WHAT WILL IT TAKE FOR 500?

Head Coach Wendy Larry is rapidly approaching the 500 victory mark in her career. To date she needs three victories to reach the mark. She currently holds a 497-184 overall record in her 23rd season as a head coach. Additionally, Coach Larry is approaching her 450th victory as the head coach at her alma mater. She holds a 448-153 record in her 20th season at the helm of the Old Dominion program.

BACK TO THE POLLS:

The Lady Monarchs received votes in both the Preseason Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll. The Lady Monarchs have received votes over the last few seasons and are looking to return to the Top 25 in both polls. Old Dominion's last Top 25 ranking in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll was November 18th, 2003. Old Dominion's last appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 was the final poll of the 2002 season as the Lady Monarchs danced their way to the "Elite Eight".

STREET & SMITH:

Street and Smith Magazine has listed the Old Dominion women's basketball team at No. 18 in its annual College Basketball Yearbook which went on sale on Oct. 1. Included on this year's schedule are five teams also appearing in Street and Smith's list including No. 5 Tennessee, No. 7 Duke, No. 14 Rutgers, No. 15 Kentucky and No. 20 Virginia.

WHAT THE LADY MONARCHS WELCOME BACK:

The Old Dominion women's basketball team welcomes back four starters and nine letter-winners from last year's team that went 22-9 overall and captured its 15th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association title. Seventy two percent of the offense returns including the four of the five leading scorers and three of the four leading rebounders from a season ago. This year's group of seniors - Tish Lyons, Sherida Triggs, Shantel Wilson - enter the 2006-07 season having collected three CAA titles, three NCAA appearances, a 69-25 overall record and 49-5 mark in CAA matchups. Triggs joins junior guard T.J. Jordan on the Preseason Second Team All-CAA list. Triggs led the CAA in field goal percentage, was second on the ODU squad in scoring, and led the Lady Monarch rebounding corps. Jordan led the team in scoring and reset the single season three-point attempt record.

The Lady Monarch women's basketball team helped the Virginia Cavaliers open their new building - The John Paul Jones Arena - in ODU's first regular season contest on Saturday, November 12th. It was Virginia back on November 22nd, 2002 that helped Old Dominion open the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

LAST TIME VS. EAST CAROLINA:

Freshman Myriah Spence scored a career high 29 points and keyed a 17-2 ODU run to start the second half as Old Dominion defeated East Carolina, 92-64 in a CAA contest back on February 4, 2001 at the old ODU Fieldhouse. Spence scored 13 points in the first half as ODU led 43-30. She then scored five points in the Lady Monarchs 17-2 run to start the second half which increased the lead to 60-32 lead with 14:35 left in the game. Spence also was perfect six-for-six from three-point range. Four other Lady Monarchs scored in double figures. Freshman Monique Coker scored 17 points, while Hamchetou Maiga and Okeisha Howard scored 11 each. Tiffany Thompson led ODU with eight rebounds, while Howard dished out a game high seven assists. Old Dominion shot a blistering .603 (35-58) from the field, while ECU shot .286 (18-63). ODU outrebounded ECU, 47-30 in winning their 110th straight league game. ECU was led by Lucina Mason with 14 points, while Tali Robich and Alisha Bishop added 13 points each.

SERIES WITH EAST CAROLINA:

Tonight will mark the 49th meeting between the Lady Monarchs and Pirates with Old Dominion holding a 39-9 advantage in the all-time series. East Carolina was once a member of the Colonial Athletic Association and regularly met Old Dominion on the hardwood from the Lady Monarchs entry into the league in 1991 through the Pirates departure to Conference USA after the 2000-01 season. This will mark the first meeting between these two schools since the Pirates left the CAA. East Carolina only managed to defeat ODU once during regular season competition with a 71-57 in February of 1992. After that Old Dominion rattled off 26 straight wins over the Pirates including seven CAA Tournament victories.

CAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

ABOUT EAST CAROLINA::

The Pirates enter Tuesday night's competition with a 1-2 overall mark. East Carolina opened the season against ODU rival James Madison, falling 82-66 in Harrisonburg. The Pirates then traveled to the TD Banknorth Classic in Burlington, Vermont earning an 80-71 victory over Harvard, but falling 57-43 to host Vermont in the championship game. The Lady Monarchs represent one of four CAA schools on the Pirates' slate this season. Including James Madison and Old Dominion, East Carolina will square off against Virginia Commonwealth and UNC-Wilmington. Entering tonight's game, East Carolina is led by sophomore guard Jasmine Young (17.3 ppg) and senior center Cherie Mills (11.3 ppg). Mills is also adding in a team-leading 7.3 rebounds per game.

BREAKING DOWN THE OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 25-13 in season openers, suffering a 72-92 set back in this year's opener at Virginia. Of the previous 38 season openers, Old Dominion has opened the season three times with Virginia with a win in 1977, a loss in 2002 with the opening of ODU's Ted Constant Convocation Center, and a loss in 2006 at the opening of UVA's John Paul Jones Arena. In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 27-11 including a 2-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion fell to #21/24 Kentucky in its 2006-07 home debut, 55-69.

KEEP SHOOTING PARTNER:

Junior guard T.J. Jordan came off the bench in the 72-92 season opening loss at Virginia to net a team-high 21 points. Shooting 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range, the third year Lady Monarch set new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted. The Lady Monarchs' three-point specialist, she holds the single season three-point attempt mark (2005-06 - 248).

TAKING AWAY SOME GOOD:

Nobody likes to lose, but let's look at one thing the Lady Monarchs improved on from the exhibition season ...Free Throw Shooting. In their last exhibition showing, a 105-50 win over M.I. Express, Old Dominion shot just 54.5 percent from the charity stripe hitting 24-

of-44. Of the nine Lady Monarchs that got to the line, only three shot 50 percent or better (Sherida Triggs - 7-of-7, T.J. Jordan - 4-of-4, Jessica Canady - 3-of-4). Against Virginia, Old Dominion improved that mark to 63 percent as four of the six Lady Monarchs who got to the line hit 75 percent or better. The number got even better in their home opener against Kentucky as Old Dominion shot 73.1 percent. Of the eight Lady Monarchs who got to the line against the Wildcats, only one Lady Monarchs missed more than one free throw. Senior forward Tish Lyons went a perfect 4-of-4 and T.J. Jordan went 6-of-7 from the stripe to tie her career-high in free throws made and attempted.

RANK 'EM UP:

Old Dominion took on #21/24 Kentucky in their last outing marking the first of four Top 25 teams the Lady Monarchs will face this season. Also awaiting Old Dominion this season will be Duke, Tennessee, and Rutgers, who were featured in the Top 10 in the preseason polls.

0-2...SO WHAT?:

The Lady Monarchs may be 0-2 on the 2006-07 season, but that's no reason to think the sky is falling. Last season, Old Dominion opened the season 0-2 and finished the year with a 22-9 overall mark and their 15th straight CAA title. The 2003-04 Lady Monarchs opened 0-2 and picked up ranked wins over #7 Penn State and #12/13 North Carolina. They finished 25-7 along with the CAA title. The 2002-03 Lady Monarchs opened 0-3 but managed a 20 win season going 21-9 with a CAA title. The 2000-01 season saw Old Dominion go 0-2 and also finished with a 21-9 mark and a CAA title. The 1992-93 women's team started the year off 0-4, but ended the year 22-8 overall, with yes...another CAA title and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

UP NEXT:

The Lady Monarchs close out their three-game homestand hosting Delaware State on Saturday, November 25th. The Delaware State game will be the first meeting between the Lady Monarchs and Hornets. Tip-off is at 4:00 p.m. with the ODU men's team meeting Richmond in a televised game earlier in the day. The Pirates travel to Richmond for a Friday night meeting with Virginia Commonwealth.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 14-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 269-15 overall record, which includes eights seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 143-2 record at home and a 128-13 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (2-0), George Mason (39-0), Northeastern (2-0), UNC-Wilmington (33-0), and Towson (9-0).

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team opened the 2006-07 season with a 92-72 loss at in-state rival Virginia on Sunday afternoon at the brand new John Paul Jones Arena.

The game marked the opening of the Cavaliers brand new facility. Virginia had helped open ODU's new home, the Ted Constant Convocation Center, back when the door opened in 2002.

The loss dropped Old Dominion to 0-1 in their first showing of the regular season. Virginia improved to 2-0.

Virginia jumped out to a 14-point lead, 24-10. The Cavaliers built its lead to 21 points, 36-15 with 6:38 to go in the half and entered the locker room with a 14-point edge, 44-30, paced by senior Siedah Williams' 15 points.

In the second half, Virginia maintained its double-digit lead, going ahead by as many as 21 points.

Junior guard T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) led the Lady Monarch squad with 21 points, all coming from three-point range. The third-year Lady Monarch shot 6-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-17 from three-point range setting new career-highs in field goals and three-pointers attempted.

Senior Sherida Triggs (Norcross, Ga.) sat out most of the first half in foul trouble and scored all 15 of her points in the second half.

Redshirt sophomore Tiffany Green (Chesapeake, Va.) collected a game-high 10 boards as Virginia only held a slight one rebound margin over Old Dominion, 43-42.

Sophomore Lyndra Littles led Virginia with a career-high 23 points and 12 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and seventh of her career. She went 13-of-14 from the line. Williams followed with 21 points. Junior Denesha Kenon came off the bench for a career-high 13 points, while freshman Monica Wright rounded out the double-figure scoring with 11 points. The frosh also added six boards, four assists, and three steals in her second start.

NORFOLK, Va. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team fell to 0-2 on the season falling, 55-69, to No. 21 (AP)/24 (ESPN/USA Today) Kentucky on Homecoming Saturday at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

The Wildcats improved to 2-1 on the season and picked up their first victory in Norfolk in five trips to Hampton Roads.

In the first half, neither team enjoyed more than a five-point lead. Old Dominion led for much of the first half holding on to a 15-12 edge with 8:19 left in the half. From there Kentucky took a 7-0 run to take over a lead they would never relinquish. Old Dominion did manage to tie the game up late in the half. A.T.J. Jordan (Portsmouth, Va.) lay-up with 1:36 remaining tied the game at 23-23 and the Lady Monarchs ended the half down only 27-23.

Kentucky had a hot hand in the second half. After the Lady Monarch defense held the Wildcats to just 27.3 percent shooting in half number one, Kentucky ignited for 15-of-23 to hit 65.2 percent from the floor in the second half.

Old Dominion cut the Kentucky edge down to one twice in the opening minutes of the second half, but the Wildcats bumped up their margin to eight, 27-39, with 13:16 remaining. The Lady Monarchs would only manage to widdle the Wildcat lead down to five. On the next two plays, a Jordan free-throw and a Sherida Triggs lay-up, Old Dominion got as close to the Kentucky lead, 47-42, as it would get the rest of the game.

Guards Carly Ormerod and Samantha Mahoney helped Kentucky take a 6-0 run to give the Wildcats a double digit lead it would hold on for almost the rest of the game. Senior forward Jennifer Humphrey hit two free throws giving the Wildcats its largest lead of the game, a 16-point 65-49 advantage.

Jordan was the team's leading scorer for the second straight game and the lone Lady Monarch in double figures. Jordan netted 11 with six points coming from the line. Sophomore Jazzmin Walters (Norfolk, Va.) added in nine.

Kentucky's Jenny Pfeiffer came off the Wildcat bench to lead all scorers with 22 points. Two other Wildcats joined Pfeiffer with double digit scoring. Ormerod added in 18 points, while Mahoney poured in 12.

Old Dominion won the battle of the boards by one, 42-41. Junior Megan Pym (Newfield, N.Y.) hauled in seven rebounds in just six minutes, but missed the rest of the game with an injury.
