UAB TO HONOR CHILDREN'S HARBOR ON HOMECOMING VS. OLD DOMINION:

In one of college football's greatest new traditions, the UAB football team will honor Children's Harbor by wearing the names of 100 patients on the back of their grey and lime alternate jerseys when UAB hosts Old Dominion for Homecoming. The tradition has garnered national attention each year since 2017, and the Homecoming games have been memorable. Two years ago, UAB blocked a last second field goal to defeat Louisiana Tech 23-22. Last year, UAB outscored North Texas 19-0 in the second half for a come-from-behind 29-21 victory.

UAB DEFENSE PLAYING LIGHTS OUT:

UAB was once again lights out at UTSA and checks in this week at No. 7 nationally in total defense. The Blazers held the Roadrunners to just 220 yards of total offense and have yet to allow any opponent this season to score more than 20 points. UAB recovered two fumbles at UTSA and is now tied for the national lead with 10. Additionally, the Blazers rank 8th nationally in third down defense (.277), 12th in scoring defense (16.0), 12th in passing yards allowed (168.5), 13th in sacks per game (3.33), 15th in rushing yards allowed (96.5) and 18th in TFL per game (7.7).

WATKINS JR. HAS CAREER NIGHT AT UTSA:

Junior wide receiver Austin Watkins Jr. had a career night at UTSA, hauling in six catches for 167 yards and a touchdown. Watkins Jr. now has 26 catches for 534 yards and five touchdowns on the season, and he leads Conference USA in receiving yards per game at 89.0. He, Kendall Parham (436 yards) and Myron Mitchell (298 yards) have combined for 1,268 of UAB's 1,503 receiving yards this season (84.4%).

VOGEL SETS CAREER HIGH IN FIELD GOALS:

Senior place kicker Nick Vogel made a career-high four field goals at UTSA last Saturday. Vogel was good from 43, 31 twice and 23 yards in UAB's 33-14 victory. Vogel is now 8-of-11 on the year and has made each of his last six field goal attempts.

UAB OWNS NATION'S FIFTH LONGEST ACTIVE HOME WINNING STREAK:

Since reinstating the program in 2017, the Blazers are yet to lose a game at Legion Field and are a perfect 15-0 at home. UAB's 15 game home winning streak is the nation's fifth longest only behind Alabama (29), Clemson (19), UCF (18) and Ohio State (17).

24 WINS AND COUNTING:

With the win at UTSA, UAB is now 24-9 since returning to action in 2017. The 24 wins are the most of any team in Conference USA since the start of the 2017 season.

HEAD COACH

FOURTH SEASON AT UAB

JACKSONVILLE STATE '90

OVERALL RECORD: 41-19

AT UAB: 30-15

Bill Clark is a native of Anniston, Alabama. He graduated from Jacksonville State University in 1990 with a degree in physical education and began his football coaching career that year. His head coaching record at UAB is 30-15 and he is 41-19 as a Division I head coach.

A year after guiding UAB to a then-school record eight wins in 2017, Clark and the Blazers surpassed that with the program's first-ever 10-win season in 2018. UAB also tallied a school-best seven Conference USA wins which was good to win the West Division title and clinch a berth in the C-USA championship game.

On December 1, 2018, the Blazers won their first Conference USA title by traveling to Murfreesboro, Tenn., and defeating Middle Tennessee 27-25 in dramatic fashion on the Blue Raiders' home field to claim the league championship. UAB became the first C-USA team in league history to win a conference title on the road.

The Blazers went on to defeat Northern Illinois 37-13 in the Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl to capture UAB's first bowl victory ever and finished the season with the best record in program history at 11-3.

The national accolades once again poured in for Clark as he was named the 2018 FWAAs Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year, as well being named the CBS Sports National Coach of the Year for a second-consecutive year.

UAB was led by its record-setting defense the entire year. The Blazers finished 9th nationally in total defense and set a Conference USA record with three shutouts along the way. UAB ranked top-10 nationally in six different statistical categories this past season

On the offensive side of the ball, sophomore running back Spencer Brown continued to re-write the record book and followed up his Freshman All-America season with another outstanding season. Brown finished his spectacular sophomore season with 1,227 rushing yards and 16 rushing touchdowns. His 16 rushing touchdowns are a new single season UAB record and he finished the season nationally ranked ninth in that category. He also set the single season school record in total touchdowns (17) and total points (102).

UAB had 14 players earn All-Conference USA accolades in 2018, and defensive coordinator David Reeves was named a semifinalist for the Broyles Award, given annually to the nation's top assistant coach. Overall, UAB set 21 school records in 2018.

The Blazers also went 6-0 at home for a second-straight season and are now 12-0 since the start of the 2017 season which is the fifth longest home winning streak in the country.

In 2017, Clark guided UAB to an 8-5 overall record in its first year back after a two-year hiatus and just its second bowl appearance in program history.

The 2017 season started in record-setting fashion as 45,212 fans poured into Legion Field to watch the season opener, a 38-7 victory over Alabama A&M, which established a new attendance record.

For guiding the Blazers' historic 2017 season, Clark was named the CBS Sports National Coach of the Year as well as Conference USA Coach of the Year.

On the field, he orchestrated one of UAB's most potent offenses in program history and a devastating ground game featuring true freshman Spencer Brown, who ran for 1,329 yards and 10 touchdowns. Brown slashed the UAB record book in his first season donning the Green and Gold as he broke program's single season freshman rushing record previously held by Jordan Howard.

For his efforts, Brown became UAB's first-ever FWAAs Freshman All-America honoree and was also selected as the Conference USA Freshman of the Year. His 1,329 rushing yards were the second highest total by a freshman in C-USA history.

Clark also guided quarterback A.J. Erdely to record setting numbers as the junior tied the then-school record with 13 rushing touchdowns and threw for 2,331 yards and 16 touchdowns while completing 60.7 percent of his passes. His 29 total touchdowns were the second most in a single season at UAB.

The 2017 defense was led by a trio of seniors who became the backbone of the program, highlighted by Darius Williams, who was named First Team All-Conference USA and a First Team All-American by Pro Football Focus. He finished the regular season leading C-USA in passes defended (20), pass breakups (15) and interceptions (5).

Tevin Crews more than tripled his production from his junior year in 2014 as he led the team in tackles with 102 and was second on the team in tackles for loss (12.0). Crews finished the regular season as the only player in Conference USA to rank in

the top 10 in both tackles and tackles for loss.

Shaq Jones had 57 tackles and 13.0 TFL at the jack linebacker position and set the example for the team on and off the field. Along with his on-field production, Jones was named to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team and was a semifinalist for the inaugural Jason Witten Collegiate Man of the Year Award, both given for exceptional community service and humanitarian work.

Prior to the start of the 2017 season, the Blazers moved into their new state-of-the-art Football Operations Center which features coaches offices, meeting and film rooms, athletic training facilities, locker rooms, a weight room, a nutrition station and two full turf practice fields. One of those practice fields is under a pioneering open-air covered pavilion made possible by Legacy Community Federal Credit Union.

Legacy Credit Union announced the largest-ever sponsorship with UAB, a 20-year, \$4.2 million naming right agreement for Legacy Pavilion, and in the process, became the official credit union of UAB.

In Clark's first season as head coach of the Blazers in 2014, he turned around a program that was 2-10 the year before into a team that finished 6-6 and earned bowl eligibility for the first time since 2004.

The Blazers had 15 players earn All-Conference USA honors during the 2014 season, including three first team selections (RB Jordan Howard, DE Diaheem Watkins and KR J.J. Nelson). Nelson was also named the school's first Walter Camp First Team All-American.

The Blazers also experienced the country's second-highest increase in home attendance average, growing by more than 130 percent.

Prior to UAB, Clark was the head coach at Jacksonville State in 2013 and led the Gamecocks to an 11-4 record, their most victories since the 1992 campaign when JSU won the NCAA Division II National Championship. That number set an Ohio Valley Conference record and was also the most wins by a first-year head coach.

Jacksonville State earned an at-large berth in the FCS Playoffs and captured two victories -- including a second-round win over No. 6 McNeese State to reach the quarterfinals. The wins were the Gamecocks' first-ever in the NCAA Division I playoffs.

JSU concluded the 2013 season ranked No. 10 in the final FCS poll. The Gamecocks, who ranked sixth in the nation in FCS attendance, set 49 school records in 2013 and broke 13 OVC marks, as well as three NCAA records. JSU had two players earn All-America honors and nine selected for All-Ohio Valley Conference accolades.

Clark became Jacksonville State's head coach after five outstanding seasons at South Alabama as the Jaguars' defensive coordinator.

Clark's defense at USA finished second in the Sun Belt Conference in total defense in 2012 as the Jaguars completed their first full season of competition in the league. South Alabama posted the best record of any Division I FCS Independent in 2011 after winning the first 17 games in the program's history in 2009 and 2010.

During the 2010 season, South Alabama allowed only 13 points and 254.6 yards per game en route to a 10-0 record. In 2009, the Jags allowed only 5.9 points and 234 yards per game when the defense forced 25 sacks and forced 23 turnovers in only seven games.

Clark joined South Alabama in 2008 after spending nine years as head coach at Prattville (Ala.) High School where he led the Lions to national prominence. He won a pair of Class 6A State Championships as his last two teams won 30 straight games, while the 2007 squad was ranked No. 2 in USA Today's national high school poll.

Following his final season at Prattville High School, he was named the Alabama High School Athletic Association Coach of the Year and was also selected as the Schutt Southeast Regional Coach of the Year.

Clark posted a 107-11 (90.7 percent) overall record during his tenure.

Clark served on the staff of the Alabama-Mississippi All-Star Classic three times, including as head coach in the summer of 2007. He also served as head coach in the 2004 North-South All-Star Game. Clark began his coaching career as an assistant at Piedmont High School (1990-91) and also has coaching stints at Tuscaloosa County High School (1992-94), Coffee County (Ga.) High School (1995-96) and Dothan High School (1997-98).

Clark and his wife, Jennifer, have two children: daughter, Katie and son Jacob. His son Jacob appeared in all 27 games from 2017-18.

BIRMINGHAM – In front of 39,165 fans, the third largest home crowd in program history, the UAB football team outlasted Alabama State 24-19 on Thursday night at Legion Field.

It was the defense who made the plays down the stretch to clinch the victory, including a goal-line stand followed by a Will Boler interception on ASU's final possession with the Hornets in UAB territory.

Garrett Marino had a career night with nine tackles and a TFL, while Jarrion Street added eight tackles and one of UAB's three sacks on the evening. Along with his first career interception, Boler had four tackles and a pass breakup.

Wide receiver Myron Mitchell added the spark on special teams as UAB fans witnessed the Blazers' first kickoff return for a touchdown in five years. Mitchell went 98 yards in the first quarter for a touchdown and led the team with 166 all-purpose yards.

Running back Spencer Brown had 77 yards on 23 carries. Quarterback Tyler Johnston III added 64 yards rushing and finished 8-of-19 for 114 yards through the air.

The first quarter featured 27 points in the span of 1:12. After forcing a three-and-out on Alabama State's first possession, UAB took the ball straight down the field and Johnston III gave the Blazers a 7-0 lead with a 1-yard touchdown run with 8:55 left.

The Hornets though, responded with two touchdowns within 12 seconds of each other to take a 13-7 lead. The first was a 67-yard rush from Duran Bell, and following a UAB fumble on the ensuing kickoff, KHA'Darris Davis found Tyrek Allen on the next play for a 16-yard touchdown pass.

Mitchell gave UAB the lead right back with his 98-yard kickoff return for a touchdown to cap the wild scoring stretch.

The Blazers outscored the Hornets 10-0 in the second quarter and took a 24-13 lead into the locker room. The scoring came on a 46-yard field goal from Nick Vogel and a 23-yard touchdown pitch and catch from Johnston III to Kendall Parham with 4:39 remaining in the first half.

Alabama State scored the only points of the second half on a 7-yard pass from Davis to Joshua Knight with 5:31 left in the third. The Hornets' two-point conversion attempts was no good, bringing the score to 24-19.

The Hornets had a chance to take the lead early in the fourth quarter with first and goal at the 5-yard line, but the Blazers stiffened with their backs up against the wall as Marino, Noah Wilder and Will Dawkins all came up with tackles to keep ASU out of the end zone.

With one final attempt to take the lead, Davis had his pass deflected up into the air and intercepted by Boler with :56 remaining as UAB was able to take a knee for the victory.

UAB out-gained the Hornets 290-260 and had the edge in rushing 176-145.

The Blazers extended their home winning streak to 13 games and now hit the road for a Week 2 matchup at Akron. Kickoff on Sept. 7 is set for 12 p.m. local time, 11 a.m. CST on CBS Sports Network.

AKRON, Ohio – Tyler Johnston III threw for 319 yards and four touchdowns as the UAB football team defeated Akron 31-20 on Saturday afternoon at InfoCision Stadium in Ohio.

The Blazers (2-0) had a field day through the air as UAB's top three receivers, Austin Watkins Jr., Kendall Parham and Myron Mitchell all had at least 85 receiving yards and a touchdown. Johnston III found eight different receivers in total and has now thrown for over 300 yards in three of his seven career starts.

Watkins Jr. finished with 95 yards and two touchdowns, while Parham had 94 yards and a touchdown and Mitchell 88 yards and a score.

The defense also a monster day, picking up five sacks, 13 TFL and four pass breakups. Noah Wilder had a career afternoon and led the Blazers with 10 tackles, 1.5 TFL and 0.5 sacks, while Kristopher Moll returned to the lineup after missing last week and had eight tackles.

Reigning Conference USA Defensive Player of the Week Garrett Marino added two sacks and five tackles.

The Zips (0-2) received the opening kickoff, marched down the field in 10 plays, and converted a fourth-and-goal from the 1-yard line as Deltron Sands punched it in for the touchdown. The extra point was no good and Akron led 6-0 early on.

UAB responded on its second possession with a six play, 88-yard drive which resulted in a 49-yard touchdowns pass from Johnston III to Parham. That was the start of 31-unanswered points from the Blazers.

Following a second quarter field goal from Nick Vogel, Johnston III found Watkins Jr. on a 28-yard strike with 4:57 to go in the half which gave the Blazers a 17-6 lead and that was the score at halftime.

Out of the break, Johnston III once again connected with Watkins Jr., this time a 40 pass with 12:50 left in the third quarter to give UAB a 24-6 lead. After a defensive three-and-out, UAB's first play on the next possession was a 78-yard strike to Mitchell.

Akron added two touchdowns in the fourth quarter, but it was too-little, too-late as the Blazers improved to 2-0.

The Blazers held Akron to 4-of-16 on third down, and in two games combined are holding their opponents to just 7-of-31 on third down (22.5%).

The Blazers have a bye next week and then return to Legion Field to host South Alabama on Sept. 21. The game kicks at 2:30 p.m. on NFL Network and the Blazers look to extend their home winning streak to 14.

BIRMINGHAM – It was a dominating performance on Saturday afternoon as the UAB football defeated South Alabama 35-3 at Legion Field and improved its home winning streak to 14 straight.

The Blazers are off to their first 3-0 start as FBS members and have not lost a home game since returning to action in 2017. South Alabama falls to 1-3 on the season with the loss.

Tyler Johnston III completed 22-of-27 passes for 313 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Blazers. In his past two games, Johnston III has thrown for 632 yards and seven touchdowns.

His top three targets in Kendall Parham, Austin Watkins Jr. and Myron Mitchell were once again on full display as they combined for 260 of the 313 passing yards. Parham had a career-high 107 yards on three catches, one for a touchdown. Watkins Jr. had a team-high six catches for 90 yards and a score, while Mitchell went for 63 yards on five catches.

Those three receivers have now combined for 615 of UAB's 746 receiving yards this season.

Junior Spencer Brown added 80 rushing yards and his first two touchdowns of the season, and in the process moved into sole possession of second place UAB's career rushing touchdown list with 28, passing Darrin Reaves (2011-13). In all, UAB had 514 yards of total offense as they picked up a season-high 201 rushing yards.

The UAB defense was unstoppable Saturday afternoon, yielding just 190 yards of total offense to South Alabama. The Blazers added five sacks and eight tackles for loss, led by Garrett Marino who had two sacks. UAB held South to just 2-of-11 on third down and will remain in the top 10 nationally after coming into the game ranked seventh.

After a defensive three-and-out in which Marino picked up his first sack, the Blazers struck on their first possession as Johnston III connected with Parham for a 67-yard touchdown. Parham now has a touchdown reception in each of UAB's first three games.

UAB got Brown going early as the junior compiled 51 yards and two touchdowns in the first half, while Watkins Jr. added his third receiving TD of the season to give the Blazers a 28-3 lead at halftime.

Johnston III found fellow Mobile native Hayden Pittman for the only points in the second half as Pittman's 16-yard score capped a 15-play, 82-yard drive that took 8:38 off the clock as UAB controlled the game from start to finish.

The Blazers were 9-of-13 on third down offensively, while on the defensive side of the ball Noah Wilder had a team-best eight tackles.

UAB now turns its attention to Conference USA action in hopes of defending the league title. The Blazers are back in action next Saturday at WKU and game kicks at 6 p.m. on ESPN+.

BOWLING GREEN, Ky. – Junior Spencer Brown became UAB's career leading rusher, but the Blazers suffered their first loss of the season with a 20-13 defeat at WKU on Saturday night.

Brown had 21 carries for 70 yards and a touchdown and now has 2,818 career rushing yards. Brown also tallied his 30th career touchdown in the loss.

The Blazers (3-1, 0-1 C-USA) outgained the Hilltoppers (2-2, 2-0 C-USA) 298-222, but had four costly turnovers, all of which were interceptions.

Tyler Johnston III was 18-of-31 for 181 yards and the four interceptions. WKU quarterback Ty Storey made his first start in a WKU uniform and threw for 189 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, Kristopher Moll led the Blazers with eight tackles and a TFL. Jordan Smith recorded a sack for the fourth consecutive game, but UAB was only able to generate two sacks and three TFL, both of which are far under their season average.

Starling Thomas recovered a fumble on the first play of the game and the Blazers quickly turned that into three points as Nick Vogel converted a 31-yard field goal. WKU added a field goal of its own and the game was tied at three after the first quarter.

Brown scored his 30th career touchdown early in the second quarter to give UAB a 10-3 lead, but WKU took a 13-10 advantage into the locker room as the Hilltoppers intercepted UAB three times in the first half.

The Blazers tied it up at 13-13 with 9:17 to go in the third quarter as Vogel drilled a 38-yarder. That would be the only scoring of the stanza.

WKU regained the lead on a 7-yard pass from Storey to Jahcour Pearson with 11:17 left in the game, which proved the game-winning touchdown. Pearson finished with 94 receiving yards and a touchdown.

UAB's final drive of the game started at its own five, and the Blazers moved down to the WKU 38, but Johnston III was sacked on 4th-and-19 to end the game with 2:11 left.

The Blazers are back in action next Saturday when they host Rice at Legion Field. Kick is set for 6 p.m.

BIRMINGHAM – After two substantial weather delays which resulted in the longest game in program history, the UAB football team defeated Rice 35-20 on Saturday night at Legion Field.

The game featured an hour and a half lightning delay at halftime and another 1:23 minute delay with 6:11 to go in fourth quarter.

The entire second half was played in a torrential downpour and it favored the Blazers as they had 108 of their 129 rushing yards after the break, led by Lucious Stanley who had a career night.

Stanley set new career highs for carries (19), yards (88), touchdowns (2), and had his longest rush of 25 yards which was his first of two second half scores.

The Blazers (4-1, 1-1 C-USA) led 21-20 at the break, but held Rice (0-6, 0-2 C-USA) to just 48 yards in the second half. Kristopher Moll led the defensive charge with a monster game, compiling a career-high 14 tackles, 2.5 TFL, 1.5 sacks, a forced fumble and two quarterback hurries.

Rice fumbled five times, four of which were recovered by the Blazers, including three in the second half.

Tyler Johnston III threw for 282 yards, three touchdowns and two interceptions. His big three receivers combined for 257 of those receiving yards, led by Kendall Parham with three catches for 109 yards and two touchdowns. Austin Watkins Jr. had a team-high five catches which went for 78 yards and a TD, while Myron Mitchell added 70 receiving yards on three catches, along with 35 kickoff yards.

The Owls scored on the second play of the game as Aston Walters broke loose for a 64-yard rushing touchdown and Rice led 7-0 at the end of the first quarter.

UAB found its offensive groove in the second quarter with 21 points on three long touchdown passes. Johnston III found Parham twice on scores of 46 and 57 yards, while Watkins' 36-yarder was sandwiched in between Parham's TD receptions.

After the first lightning delay, the two teams took the field for the second half and it was all UAB. Stanley had 79 of his 88 yards in the second half, and both of his touchdowns came in the third quarter to help UAB gain a 35-20 advantage.

Mother nature once again disrupted the contest in the fourth quarter, but it was the Blazers who came out of the locker room and held the Owls to -5 yards in the final six minutes.

The Blazers had 409 yards of total offense compared to Rice's 305. UAB is now 3-0 against the since returning to action in 2017 and have outscored them 129-41 in those contests.

UAB now hits the road for a C-USA West Division showdown with UTSA next week in San Antonio. Kick of ESPN+ is scheduled for 5 p.m.

SAN ANTONIO – Behind a career night from wide receiver Austin Watkins Jr., the UAB football team led wire-to-wire in a 33-14 victory over UTSA at the Alamodome on Saturday night.

UTSA (2-4, 1-2 C-USA) entered the game ranked sixth nationally in pass defense allowing 158.3 yards per game, and the Blazers threw for 294 yards and two touchdowns on the Roadrunners. Watkins Jr. finished with six catches for 167 yards and a touchdown, while Tyler Johnston III was 17-of-26 for 294 yards, two touchdowns and one interception.

Entering tonight, only one team had thrown for more than 200 yards on UTSA (North Texas – 211).

It was a very balanced attack as UAB (5-1, 2-1 C-USA) put up 492 yards of total offense which included 198 on the ground. Lucious Stanley led the charge with a career-high 92 yards on 13 carries and a touchdown. True freshman Jermaine Brown Jr. added 62 yards, which was also a career high.

In yet another dominant defensive performance, UAB held UTSA to 220 yards of total offense and had two fumble recoveries, bringing its nation-leading total to 10 recoveries. Kristopher Moll, Noah Wilder and Dy'Jonn Turner each had seven tackles, and Moll added 1.5 TFL, one forced fumble, one fumble recovery, a pass breakup and a quarterback hurry.

Jack linebacker Jordan Smith had a standout game as well, registering a career-high six tackles, 2.0 TFL, a forced fumble and three quarterback hurries.

Nick Vogel also contributed to the win with a career-high four field goals. His first was a 31-yarder which gave UAB a 3-0 lead with 9:59 to go in the opening quarter. Those would be the only three points of the quarter for either team.

After Moll forced a UTSA fumble which TD Marshall recovered, the Blazers went deep on the next play as Johnston III found Watkins Jr. on a 67-yard strike to give the Blazers a 10-0 advantage at the 14:01 mark of the second quarter.

UTSA answered right back behind a 4-yard touchdown run from Sincere McCormick which made the score 10-7 with 12:02 remaining in the half.

Vogel added two field goals from 31 and 24 yards, and UAB led 16-7 at the break. The Blazers outgained the Roadrunners 292-130 in the first half, led by Watkins Jr. who had five catches for 123 yards and a touchdown.

UTSA got within two at 16-14 after a 4-yard rushing touchdown by quarterback Lowell Narcisse with 8:57 left in the third, but those would be the final points for UTSA as UAB ended the game with 17 unanswered.

Myron Mitchell extended UAB's lead with his only catch of the night which was a ridiculous 25-yard toe-tap touchdown in the corner of the end zone to make the score 23-14 with six minutes left in the third.

Vogel added a season-long 48-yarder in the beginning of the fourth quarter, and Stanley iced the game with his third touchdown run of the season with 5:20 left in the game.

UAB had the ball for 13 more minutes than the Roadrunners (36:06-23:54) and UAB has still not allowed a team to score more than 20 points this season.

The Blazers return home next Saturday, Oct. 19, to host Old Dominion on Homecoming. UAB will honor Children's Harbor by wearing their alternate grey and lime jerseys with patients' names on the back. Kick is set for 3 p.m. on ESPN+.
