- Old Dominion and James Madison have combined to win 18 of the past 19 CAA Championships. Today's game is a rematch of last year's CAA Tournament championship game that the Dukes won on their home floor.
- ODU has won four of its past five games and James Madison is riding a four-game winning streak.
- The Lady Monarchs are the second best team in the nation in defending the three-point line. Opponents are shooting just 21.1 percent from beyond the arc, which ranks No. 2 nationally.
- ODU has played the 18th most difficult schedule in the country according to CollegeRPI.com.
- Old Dominion is ranked No. 12 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, released January 4. JMU is No. 18.
- Senior Jasmine Parker ranks fourth nationally with 3.5 steals per game. The guard has swiped six or more steals in a game on three occasions this season.

Although Old Dominion holds a dominant advantage in the all-time series with James Madison, over the past six years the series has been evenly matched. In the last 15 meetings between the squads, the Lady Monarchs are 8-7 against the Dukes. ODU is 28-5 all-time in games played in Norfolk.

About James Madison

- After starting the year 5-5, James Madison has won four straight games to improve its record to 9-5 overall and 2-0 in CAA play.
- Senior guard Dawn Evans leads the nation in scoring at 25.8 points per game. Her 2,242 career points are the most of any active CAA player. ODU senior Jasmine Parker ranks third on the active CAA scoring list with 1,082 career points.
- Senior Lauren Jimenez is second on the Dukes with 13.4 points per game and leads the way on the boards with 8.5 rebounds a contest.
- The Dukes and Lady Monarchs were picked to finish as the top two teams in the CAA in the preseason poll. Old Dominion topped James Madison on its home floor during the regular season last year, but the Dukes upended ODU in Norfolk during the conference slate and then again in Harrisonburg in the CAA Championship game to exact revenge.

About Old Dominion

- The Lady Monarchs are 6-1 this season at the Constant Center, where they're averaging nearly 3,400 fans per game.
- As of January 2, Old Dominion boasts an RPI of #48. That is only bested in the CAA by Drexel, which is #36.
- Senior Jasmine Parker leads the team with 13.7 points and 3.5 steals per game. The guard has hit for double figures in 12 of 13 games this year and she has led the team in scoring in six contests.
- Junior Tia Lewis paces the squad in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and is second in scoring (12.6 ppg). In her last five games, Lewis is averaging 17.0 points and 10.2 rebounds.
- ODU has been dealing with a pair of significant injuries this season. Key reserve Mairi Buchan has missed every game with a foot injury, while senior Alena Voronina missed six games with an elbow injury before returning at Towson.

Game Day Notes

George Mason Recap

Junior Tia Lewis registered a career-high tying 24 points and pulled down 10 rebounds to lead Old Dominion past George Mason, 70-66, in the Lady Monarchs home Colonial Athletic Association opener Thursday. Lewis, who has scored in double figures in each of her last five games, now has a team-high five double-doubles on the year. Senior Jasmine Parker netted 12 points for her 12th double-digit scoring effort of the season and classmate Alena Voronina tallied 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting. Old Dominion, which has won four of its last five games, improves to 8-5 overall and 2-0 in CAA play. The Lady Monarchs also move to 25-0 all-time against George Mason on their home floor. Old Dominion shot 49 percent from the field, its second best shooting game of the season, only trailing the 52.1 percent the Lady Monarchs shot at Towson in their last outing.

Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just four wins shy of her 600th career victory. She has compiled a 596-228 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 547 career wins at ODU.

Second In The Nation

Old Dominion ranks No. 2 nationally in defending the three-point line. The Lady Monarchs have shut down their opponents on the perimeter, holding them to a 21.1 percent shooting clip. Teams are 37-of-175 from beyond the arc against ODU this year. Fairleigh Dickinson is holding its opponents to 21.0 percent from three-point land.

Mid-Major Poll

Old Dominion stayed put at No. 12 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which was released January 4. Green Bay sits atop the rankings, while Delaware (No. 11), Drexel (No. 14), James Madison (18), Hofstra (24) & UNC Wilmington (25) also represent the CAA.

Parker Reaches 1,000

Senior guard Jasmine Parker became just the 28th all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her game-high 16 points against No. 9/8 Tennessee, the guard from Norfolk reached the major plateau.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs play one of the toughest schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against five teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane and JMU) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel). At the end of its non-conference slate, ODU's schedule ranked No. 16 according to CollegeRPI.com.

RECORD CROWDS AT THE

TED:

Old Dominion set the all-time women's basketball attendance record at the Ted Constant Center earlier this season when the Lady Monarchs hosted Tennessee. The game between the two historic programs was a **BLUE OUT** and a remarkable 7,774 fans packed the Ted. Old Dominion boasts a dominant 107-22 overall record in the Constant Center, including seven victories over nationally ranked opponents.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

CAA Honors

Senior Jasmine Parker was named the CAA Co-Player of the week Nov. 29 after scoring a combined 47 points and swiping nine steals in games at NC State and home vs. Louisville.

D-FENCE

Defense was the story for the Old Dominion women's basketball team December 8 against George Washington as the Lady Monarchs forced 22 turnovers and held the Colonials to 26.0 percent shooting from the field in a 60-35 victory. George Washington's 35 points is the lowest scored against ODU since Delaware State was only able to muster 28 in a game verse the Lady Monarchs on Dec. 20, 2007. The Colonials netted only 13 points in the first half, which was the lowest since that same game, when the Hornets tallied just 12 points in the opening stanza en route to losing 70-28.

Everyone Involved

Nearly everyone contributed to ODU's win over NC A&T on November 18 as 10 of 11 Monarchs that played, scored, including Kquanise Byrd, who scored six points after missing the opener with a broken finger on her shooting hand.

Openers

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time. After topping Towson on January 6, ODU improved to 20-0 all-time in CAA openers.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

Dixon To Have Jersey Retired

Former Lady Monarch basketball All-American and Olympian Medina Dixon will have her jersey retired on Sunday, Jan. 30, prior to Old Dominion's 2 p.m. game against Georgia State at the Ted Constant Center. During her three years as a Lady Monarch, Dixon helped lead Old Dominion to an 84-14 record and two trips to the NCAA Final Four. In 1983 the Lady Monarchs rolled to a 29-6 record and hosted the Final Four in Norfolk. ODU lost the semi-final game to Louisiana Tech. As a senior in 1985, Dixon guided Old Dominion to a 31-3 record and the NCAA National Championship. The Lady Monarchs topped Georgia for the title and Dixon was named to the NCAA All-Tournament team. Dixon, a Boston, Mass. native, was a standout forward for ODU from 1982-85. She completed her career with 1,968 points, 979 rebounds, 417 assists and 277 steals. She ranks seventh all-time at Old Dominion in scoring and rebounding, fourth in steals and fifth in assists.

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

CAA Dominance at Home

Since Old Dominion joined the CAA in 1992, the Lady Monarchs have only lost six games in Norfolk. The most recent was last years regular season finale vs. Towson as the Tigers posted an eight-point win over the Lady Monarchs. Earlier in the year, VCU had a 19-point win over the Lady Monarchs, the largest margin of defeat ODU has suffered in a home conference game, and JMU became the only team to beat ODU twice in Norfolk. Old Dominion is now 153-6 in regular season conference games at home since joining the CAA. Including the eight CAA Tournaments held in Norfolk, Old Dominion has a 176-6 overall record against CAA opponents.

Lady Monarchs Ink Five To National Letters of Intent

Old Dominion head women's basketball coach Wendy Larry announced the signing of five players to National Letters of Intent. Myeisha Hall, Tiffany Minor, Queen Tiye Jackson, Ashley Betz-White and Kaneisha Atwater will continue their academic and athletic careers with the Lady Monarchs beginning in 2011-12.

Hall is ranked the 53rd-best guard in the Class of 2011 by ESPN. She's 5-8 and can play the point or shooting guard spots. Hall averaged 22 points, nine rebounds and four assists last season for Palm Beach (Fla.) Lakes High School. The combo guard, who scored 40 points in a game as a junior, was named the South Florida Sun-Sentinel Big School Player of the Year in Palm Beach County.

Larry on Hall: "Myeisha is an athletic scorer with tremendous transitional skills."

Minor is ranked No. 72 among wing players in her class by ESPN.com. The 5-11 wing player averaged 16.7 points last year at The Maret School in Washington, D.C. She's an excellent set shooter who can rebound and pass well for a wing player. She's expected to either play shooting guard or small forward at ODU.

Larry on Minor: "She's extremely versatile with good court awareness. She also adds a great deal of length on the defensive side of the ball."

Jackson led Trenton (N.J.) Catholic Academy to a state title last year. She's an excellent rebounder at 5-11 and she's expected to contribute at one of the two forward spots at ODU. Jackson has a strong build and can score both inside and out. Her range extends to the three-point line.

Larry on Jackson: "She has the size of a post player with a perimeter players skills."

Betz-White is a 5-5 point guard out of Trinity High School in Camp Hill, Pa. She averaged 11.4 points and 4.2 steals last year en route to being named to the Class AAA All-State Third Team as a junior. A true point guard, Betz-White excels in transition and on the secondary break, but is also comfortable in a set offense. The guard is a solid outside shooter and features a good pull-up jumper.

Larry on Betz-White: "She's a true point guard with personality and flare. Ashley makes everyone around her better."

Atwater is a 5-7 combo guard from Fort Pierce Westwood High School in Florida. She led her high school team in scoring as a junior, averaging 28.2 points. Atwater tallied five triple-doubles last season. She's a three-sport high school athlete who is quick off the dribble and strong on the defensive side of the ball.

Larry on Atwater: "She's an athlete that's extremely quick and fast. Additionally, she's an exceptional defender that can help us a great deal."

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 917-319 (.742) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.
