, with Buchan notching 15 points and 12 boards while Guilford had 13 points and pulled in 10 rebounds. Jackie Cook rounded out the double-digit scorers with 15 points.

### NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on March 17 and 19.

### 2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

### 900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 929-325 (.741) and is in its 43rd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

### 2010-11 Recap/2011-12 Preview

- Old Dominion finished in second in the CAA regular season and advanced to the first round of the WNIT.
