ABOUT THE MATCH: New Mexico needs a win if it wants to have any chance at the conference title. The Lobos are already nine points behind the leaders and would fall 10 points back of Old Dominion (with just five matches remaining) if they lose on Saturday. The Monarchs are trying to keep pace with South Carolina and Kentucky, who are both 3-0-0 in C-USA play already.

SCOUTING OLD DOMINION ...

The Monarchs are one of the current front-runners in Conference USA, as well as one of the highest-scoring teams in the country. They average 2.5 goals per game, which is tied for fourth in the nation. They have four players with at least three goals, and since their season-opener (a 2-0 loss at Coastal Carolina), they have scored multiple goals in every game except one. Their defense, meanwhile, has been almost as good, limiting opponents to less than a goal per game. Redshirt junior keeper Alex Tiesenhausen owns a save percentage of .805 and two shutouts. ODU also has an experienced backline that features two juniors and two seniors.

HERRERA CALLED UP TO U.S. U20 ... Freshman defender Aaron Herrera has been called up to the U.S. U20 team for three friendlies in Germany this weekend and will miss UNM's match at ODU.

RPI UPDATE ... The Lobos checked in at No. 29 in the latest NCAA RPI update, which is second in Conference USA behind only South Carolina. Kentucky is 48th in the rankings.

WEHAN ENTERS TOP 10 ... Chris Wehan's scored the 21st goal of his career on Sept. 30 against San Francisco. That moved him into sole possession of 10th in UNM history. James Rogers and Lance Watson are tied for eighth with 22.

NSCAA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD ... The Lobos earned the NSCAA Team Academic Award on Sept. 23, the fourth straight year they've accomplished that. It's the 12th time under Coach Fishbein the Lobos have earned the award. Their 3.44 team GPA was the fourth highest among all Division I men's soccer programs.

BACK-TO-BACK AWARD SWEEPS ... UNM swept the Conference USA Player of the Week Awards for the second straight week. Niko Hansen and Nicholas Rochowski were named C-USA

Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, on Sept. 21. The Lobos have won six of the eight awards handed out this season.

LOBOS WIN TLC INVITATIONAL ... UNM won the TLC Plumbing & Utility Invitational last weekend courtesy of their wins over Missouri State (1-0) and No. 21 American (2-1, OT). Niko Hansen was named Tournament MVP and Offensive MVP, Nicholas Rochowski was the Defensive MVP, and Francesco Casucci and Patrick Khouri were named to the All-Tournament Team.

NO QUIT ... Amazingly the Lobos did not score in the first half until their ninth match of the season, against USF on Sept. 30, and they have found themselves trailing at the half five times in 2015. However, they have done pretty well in those matches, going 3-1-1.

LOBOS SWEEP AWARDS ... UNM swept the C-USA Players of the Week Awards on Sept. 14. Chris Wehan repeated as Offensive Player of the Week after scoring both game-winning goals for the Lobos. Jason Beaulieu earned his second Defensive Player of the Week award this year after earning his first shutout of the season on Sept. 12 and making eight saves during the weekend.

WEHAN CONSENSUS NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK ... Chris Wehan swept the National Player of the Week awards by major publications following his back-to-back two-goal games against San Diego and UCSB Sept. 4 and 6. He earned the honor from College Soccer News, Top Drawer Soccer and the NSCAA.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING ... Four Lobos made their first career start in UNM's loss at No. 1 UCLA on Aug. 29: sophomore Lucas Seligman, true freshman Aaron Herrera, and redshirt freshmen Matt Dorsey and Patrick Khouri. Herrera and Khouri went on to play all 90 minutes. Two other true freshmen, Francesco Casucci and Kasper Kajermo, both made their collegiate debuts

as substitutes. Simon Spangenberg, another true freshman, made his debut against San Diego on Sept. 4. Redshirt freshmen Olav Hovstad, Justin Hix and Gabriel Camera all appeared against San Francisco on Sept. 30 for their first action.

YOUNG BUT SAME EXPECTATIONS ... The Lobos are one of the youngest teams in the nation this year with 15 freshmen and four sophomores. Their total of 19 underclassmen is the 11th most in the country, and the highest in C-USA. Despite the youth, though, head coach Jeremy Fishbein expects the youngsters to play like veterans.

A LEADER AMONG LEADERS ... Head Coach Jeremy Fishbein continues to build his coaching legacy at New Mexico. The 2015 season will be Fishbein's 14th at the helm of Lobo Soccer. His UNM record of 179-60-29 makes him the program's all-time winningest coach. Furthermore, Fishbein has cemented himself among the best in the nation. His 153 wins since 2004 are third in the nation among all active NCAA Division I head coaches.

LOBO SOCCER: A MILE HIGH AND LOUDER THAN ...

The UNM Soccer Complex is building a reputation as one of the nation's toughest venues to play in. In addition to being "a mile high and louder than...", New Mexico has turned Albuquerque into one of the hottest tickets in college soccer. The Lobos have ranked in the top 15 in attendance nationally every season since the NCAA began keeping those statistics in 2001. It was first in attendance nationally in 2005 and has ranked in the top ten in every season since 2009.

MORE THAN AN INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR ...

While the diversity of the team roster is obvious, many Lobos have some serious international credentials. Two have represented their country in top-level international competition: Adrian Mora Delgado (Costa Rica U-17), Patrick Khouri (USA U-14, U-15 and Jamaica U-23). Niko Hansen was invited to USA's U-23 college ID camp in preparation for 2016 Summer Olympic qualifying in August. Most recently Aaron Herrera played with the U.S. U20 team for three friendlies in Germany in early October.

PRESEASON HONORS ...

The Lobos were picked to finish second in Conference USA as voted on by the league's coaches. UNM received one first-place vote and finished behind Charlotte. Chris Wehan and Niko Hansen were both voted onto the Preseason All-Conference Team. Wehan was also named to the MAC Hermann Trophy preseason watch list.

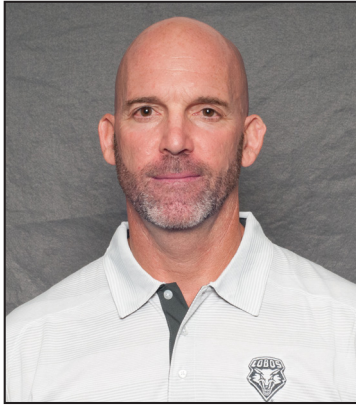
