OPENING TIP

- ODU opens the 2020-21 season with a road contest against George Washington.
- The Nov. 28 contest will mark head coach DeLisha Milton-Jones' first game as head coach for ODU.
- Prior to her stop with the Orange, Milton-Jones served as head coach of Pepperdine for two seasons.
- ODU returns three of its four double-figure scorers from last season's 24-6 team, which includes Victoria Morris (11.8), Ajah Wayne (10.7), Amari Young (10.6).
- The Monarchs were picked third in the C-USA Preseason Poll with two Monarchs in Ajah Wayne and Amari Young tabbed on the Preseason All-Conference Team.
- There are three new faces on the 2020-21 ODU squad, all freshman - Skylah Travis, Lanay Wheaton and Ash'a Thompson.
- Overall, ODU is 34-17 in all-time season openers. Last season, ODU opened the season with a 59-44 win over Campbell.
- In season openers on the road, ODU is 8-10.

DeLisha Milton-Jones, the two-time Olympic gold medalist and former head coach at Pepperdine University, has been selected as the new head coach of the Old Dominion women's basketball program, as announced by Director of Athletics Dr. Camden Wood Selig on April 17, 2020.

Milton-Jones, who also had a decorated professional career in the WNBA and overseas, spent the past season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for Syracuse University.

Milton-Jones has excelled at every stop of her basketball career. She started her college coaching career as an assistant at Pepperdine in 2016-17. After one season, she moved into the head coaching role and led the program to unprecedented success. In the 2017-18 season, she guided Pepperdine to 10 wins, the most at the Malibu school since 2012. In her second year, the Waves won 12 more games than the previous year by finishing 22-10, one of the best turnarounds in the country. The Waves 22 victories in 2018-19 also marked the program's most wins since 2002. Pepperdine earned a WNIT bid, the program's first postseason tournament, and then advanced to the Sweet 16 with wins over St. Mary's and Cal Baptist.

She left Pepperdine for the assistant coaching role at Syracuse following the 2019 WNIT run. Milton-Jones joined the staff of veteran head coach Quentin Hillsman. This past season, the Orange put together a 16-15 mark, highlighted by wins over No. 5 Louisville and No. 8 Florida State.

Milton-Jones is the eighth head coach in ODU's storied women's basketball history, replacing Nikki McCray-Penson, who left the role last week to become the head coach at Mississippi State. Milton and McCray were both members of the USA team that won the gold medal in the 2000 Olympics.

Milton-Jones's coaching career followed a long and successful professional and international basketball career. Drafted fourth in the 1999 WNBA draft, she played 17 years in the league, retiring from the WNBA in 2016 after setting the record for most games played in league history with 499, which was later broken by WNBA great Sue Bird. She helped lead the Los Angeles Sparks to back-to-back WNBA Championships in 2001 and 2002. She was selected to the WNBA All-Star team in 2000, 2004 and 2007. In all, Milton-Jones played for Atlanta, New York, Washington and San Antonio, in addition to Los Angeles. Her 5,571 career points still ranks ninth in WNBA history. She also made stops in Spain, Italy, Turkey, South Korea, the Czech Republic and Russia to play professionally.

On the international stage, Milton-Jones helped the United States win Olympic gold medals in 2000 and 2008. In the latter, she was coached by former ODU legend, Anne Donovan. She missed the 2004 Olympics with an injury. While playing for the national team, Milton-Jones also helped Team USA win FIBA Championships in 1998 and 2002.

Milton-Jones's first venture into coaching came when she was named interim coach of the Los Angeles Stars midway through the 2005 American Basketball Association. She became just the second woman to coach a men's professional basketball team.

Milton-Jones, who played for four years for Carol Ross at Florida, had one of the most remarkable college careers at Florida, capped off her senior year when she was named the 1997 Wade Trophy Winner, the 1997 Honda Award Winner, the 1997 SEC Player of the Year, a First Team All-American selection amongst other highly-touted accolades. She scored 1,858 points during her career, helping the Gators to four straight NCAA tournament appearances. Ironically, her final collegiate game was a 53-51 loss to Old Dominion in the 1997 NCAA Elite Eight. She was named to the Florida Gator Hall of Fame in 2007.

Milton-Jones takes over a program with a storied history that has returned to the national spotlight in recent years. The Monarchs' 1,084 wins ranks top-10 in the NCAA all-time wins category. ODU also owns three national championships, 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, 17 conference championships and 55 All-Americans.

SCOUTING THE COLONIALS

George Washington is coming off a 53-38 win over Lincoln on Wednesday, Nov. 25. Redshirt junior Neila Luma recorded a double-double, putting up 16 points and 17 rebounds. The Colonials were selected to finish ninth in the Atlantic 10 Conference preseason poll. Last season they compiled a 14-16 overall mark and an 8-8 record in A-10 play.

A NEW COACH IN TOWN

Milton-Jones was introduced at the Monarchs eighth women's basketball head coach in program history on April 17, 2020. Milton-Jones joined ODU after serving one season at Syracuse as Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator where she helped bring in the No. 4 recruiting class in the nation.

COACHING MATCHUP

Colonials head coach Jennifer Rizzotti was named the 1996 Wade Trophy winner, just one year before head coach Milton-Jones was named the 1997 Wade Trophy winner.

ALL-TIME SEASON OPENERS

Overall, ODU is 34-17 in all-time season openers. Last season, ODU opened the season with a 59-44 win over Campbell. In season openers on the road, ODU is 8-10.

1996-97 SEASON OPENER

ODU opened its 1996-97 season with a home Preseason WNIT game against George Washington. The Monarchs won 70-44. That same season, ODU went on to play in the NCAA Championship, eventually falling, 68-59 to Tennessee. Not only that, ODU put together a 34-2 record and a No. 2 ranking.

THEY'RE BACK!

#20 Maggie Robinson and #24 Mackenzie Smith are both back from ACL injuries suffered in the 2019-20 preseason. Robinson, who saw action in 2018-19 as a key starter looks to make an immediate impact as a forward. Smith looks to bring versatile skills to the point guard position.

A BRAND NEW STAFF

DeLisha Milton-Jones brought on three new faces to her inaugural staff. First, **Brandy Manning** serves as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. He comes to ODU from Georgia Tech, where he was an assistant coach for the last year. Manning has 14 years of Division I college coaching experience, which includes stops at Murray State, Central Florida, Arizona, Southern California, Texas State and Cal State Northridge.

Milton-Jones' second coaching hire was **Roneeka Hodges**. Hodges spent the 2019-20 season in an advisor role with LSU following her extensive playing career. Competing both internationally and in the WNBA, Hodges was drafted 15th overall in the 2005 WNBA Draft. Hodges played college hoops at LSU for three years before completing her eligibility at Florida State. Her senior season, Hodges earned 2004-05 Kodak Region II All-American honors and was selected to play in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) All-Star Challenge.

Joining the support staff as director of basketball operations, **Roland Jones Jr** spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach at Etiwanda High School in California, a top-25 nationally ranked program. Prior to that, Jones served as assistant coach on Milton-Jones' staff

at Pepperdine for the 2017-18 season. Before coaching, Jones played both collegiately and professionally

2020-21 PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Juniors Amari Young and Ajah Wayne have been named to the C-USA Preseason All-Conference Team, the league announced Wednesday. The Monarchs, who received three first-place votes were picked to finish third by the C-USA coaches.

FRESH FACES

Three Monarchs joined the squad this year. #2 Lanay Wheaton, #11 Ash'a Thompson and #25 Skylah Travis are all new Monarchs in Norfolk.

ODU GAME STREAMING

The Monarchs have been selected for two home games on ESPN+, starting with the Jan. 16 contest against Rice and Feb. 12 versus Charlotte. The Monarchs road game at Florida Atlantic on Jan. 8 will be an ESPN+ broadcast. Additionally, ODU will travel to Marshall and Middle Tennessee on Feb. 10 and Feb. 27, respectively, which have also been picked up by ESPN+. The remainder of ODU's game will be streamed on CUSA.TV.

2019-20 POSTSEASON ACCOLADES

Amari Young captured spots on the Second Team All-C-USA and the All-Defensive Team and Ajah Wayne tabbed a spot on the Second Team All-C-USA as announced by the league.

Young was been a force for the Monarchs in 2019-20 packing the stat sheets. The South Carolina native led the Monarchs in rebounding with 8.2 per game, which was good for seventh in the league. Young averaged 10.6 ppg and picked up 63 steals this season, which was second-most in the league. She compiled four double-doubles and was the only sophomore to be named on the Defensive Team.

A three-time C-USA Player of the Week, Wayne opened her season with a career-high 35 points to take down Auburn, the Monarchs first win over a Power 5 opponent since March 2015. Missing three games due to an ankle injury, Wayne averaged 10.7 points per game and 6.9 rebounds per game. The sophomore put together five double-doubles this season.

Hudson was the Monarchs leading scorer off the bench in 2019-20, averaging 6.5 ppg. The New York native drained 48 triples, which was good for 14th-most in the league. Hudson put together five double digit performances, leading the Monarchs in three of those contests.
