- · George Washington makes the trip across state lines to Norfolk, Virginia to face off with Old Dominion University on Thursday. Tip is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. with live coverage on CONUSA.tv.
- •Thursday's match-up against ODU will be the 8th in GW's history. The Colonials currently lead the career series 4-3, and are looking for their third straight win over the Monarchs, and their fourth win in the last five games.
- · George Washington's offense stalled in their last game against Minnesota, leading to a 48-32 loss at the hands of the Golden Gophers.
- Ty Moore led all GW scorers with eight points in Sunday's contest. It marks the second time in her GW career that Moore has been the Colonial's leading scorer. Behind Moore, Aurea Gingras, Sheslanie Laureano and Taylor Webster all had six points
- •Sunday's contest from Minnesota marked a homecoming for two GW players. Maddie Loder and Sophie Haydon both returned to the Land of 10,000 lakes, where they played their high school ball. In the contest, Loder started the game and chipped in with four assists, while Haydon had two points in nine minutes of action.
- •Defensively, the grit and intensity that Coach McCombs preached as a centerpiece of her teams showed itself against the Golden Gophers, with the Colonials' limiting the Minnesota offense to just 48 points on 18 of 57

shooting. Coming into Sunday's contest, Minnesota had been averaging 76 points in its first two contests.

THE GRADUATE

Through the first three games of the season, Ty Moore has been putting up numbers rarely seen from a graduate transfer in GW history.

Currently, Moore's 28 points (9.3 ppg) in her first three games are the most by a grad transfer in program history and are the most since Ariel Stephenson scored 26 points in her first three games during the 2019-20 season.

Meanwhile, on the boards, Moore is averaging 7.3 rebounds per game, another graduate transfer record through the first three games of a GW season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Through the first three games of the year, it seems like Essence Brown has been called upon to be the steady hand in Coach McCombs' defense. Brown, a junior, has played at least 30 minutes in all three of GW's games, including a career-high 36 minutes in GW's game against Minnesota.

Offensively, Brown has also been putting in the work. Right now, she is currently averaging career-highs in points (4.7), rebounds (3.7), assists (1.3) and blocks (0.3) through the first three games of the year.






CRASH THE BOARDS

HISTORY VS. OLD DOMINION

GW and ODU match up for the 8th time overall, and for the second straight season, this time facing off in Norfolk after battling in the first leg of a home and home from the Smith Center last year. In their last meeting on November 28th of 2020, the Colonials were able to dispatch the Monarchs in a 55-37 victory. GW's Neila Luma led all scorers with 18 in the contest, while currently Colonial **Maddie Loder** pocketed six of her own, in addition to teammates Mayowa Taiwo and Aurea Gingras, who each scored four.

A LOOK AT THE MONARCHS

ODU returns four of their starters from a season ago and, much like George Washington, welcome 10 total newcomers to their roster. Last season, ODU went 13-11 in head coach Delisha Milton-Jones' first season at the helm. Entering the 2021-22 season, returners Ajah Wayne and Amari Young, as well as Florida Atlantic transfer lggy Allen earned preseaon all-conference honors for Conference USA.

The Monarchs have put forth a dominant effort in their first two games this season, defeating South Carolina State, 80-52, in their home opener before downing SEC power Auburn, 57-44. Iggy Allen has been leading the way for ODU through the first two games, averaging a double-double with 18 points and 11 rebounds, while Ajah Wayne is right behind her, averaging 17 points and nine rebounds.

UP NEXT

George Washington will return home to the Smith Center for their final home contest before Thanksgiving, facing off with Quinnipiac on Monday, November 22nd. Tip-off is scheduled for 5:00 p.m..







CAROLINE MCCOMBS HEAD COACH

FIRST SEASON // YOUNGSTOWN STATE '98

GW Director of Athletics Tanya Vogel named Caroline McCombs as the 11th head coach in the history of the Buff & Blue's prestigious women's basketball program on April 2, 2021.

A proven winner at every stop during her 22-year coaching career, McCombs comes to GW after seven years as the head coach at Stony Brook where she led the Seawolves to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021.

"I am thrilled to welcome Caroline McCombs to GW," Vogel said.
"Our women's basketball program is rich with history that serves as an outstanding display of both discipline and excellence for the university, winning 23 Atlantic 10 regular season and tournament championships. Caroline's passion for our program and her ability to build a culture grounded in love, service and value addition is an ideal match for our program as we strive to return GW women's basketball to the national conversation."

The 2020 America East Coach of the Year, McCombs won 130 games in seven years at Stony Brook. This past season, she led the Seawolves to a 15-6 mark, winning the America East Tournament Championship and earning a No. 14 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

"First off, I'd like to thank President LeBlanc, Mark Diaz, Tanya Vogel and John Square for the belief in me to lead this program," McCombs said. "In all of my conversations, it was evident that my values would fit seamlessly with the established culture at GW. Furthermore, I'd like to thank Shawn Heilbron for the opportunity to become a head coach and the position he put me in to lead the Stony Brook program.

"GW has a storied tradition. Having worked under Joe McKeown at Northwestern, I was able to learn what a special place GW is. I look forward to helping restore this program as contenders in the Atlantic 10 and across the country."

McCombs had the Seawolves on the precipice of an NCAA Tournament berth in 2020, winning the program's first-ever America East regular season championship and advancing to the America East Championship game with a 28-3 record before the remainder of the season was canceled due to COVID-19.

The Seawolves won 22 consecutive games in 2019-20, garnering votes in the national polls for the first time in program history. McCombs leaves Stony Brook as the program's winningest Division I coach and second-winningest overall having coached 19 all-conference selections.

McCombs' teams have made their mark on the defensive end of the floor, ranking in the top 40 nationally in scoring defense each of her seven years on campus. This past year, the Seawolves held opponents to just 52.4 ppg, the fifth-best mark in the nation.

"Our expectations for GW women's basketball are high, and Caroline McCombs clearly displays the excellence that we are looking for in a leader," said GW President Thomas LeBlanc. "With a proven track record of recruiting and developing student-athletes who excel on the court and in the classroom, Caroline is an excellent match for our program, and we look forward to welcoming her to GW."

Prior to becoming a head coach, McCombs gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach for 15 years at the Division I level. She assisted four different programs and appeared in five NCAA tournaments, including two Sweet 16 appearances. She has also developed a pair of AP All-Americans and three WNBA players.

Before her time at Stony Brook, McCombs spent 2012–14 as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn, assisting the Tigers to a pair of WNIT berths. She was influential in signing a recruiting class that ranked 16th nationally in 2012.

McCombs came to Auburn from Northwestern where she was an assistant under former GW head coach and Hall of Famer Joe McKeown from 2010-12. Under her tutelage, Amy Jaeschke was an AP All-American and made history as the program's first WNBA draft pick. McCombs helped lead the team to a WNIT berth in her first season and assisted in bringing in a top-25 recruiting class.

Prior to Northwestern, McCombs spent five seasons as an assistant at Pittsburgh from 2005-10, aiding the program to five straight postseason appearances that included three NCAA Tournaments and a pair of Sweet 16 berths. With the Panthers, she coached Shavonte Zellous, who earned All-America honors

and was a 2009 WNBA Draft pick.

McCombs started her coaching career as an assistant coach at Valparaiso in 1999, holding the title for five years before being elevated to associate head coach in 2004-05. The Crusaders won two conference championships and advanced to consecutive NCAA Tournaments under her watch. She also coached Marlous Nieuwveen, who became the first player in school and conference history to reach the WNBA.

A native of Medina, Ohio, McCombs was an all-conference performer for Youngstown State, where she graduated in 1998 with a degree in dietetics. McCombs was a two-time Mid-Continent Conference Second Team selection in 1996-97 and 1997-98 and played in two NCAA tournaments, including with the 1998 team that pulled off a first-round upset as a #12 seed.
