About North Carolina A&T

•The Aggies are 1-1 on the season and coming off a 81-56 triumph at Winthrop in the second game of the Winthrop Tournament.

•North Carolina A&T has been led thus far by a trio of freshmen. Rookie guard Alishia Mosley posted 22 points on 5-for-10 shooting from 3-point range in the win over Winthrop. She also dished out five assists, grabbed five rebounds and turned the ball over just once in what was her first collegiate start. Freshman Sabre Proctor came off the bench to contribute 16 points and 11 rebounds, while freshman Tracy King was also a part of the youthful uprising as she finished with 14 points off the bench.

•The Aggies received six first-place votes and were selected to finish second in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Preseason voting.

About Old Dominion

• Old Dominion earned a come-from-behind victory, 65-63, over Georgia Tech on Sunday at home. With the win over Georgia Tech, the Lady Monarchs have now won three of their last four season openers.

• The win was ODU's first over an ACC school since topping Virginia on Nov. 21, 2008.

• The Lady Monarchs were led by senior guard Jasmine Parker's 13 points. She also secured the win for the team after hitting a pair of free-throws with 4.6 seconds remaining in regulation.

•ODU had five players score double-figures against the Yellow Jackets, which was the first time five players had scored in double-figures in one game since March 4, 2009 against conference foe William & Mary.

Game Day Notes

Georgia Tech Recap

Jasmine Parker hit a pair of free throws with 4.6 seconds remaining in the game to give Old Dominion a come-from-behind 65-63 win over Georgia Tech Sunday afternoon at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Five Lady Monarchs hit for double-figures, led by Parker's team-high 13 points. The senior also dished out a game-high six assists for ODU. Junior Tia Lewis chipped in 11 points and hauled in a team-high seven rebounds in the win.

Georgia Tech (1-1) took its largest lead of the game at 48-38, but ODU (1-0) responded with a 15-5 run to tie the game at 53. After the Yellow Jackets took a 61-59 lead, Parker knotted the score once again with a driving layup. After each team made a bucket to tie the score at 63, Parker started a drive from the left wing and pulled up at the foul line where she was fouled. The senior hit both foul shots to give ODU the two-point edge. On the ensuing possession, Georgia Tech's Tyanna Marshall drove the length of the court and was fouled by Parker with 0.4 seconds left. Marshall missed her first shot and purposely missed the second, but the rebound was tipped away by Lewis as time ran out to secure the ODU victory.

Fab Five

In Old Dominion's 65-63 win over Georgia Tech on November 14, five Lady Monarchs hit for double-figures in scoring. Jasmine Parker led the way with 13 points, while Jackie Cook posted 12, Tia Lewis and Russia Voronina had 11 and Shadasia Green chipped in 10. It was the first time ODU had five players in double-figures since March 4, 2009 against William & Mary.

Tracking Parker

Senior guard Jasmine Parker is inching closer to becoming the 28 all-time Lady Monarch to score 1,000 career points. With her 13 points in ODU's win over Georgia Tech on Sunday, she now sits with 917 points.

Milestone March

Head Coach Wendy Larry is approaching yet another milestone, just 11 wins shy of her 600th career victory. She has piled up a 589-223 record in 27 seasons as a head coach, including 540 career wins at ODU.

Mid-Major Riser

The first regular season CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll was released Tuesday and Old Dominion jumped from No. 11 in the preseason poll to No. 5. Green Bay sits atop the rankings and three total CAA teams are ranked.

ACC Win

Old Dominion topped Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech on November 14, 65-63. It was ODU's first win over an ACC school since 2008. The Lady Monarchs upended Virginia, 78-70, on November 21, 2008.

Tough Slate

As usual, the Lady Monarchs will play one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation during their 2010-11 campaign. ODU's 2010-11 schedule features games against four teams that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament (Georgia Tech, NC State, Tennessee, Tulane) and six that qualified for the WNIT (Florida, Richmond, Delaware, VCU, Hofstra & Drexel).

CAA Preseason Poll

The Lady Monarchs were picked to finish second in the CAA Preseason Rankings, as voted on by the league head coaches. Defending champion James Madison was pegged as the top team heading into 2010-11.

Openers

After topping Georgia Tech on Nov. 14, Old Dominion improves to 30-12 all-time in home openers. In season openers, the Lady Monarchs are 28-14 all-time.

Exhibition Success

The Lady Monarchs went 2-0 in a pair of home exhibition games against Davis & Elkins and Bowie State. Junior Tia Lewis posted 20 points and 23 rebounds against D&E, while sophomore JoNiquia Guilford shined versus Bowie State with a game-high 19 points.

NCAA Host Site

Old Dominion has been selected as one of 16 host sites for first- and second-round games in the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Games will be played at the Ted Constant Convocation Center on either March 17 and 19 or March 18 and 20, with exact dates and ticket availability for those contests to be released at a later date.

2011 CAA Championships

The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 11-14, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

900 WINS!

On January 31, 2010 the Old Dominion women's basketball program became just the third to win 900 games. Old Dominion women's basketball boasts an all-time record of 910-314 (.743) and is in its 42nd year of play. There are only two other programs in the history of women's basketball with 900 wins, Tennessee and Louisiana Tech.

Brief Recap/Preview

•Old Dominion won the 2010 CAA regular season title, advanced to the CAA Tournament championship game and reached the WNIT second round before falling to BIG EAST foe Providence last year.

•The Lady Monarchs have reached the postseason in 18 of the past 19 years.

•ODU ended the year with a 19-14 overall mark and a 14-4 record in league play.

•Four starters, including three double-figure scorers, are back for the Lady Monarchs this season.

•Senior guards Jasmine Parker (11.1 ppg) and Shadasia Green (10.7 ppg/5.3 rpg) both earned All-CAA accolades a year ago.
